

A MAY LIKE NO OTHER

In the midst of the peculiar reality that we are facing as a community, and as a country (world?) these days, the days continue to pass by, and we have to continue to find ways to be engaged in our faith and unite spiritually as a community.

May is a very special month in church. It is usually packed with all kinds of activities, like May crowning events, Mother's Day festivities, First Communions and Confirmations, Ordinations and Cinco de Mayo fiestas. This year, we also anticipated the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the birth of St. John Paul II.

But this year's May is proving to be a very different kind of May. First communions and confirmations have been postponed. May crowning will be done by the priests, who are still celebrating inside the church without the people, except those who are participating and connecting in social media. Ordinations have been postponed for a later date in June. The Cinco de mayo will not be held in our grounds; I know something simple is being considered. And the celebration of our patron's 100th birthday will be observed liturgically and spiritually, but the actual celebration of this milestone will be considered for the fall season, God permitting. Instead, we have online livestreams of our masses, Breakfast with Jesus covering various topics and points of interest, Bible Studies online, prayer sessions online, Hispanic teachings online, and everything else of human encounter happens a lot in online chatrooms and video conferences with Zoom and Facebook. This is a May that we have never seen before.

Even then, the Mary month of May can be celebrated with your family at home. May you find time to pray the rosary together as a family during this month. May you take time to crown a statue of Mary in your house, of offer some flowers at her altar. May you find time now more than ever before, to join us in our daily masses, and especially in our upcoming novena for St. John Paul II. Join us in praying for our mothers; I am sure that this stay-home time will not stop us from honoring our mothers in the best way that we can. And, let us continue to pray for Deacon Michael Groth and his family as he prepares for his ordination which has been moved to a new schedule on June 20, 2020. Let us also continue to help our young in their walk of faith. I know that our catechists are following up on each of our children, and we are going to remain in touch with them as the new dates for the sacraments of first communion and confirmation are being decided.

MEMORIAL MASS. During this COV-19 Pandemic, there are many people who have suffered, and many people who have died. We will offer a special Holy Mass for them, and for our own parishioners who have died not having the Rites of Christian Funeral in our church during this pandemic. The memorial mass is scheduled for May 8, at 7:00 PM. Please join us in our livestream broadcast for this solemn mass for the departed.

Dear parishioners, I pray that you all remain healthy, happy and holy, now more than ever before.

En medio de la realidad peculiar que estamos enfrentando como comunidad y como país (¿Mundo?), los días siguen pasando, y tenemos que seguir encontrando formas de estar comprometidos en nuestra fe y unidos espiritualmente como comunidad.

Mayo es un mes muy especial en la iglesia. Usualmente está repleto con todo tipo de actividades, como la corona-

ción de mayo, el Día de las Madres, primeras comuniones y confirmaciones, ordenaciones y fiesta del 5 de Mayo. Este año, también anticipamos la celebración del 100^o aniversario del nacimiento de San Juan Pablo II.

Sin embargo, el mayo de este año está demostrando ser uno muy diferente. Las primeras comuniones y confirmaciones han sido pospuestas. La coronación de mayo será hecha por los sacerdotes, quienes siguen celebrando en la iglesia, sin la gente, excepto quienes están participando y conectándose en las redes sociales. Las ordenaciones han sido pospuestas para junio. El Cinco de Mayo no se celebrará en nuestros terrenos; sé que se está considerando algo sencillo. Y la celebración del 100^o cumpleaños de nuestro patrono será observada litúrgica y espiritualmente, pero la celebración real de este acontecimiento será considerada para la temporada de otoño, si Dios lo permite. En cambio, tenemos transmisiones en vivo de nuestras misas, Desayuno con Jesús que cubre varios temas y puntos de interés, Estudios Bíblicos en línea, sesiones de oración en línea, enseñanzas hispanas en línea, y todo lo demás del encuentro humano sucede mucho en los chats en línea y video conferencias con Zoom y Facebook. Este es un mayo que nunca antes habíamos visto.

Aun así, el mes de mayo de María puede ser celebrado en casa, con su familia. Que puedan encontrar el tiempo para rezar el Rosario juntos, como familia, durante este mes. Que se tomen el tiempo para coronar una estatua de María en su casa, de ofrecerle algunas flores en su altar. Que encuentren más tiempo ahora que nunca antes para acompañarnos en nuestras misas diarias y, especialmente, en nuestra próxima novena para San Juan Pablo II. Acompañennos orando por nuestras madres; estoy seguro que este tiempo de quedarse-en-casa no nos detendrá de honrar a nuestras madres de la mejor manera que podamos. Y, continuemos orando por el Diácono Michael Groth y su familia mientras se prepara para su ordenación, la cual ha sido cambiada para el 20 junio, 2020. 


