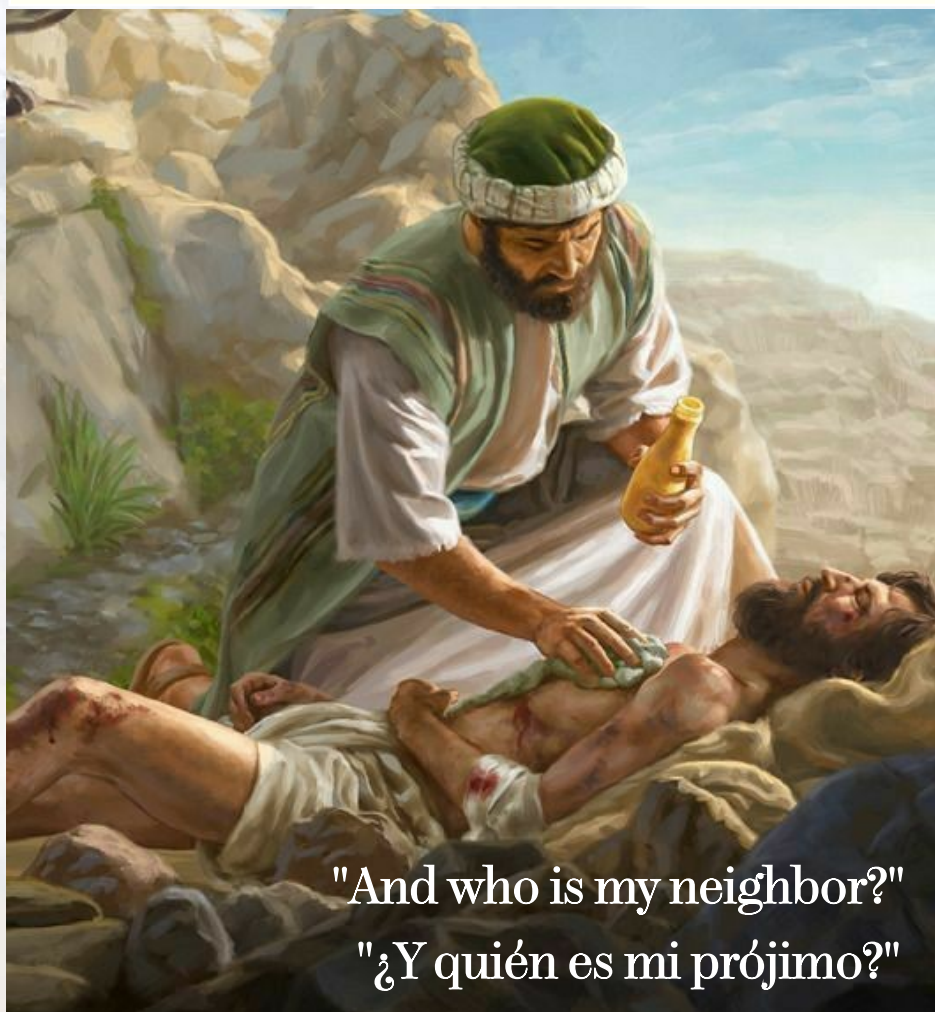

When I was twenty days old, my parents brought my twin sister and me to the church to be baptized. They continued to bring us to God by praying with us and bringing us to Church. The Church was always a part of our lives and a home for my family. Even when on vacation, we attended Mass at the local Catholic church. I have always felt at home in the church, even if the language of the Mass or the people were different. After all, the church leads us to our true homeland in heaven and unites us together in the love of God.

This is the mission of the Church: to unite us in the mercy, charity, and love of God. I encourage you to look at the parish through this lens. How powerful it is when families and neighbors experience the love of God through the sacraments and the community of the Church. How wonderful it is when we grow closer to God together. I am grateful for the gift that my home parish has been in my life. May we continue to make our parish a gift for generations to come. Let us be intentional in inviting others, sharing it with others, and being active in the life of the parish so that we can together grow in mercy and love on our journey to our heavenly homeland.
