Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Corpus Christi! This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, giving honor to Christ our Lord, present in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is the heart of the Christian community. At every Mass, the faithful come together as a family for a sacred banquet to receive the bread of life. In the sixth chapter of the Gospel according to John, the crowds walked away from Jesus when He told them that He Himself is the bread of life that has come down from heaven and that His flesh is true food and His blood is true drink. He fulfilled that teaching at the Last Supper the night before He offered His Body and Blood on the altar of the cross, when He instituted the sacrament of His Body and Blood under the appearances of bread and wine for the altar of the Mass. The greatest act of mercy and love (the crucifixion) has conquered death, and God's love endures forever. In every Mass, the saving love of God is extended to us. Every time we make our offering and approach the altar at Mass, we are united to Christ's offering and approach Christ. In every Mass, we are renewed in our union with Christ; we receive Him. Our food for the journey of life, which can be a long journey, is no ordinary bread, but it is Jesus Himself. Christ walks with us! Christ accompanies us! As we journey together, let us stay close to Christ. Let us receive Him with devotion, humility, and love. He loves you, and He gives Himself to you in this most holy sacrament.

After the 12:00 Mass this Sunday we are having a Eucharistic procession, by which we process outside of the Church with the Blessed Sacrament, the Eucharist. It symbolizes that, forgiven and nourished by Christ, we walk together in Christ, bringing Him into our world to transform it, heal it, and lift it up by His justice, peace, purity, mercy, and love. The act of procession reminds us that we are on a journey together to our heavenly homeland. Like the Israelites who wandered in the desert to the Promised Land, fed only by manna, which was like bread that had fallen from Heaven, we journey toward the Promised Land of Heaven, fed by the true bread that Has come down from Heaven to give us life: Jesus Christ. We give God thanks for the gift of the Holy Eucharist: the sacrament of the love of Christ.

It is a blessing to celebrate this feast day, Mass, and procession with you this weekend, especially as I celebrate the eighteenth anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. It is a great blessing to be your priest and offer the holy Mass for you. Know of my daily prayers for all of you at the Mass, and please continue to pray for me and for one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

¡Feliz Corpus Christi! Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, dando honor a Cristo, presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. La Eucaristía es el corazón de la comunidad cristiana. En cada misa, los fieles se reúnen como una familia para un banquete sagrado, a fin de recibir el Pan de Vida. En el sexto capítulo del evangelio según

San Juan, las multitudes se alejaron de Jesús cuando él les dijo que él mismo es el Pan de Vida que ha bajado del cielo, y que su carne es verdadera comida y su sangre es verdadera bebida. Él cumplió esa enseñanza en la Última Cena, la noche anterior a ofrecer su cuerpo y su sangre en el altar de la cruz, cuando instituyó el sacramento de su cuerpo y su sangre bajo las apariencias de pan y vino para el altar de la misa. El acto más grande de misericordia y amor (la crucifixión) ha vencido a la muerte, y el amor de Dios dura para siempre. En cada misa, el amor salvador de Dios se extiende hacia nosotros. Cada vez que hacemos nuestra ofrenda y nos acercamos al altar durante la misa, nos unimos a la ofrenda de Cristo y nos acercamos a él. En cada misa, somos renovados en nuestra unión con Cristo; lo recibimos a él. Nuestro alimento para el viaje de la vida —que a veces es un camino largo— no es un pan ordinario, sino que es Jesús mismo. ¡Cristo camina con nosotros! ¡Cristo nos acompaña! Mientras caminamos juntos, mantengámonos cerca de Cristo. Recibámoslo con devoción, humildad y amor. Él nos ama y se entrega a nosotros en este santísimo sacramento.

Después de la Misa de las 12:00 de este domingo, tendremos una procesión eucarística, mediante la cual saldremos en procesión fuera de la iglesia con el Santísimo Sacramento: la Eucaristía. Esto simboliza que, perdonados y alimentados por Cristo, caminamos juntos en Cristo, llevándolo a nuestro mundo para transformarlo, sanarlo y elevarlo mediante su justicia, paz, pureza, misericordia y amor. El acto de la procesión nos recuerda que estamos en un viaje conjunto hacia nuestra patria celestial. Al igual que los israelitas, que peregrinaron por el desierto hacia la Tierra Prometida — alimentados con el maná, que era como un pan caído del cielo— nosotros caminamos hacia la Tierra Prometida del Cielo, alimentados por el verdadero pan que ha bajado del cielo para darnos vida: Jesucristo. Damos gracias a Dios por el don de la Santa Eucaristía: el sacramento del amor de Cristo.

Es una bendición celebrar con ustedes este día de fiesta, la misa y la procesión este fin de semana; especialmente al conmemorar el decimoctavo aniversario de mi ordenación sacerdotal. Es una gran bendición ser su sacerdote y ofrecer la santa misa por ustedes. Tengan la certeza de mis oraciones diarias por todos ustedes durante la misa y, por favor, continúen rezando por mí y los unos por los otros.

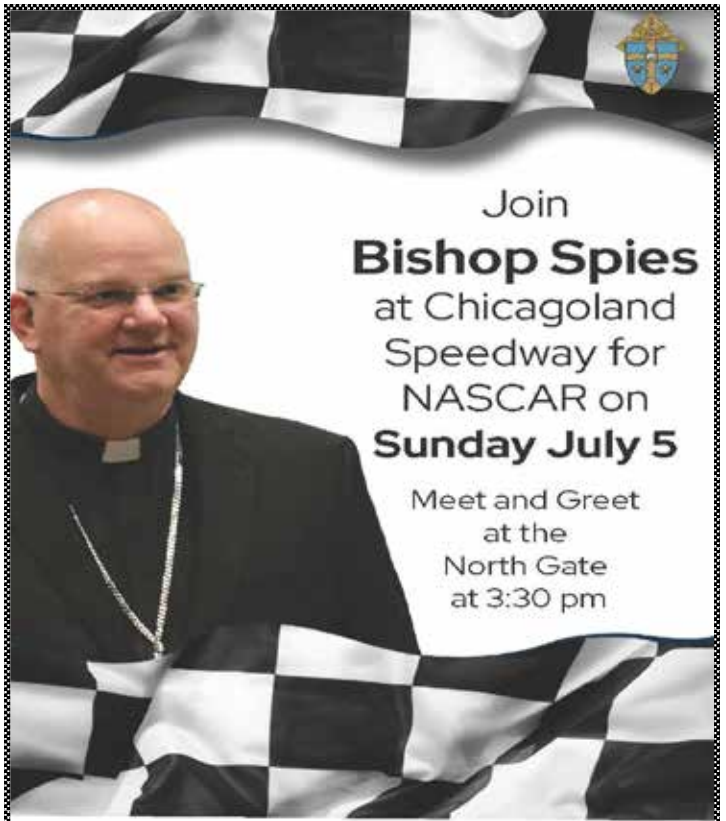

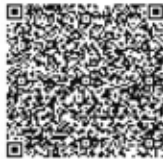
