

## A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

## UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Mother's Day! And Happy Good Shepherd Sunday! The Fourth Sunday in Easter is commonly referred to in the Church as Good Shepherd Sunday. The Gospel on this Sunday is always about Christ as the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep and whose sheep know him. When

Pope Benedict XVI was installed as pope, he gave a rather insightful reflection on Christ as shepherd: "He (the Son of God) leaps to his feet and abandons the glory of heaven, in order to go in search of the sheep and pursue it, all the way to the Cross. He takes it upon the shoulders and carries our humanity; he carries us all --He is the good shepherd who lays down his life for the sheep." May we continue to experience the consolation, strength, and grace of our Shepherd.

Christ the Good Shepherd, who has laid down His life for His sheep, has given us the Eucharist as the living memorial of the offering of His body and blood for our salvation and extends it to us to feed us as a shepherd feeds his sheep. I invite you to join us next Sunday, May 18th, as our parish is honored to be a part of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. A group of pilgrims will travel with the Blessed Sacrament from Indianapolis to Los Angeles, making stops throughout the route so that the faithful throughout the country can participate and join together in a common eucharistic devotion in thanksgiving to our Lord present in the holy Eucharist. We will receive the pilgrims and the Blessed Sacrament at the Settles Center (the gym) on Sunday the 18th at 6:30 p.m. and then process to the church, where we will pray evening prayer and have benediction. The church will remain open throughout the night for adoration until 7:00 a.m. Bishop Spies will then celebrate Mass at 7:30 a.m. on Monday the 19th. You can join the pilgrimage to Bishop McNamara's Catholic School campus in Kankakee, where there will be another procession and devotion. After the visit to the school, the pilgrims will continue to Morris and then to the Diocese of Peoria, as they continue to go southwest to Los Angeles. Please join us, and please keep this pilgrimage in your prayers. May our encounter with the love of the Lord, really and truly present in the Holy Eucharist, unite us, set our hearts on fire, and transform our lives and our land.
