Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

In our Gospel reading this weekend, our Lord speaks of both mighty deeds – “There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us.” – and small deeds – “Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward.” What do both statements share in common? Christ. The mighty deeds are done in the name of the Lord, and the smaller works are done for Christ. We are called to live for Christ. Our Lord in the Gospel admonishes us not to sin or to cause others to sin. In the second letter, St. James warns us against living for ourselves and our own contentment in such a way that we ignore or mistreat those around us and ultimately neglect the Lord. It is a temptation to see faith as one aspect among many aspects of one’s life. However, faith is essential and transformative. It opens our hearts to Christ daily in such a way that it transforms us and shapes us. It brings grace, peace, mercy, healing, and hope. It brings us together in our common journey on this earth to heaven. Having received Christ through Baptism and Holy Communion, let us stay close to Christ each day in prayer and follow Him as the Lord of our lives, our hearts, and our homes. Let us ask ourselves: Is Christ the foundation of my life? Do I follow Him here on earth so as to receive the prize of heaven? Is He an essential part of my life or only a part of my life at convenient times? Are my decisions and values formed by the faith? Being honest in this examination, let us stay close to our Lord and follow Him so that all that we do in word and in work may give glory to the Lord.

Abre nuestros corazones a Cristo diariamente de tal manera que nos transforma y nos forma. Trae gracia, paz, misericordia, sanación y esperanza. Nos une en nuestro viaje común en esta tierra hacia el cielo. Habiendo recibido a Cristo por medio del Bautismo y la Sagrada Comunión, permanezcamos cerca de Cristo cada día en la oración y sigámoslo como el Señor de nuestras vidas, corazones y hogares. Preguntémonos: ¿Es Cristo el fundamento de mi vida? ¿Lo sigo aquí en la tierra para recibir el premio del cielo? ¿Es Él una parte esencial de mi vida o solo una parte de mi vida en momentos convenientes? ¿Mis decisiones y valores están formados por la fe?
