## A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

## UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Prepare the way of the Lord! In today's Gospel, St. John the Baptist appears in the desert, proclaiming a baptism of repentance. The Gospel tells us that it was of St. John the Baptist that the prophet Isaiah spoke: "A voice of one crying out in the desert: 'prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.'" Prepare the way of the Lord! We are called to prepare a place for our Lord, to make space in our hearts and lives to receive Christ. During this Advent, as we reflect on Christ having coming into our world and on the Holy Family struggling to find room in the inn, Advent makes us pause to reflect:

Do I have room in the inn of my heart and my life for Christ and His family, the Church? Do I recognize how Christ comes to me? Do I make space daily in prayer to receive Him? Do I receive Christ devoutly in the Holy Eucharist? Do I prepare my soul to receive Christ by having it cleansed in the mercy and grace of the sacrament of Reconciliation? Do I recognize Christ in my neighbor, particularly in the needy? Do I understand that every moment is an opportunity to love Christ? In the midst of the many distractions of life and the holiday season, Advent is an opportunity to grow closer to our Lord. This is a season of preparation—preparation to receive Jesus anew. He loves you. He extends His friendship to you. He is the source of hope and joy; He is the giver of peace. Let us receive Him and adore Him.

In the midst of all of our preparations, I encourage you again to be intentional about keeping Christ at the center of your Christmas celebrations. All of our celebrations point to Christ as Pope Benedict XVI has reminded us: "Let us remember in particular, as we look at the streets and squares of the cities decorated with dazzling lights, that these lights refer us to another light, invisible to the eyes but not to the heart. While we admire them, while we light the candles in churches or the illuminations of the crib and the Christmas tree in our homes, may our souls be open to the true spiritual light brought to all people of good will. The God-with-us, born in Bethlehem of the Virgin Mary, is the Star of our lives!" (December 21, 2005). Let us continue to joyfully prepare for celebration of the birth of our Savior, whose light of grace and love shine upon us.

¡Preparen el camino del Señor! En el evangelio de hoy, San Juan Bautista apareció en el desierto, proclamando un bautismo de arrepentimiento. El Evangelio nos dice que fue de San Juan Bautista de quien habló el profeta Isaías: "Voz del que clama en el desierto:

'Preparen el camino del Señor, enderezan sus senderos'". ¡Preparen el camino del Señor! Estamos llamados a preparar un lugar para nuestro Señor, a hacer espacio en nuestros corazones y vidas para recibir a Cristo. Durante este Adviento, mientras reflexionamos sobre la llegada de Cristo a nuestro mundo y sobre la Sagrada Familia que luchó por encontrar posada, reflexionamos: ¿Doy posada a Cristo y a su familia, la Iglesia, en mi corazón y mi vida? ¿Reconozco cómo viene Cristo a mí? ¿Hago espacio diariamente en oración para recibirllo? ¿Recibo a Cristo devotamente en la Sagrada Eucaristía? ¿Preparo mi alma para recibir a Cristo purificándola en la misericordia y gracia del sacramento de la Reconciliación? ¿Reconozco a Cristo en mi prójimo, especialmente en los necesitados? ¿Comprendo que cada momento es una oportunidad para amar a Cristo? En medio de las muchas distracciones de la vida y la temporada navideña, el Adviento es una oportunidad para acercarse más a nuestro Señor. Esta es un tiempo de preparación para recibir a Jesús nuevamente. Él los ama. Él les extiende su amistad. Él es fuente de esperanza y alegría; Él es el dador de la paz. Recibámolo y adorémoslo.

En medio de todos nuestros preparativos y eventos de diciembre, una vez más, los animo a ser intencionales en mantener a Cristo en el centro de sus celebraciones navideñas. Todas nuestras celebraciones apuntan a Cristo, como nos ha recordado el Papa Benedicto XVI: "Recordemos en particular, al contemplar las calles y las plazas de las ciudades adornadas con luces deslumbrantes, que estas luces nos remiten a otra luz, invisible a los ojos, pero no al corazón. Mientras las admiramos, mientras encendemos las velas en las iglesias o las iluminaciones del pesebre y del árbol de Navidad en nuestras casas, que nuestras almas se abran a la verdadera luz espiritual que llega a todos los hombres de buena voluntad. ¡El Dios-nosotros, nacido en Belén de la Virgen María, es la Estrella de nuestras vidas!" (21 de diciembre de 2005). Continuemos preparándonos con gozo para la celebración del nacimiento de nuestro Salvador, cuya luz de gracia y amor brilla sobre nosotros.






