"Here I am," I said; "send me!"

"Aquí estoy, Señor, envíame!"



"Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man!"

"Apártate de mí, Señor, porque soy un pecador!"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's first reading, Isaiah responded to the Lord, "Here I am; send me!" In the Gospel, Jesus called His first Apostles: after a dramatic catch of fish, our Lord said to the fishermen, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." They left everything they had and immediately followed Jesus. I think of my own response to following God's call in my life. I still get asked the question: "Father, when did you know you were going to be a priest?" People often want to know not only when, but how. It is first important to recall that the word vocation comes from the Latin word *vocare*, which means "to call". One cannot know one's vocation if he does not listen, if he does not hear God calling, if he does not pay attention to God speaking to the depths of the heart. Prayer and self-awareness are essential parts of discernment. When I was a sophomore in high school, after meeting seminarians and hearing the stories of young men who were willing to give their lives to Christ and His Church, the idea of the priesthood stayed on my mind and in my heart. I couldn't shake it. So, I entered seminary immediately after high school. When preparing for the priesthood, the more I got to know our Lord and His Church and the more I prayed, studied, and was active in the parish, the more I fell in love with our Lord and His Church and felt drawn in the direction of the parish priesthood. There are young men in this parish who are called to the priesthood. There are also men and women in this parish who are called to the religious life. There are many men and women in this parish called to holy matrimony. All of these vocations, these callings, work together to build up the Church. We are all called to holiness and to help each other live holy and virtuous lives. Just as engaged couples often go to married couples for advice, I want to encourage those who are thinking about the priesthood or religious life to speak with one of the priests, deacons, or sisters. Discernment does not happen alone, and there are many resources to help one to discern God's will. Let us continue to strive to follow God's will in our daily lives, and let us encourage our sons and daughters in our parish to use their gifts for a great purpose in every state of life (married, consecrated, ordained): for the building up of the Kingdom of God. Please continue to pray for one another, and know of my continued prayers for you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En la primera lectura de hoy, Isaías respondió al Señor: "Aquí estoy, Señor, ¡envíame!" En el Evangelio, Jesús llamó a sus primeros apóstoles: después de una pesca dramática, nuestro Señor les dijo a Simón Pedro y a los pescadores: "No temas; desde ahora serás pescador de hombres." Dejaron todo e inmediatamente siguieron a Jesús. Pienso en mi propia respuesta al llamado de Dios en mi vida. Todavía personas me preguntan: "Padre, ¿cuándo supo que iba a ser sacerdote?" Muchas veces quieren saber no sólo cuándo, sino cómo. Primero es importante recordar que la palabra vocación proviene de la palabra latina *vocare*, que significa "llamar". Uno no puede saber su vocación si no escucha el llamado de Dios, si no presta atención a Dios hablándole a lo profundo del corazón. La oración y la autoconciencia son partes esenciales del discernimiento. Cuando yo era estudiante de segundo año en la escuela secundaria, después de conocer a los seminaristas y escuchar las historias de jóvenes que estaban dispuestos a dedicar sus vidas a Cristo y a su Iglesia, la idea del sacerdocio permaneció en mi mente y en mi corazón. No podía quitármela. Por eso ingresé al seminario cuando tenía 18 años. Cuanto más conocía a nuestro Señor y su Iglesia y cuanto más oraba, estudiaba y participaba activamente en la parroquia, más me enamoraba nuestro Señor y su Iglesia y me sentía atraído en la dirección del sacerdocio parroquial. Hay jóvenes en esta parroquia que son llamados al sacerdocio. En esta parroquia también hay hombres y mujeres llamados a la vida religiosa. Hay muchos hombres y mujeres llamados al santo matrimonio. Todas estas vocaciones, estos llamados, trabajan juntos para edificar la Iglesia. Todos estamos llamados a la santidad y a ayudarnos unos a otros a vivir vidas santas y virtuosas. Así como las parejas comprometidas acuden a las parejas casadas en busca de consejo, quiero animar a aquellos que están pensando en el sacerdocio o la vida religiosa a hablar con uno de los sacerdotes, diáconos o hermanas. El discernimiento no ocurre solo, y hay muchos recursos para ayudar a discernir la voluntad de Dios. Sigamos esforzándonos por seguir la voluntad de Dios en nuestras vidas diarias, y animemos a nuestros hijos e hijas de nuestra parroquia a usar sus dones para un gran propósito en cada estado de vida (casados, consagrados, ordenados): para la edificación del Reino de Dios. Por favor, continúen orando los unos por los otros y conozcan mis oraciones por ustedes.






