Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary and has been designated as Respect Life Month. Also during this month is the feast day of St. John Paul II. St. John Paul II was an ardent promoter of the rosary and the Gospel of Life, imploring us to imitate the Blessed Mother in following the will of God and teaching us that the most fundamental principle of Catholic social teaching is the dignity of the human person. Every human being at every stage of life, from conception to natural death, has intrinsic value. Let us pray this month that our society may recognize and revere the dignity of human life as well as defend and protect the most vulnerable.



We also turn our attention to St. Francis of Assisi, whose feast day is this weekend, the fourth of October. St. Francis is commonly known for his life of poverty and love of creation. Because of his love for creation, we invoke St. Francis' intercession when we bless the pets this weekend. His story is very inspiring. He was born in 1181 in Assisi, Italy, and died on October 3, 1226. He was the son of a merchant and enjoyed his father's wealth. After many years of pursuing earthly glories and pleasures, he gradually experienced a conversion and felt called to serve our Lord when he had an experience of Christ while praying before the crucifix in the church of San Damiano. St. Francis renounced his possessions and dedicated his life completely to the service of God and neighbor. He had an ardent devotion to the eucharist and is traditionally known for the first nativity scene. In both the eucharist and the nativity, we remember that our Lord loves us so much that He humbled Himself, descended from the majesty of heaven, and entered our world, our lives, and our poverty, so that He could share with us the riches of His mercy and grace. St. Francis was in awe of the love and humility of God. He conformed his life to Christ and sought to allow it to transform him. The love of God, experienced in the Holy Mass, greatly impacted his life, as is apparent in this segment of one of his letters to the Order of Friars Minor: "Let the whole of mankind tremble, the whole world shake, and the heavens exult when Christ, the Son of the living God, is [present] on the altar in the hands of a priest. O admirable heights and sublime lowliness! O sublime humility! O humble sublimity! That the Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under the little form of bread! Look, brothers, at the humility of God and pour out your hearts before Him! Humble yourselves, as well, that you may be exalted by Him. Therefore, hold back nothing of yourselves for yourselves so that He Who gives Himself totally to you may receive you totally." May we continue to cultivate a love for our Lord in the Holy Eucharist and allow that to strengthen us and transform our lives.



Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El mes de octubre es dedicado al Santo Rosario y ha sido designado como el Mes del Respeto por la Vida. Durante este mes es la festividad de San Juan Pablo II. San Juan Pablo II era un ferviente promotor del rosario y del Evangelio de la Vida, implorándonos a imitar a la Santísima Madre siguiendo la voluntad de Dios y enseñándonos que el principio más fundamental de la enseñanza social católica es la dignidad de la persona humana. Todo ser humano en cada etapa de la vida, desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural, tiene un valor intrínseco. Oremos este mes para que nuestra sociedad reconozca y reverencie la dignidad de la vida humana y defienda y proteja a los más vulnerables.

También dirigimos nuestra atención a San Francisco de Asís, cuyo día festivo es este fin de semana, el cuatro de octubre. San Francisco es conocido por su vida de pobreza y amor a la creación. Por eso invocamos la intercesión de San Francisco cuando bendecimos a las mascotas este domingo. Nació en 1181 en Asís, Italia, y murió el 3 de octubre de 1226. Era hijo de un comerciante y disfrutaba de la riqueza de su padre. Después de muchos años de buscar glorias y placeres terrenales, gradualmente experimentó una conversión y se sintió llamado a servir a nuestro Señor cuando tuvo una experiencia de Cristo mientras rezaba ante el crucifijo en la iglesia de San Damián. San Francisco renunció a sus posesiones y dedicó su vida al servicio de Dios y del prójimo. Tenía una devoción ardiente por la eucaristía y es tradicionalmente conocido por el primer nacimiento navideño o belén. En la eucaristía y en la natividad, recordamos que nuestro Señor nos ama tanto que se humilló, descendió de la majestad del cielo y entró en nuestro mundo, en nuestras vidas y en nuestra pobreza, para compartir con nosotros las riquezas de su misericordia y gracia. San Francisco estaba asombrado por el amor y la humildad de Dios. Conformaba su vida a la de Cristo. El amor de Dios, experimentado en la Santa Misa, transformaba su vida, como se manifiesta en este segmento de una de sus cartas a la Orden de los Frailes Menores: "Todo hombre tema, todo el mundo se estremezca y exulte el cielo, cuando sobre el altar, en las manos del sacerdote, está Cristo, el hijo de Dios vivo. ¡Oh altura admirable y estupenda dignación! ¡Oh humildad sublime! ¡Oh humilde sublimidad, que el Señor Dios del universo e Hijo de Dios se humille de ese modo, hasta esconderse en un pequeño trozo de pan, por nuestra salvación! Miren, hermanos, la humildad de Dios y derramen ante él sus corazones; humíllense también ustedes, para que él los ensalce. No retengan nada pues, para ustedes, para que los acoja totalmente quien se ofrece totalmente a ustedes". Que continuemos cultivando el amor por nuestro Señor en la Sagrada Eucaristía y permitiendo que eso nos fortalezca y transforme nuestras vidas.
