Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As summer begins to wane and students soon return to school, we think back to past summer vacations, Fourth of July holidays spent with family and friends, and time outdoors under the sun. Everybody needs a break. We are not made to work twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Not only are annual vacations and holidays throughout the year important for us, but for us Catholics, the Lord's Day is critical. Sunday is our day of rest. Every Sunday, we remember that first Easter Sunday, when our Lord conquered sin and death by rising from the dead, and we celebrate that day together with the very sacrament our Lord instituted as He began the work of redemption: the Holy Eucharist. Sunday is meant to be set aside as time for God and family. It is tempting to approach Sunday like any other day or to fill the day with chores and tasks left over from the week's to-do list. However, we need that day of rest, spending it in charity: loving God and neighbor.

I would also like to encourage you to give yourself a break each day, to recharge the soul through prayer. The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines prayer as "the elevation of the mind and heart to God in praise of his glory; a petition made to God for some desired good, or in thanksgiving for a good received, or in intercession for others before God." In her autobiography, St. Therese of Lisieux wrote, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." When we look toward heaven and lift up our hearts to God, we approach that throne of grace by which a weary soul receives refreshment. It is like going to the well, and our Lord extends to us the very same life-giving water that will bubble up within us and last forever that he promised to the Samaritan woman. Let us take a break each day and turn to our Lord in prayer. There we can gain peace, hope, mercy, wisdom, and joy. So I encourage you to find time each day or throughout the day for prayer. Then, the prayer of St. Augustine will ring true for each of us: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord. And our heart is restless until it rests in you."

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Mientras el verano pasa y los estudiantes pronto regresan a la escuela, recordamos las vacaciones de los veranos pasados, las fiestas del cuatro de julio con familiares y amigos y el tiempo al aire libre bajo el sol. Todo el mundo necesita un descanso. No estamos hechos para trabajar veinticuatro horas al día, siete días a la semana. Las vacaciones anuales y los días festivos durante el año son importantes para nosotros más sin embargo, para nosotros los católicos, el Día del Señor es crítico. El domingo es nuestro día de descanso. Todos los domingos, recordamos el primer domingo de Pascua cuando nuestro Señor venció el pecado y la muerte por resucitar de entre los muertos y celebramos ese domingo con el mismo sacramento que nuestro Señor instituyó cuando comenzó la obra de redención: la Sagrada Eucaristía. El domingo debe reservarse como tiempo para Dios y la familia. Es una tentación de vivir el domingo como cualquier otro día, o llenar el día con trabajo. Sin embargo, necesitamos ese día de descanso, gastándolo en caridad: amar a Dios y al prójimo.

También me gustaría animarles a tomarse un descanso cada día, para recargar el alma a través de la oración. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica define la oración como "la elevación del alma hacia Dios o la petición a Dios de bienes convenientes." En su autobiografía, Santa Teresa de Lisieux escribió: "Para mí, la oración es un impulso del corazón, una sencilla mirada lanzada hacia el cielo, un grito de agradecimiento y de amor tanto dentro de la prueba como dentro de la alegría." Cuando miramos hacia el cielo y elevamos nuestros corazones hacia Dios, nos acercamos al trono de gracia mediante el cual un alma cansada recibe descanso y paz. Vamos a la fuente de nuestro Señor quien nos ofrece la misma agua vivificante que prometió a la mujer samaritana. Tomemos un descanso cada día y vamos a nuestro Señor en oración. Allí podemos ganar paz, esperanza, misericordia, sabiduría y alegría. Por eso les invito a reservar tiempo cada día o durante todo el día para orar. Luego la oración de San Agustín nos tocará a cada uno de nosotros: "Nos hiciste, Señor, para ti; y nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descanse en ti".

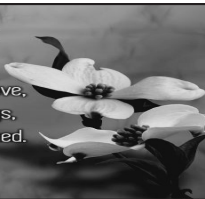

In following Jesus to Jerusalem, the disciples notice his praying and ask for help to do the same. Today, he gives them and us the Lord's Prayer. In the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*, this same prayer is not formally given to the elect until the midst of Lent. It is given as summary of all the praying they have done in their many months of preparation for being buried with Jesus at Baptism during the Easter Vigil. It is also the model for praying they will do it forever.

- How will I let the mercy works of forgiving injuries and bearing wrongs patiently fill my prayer in order to guide my actions?

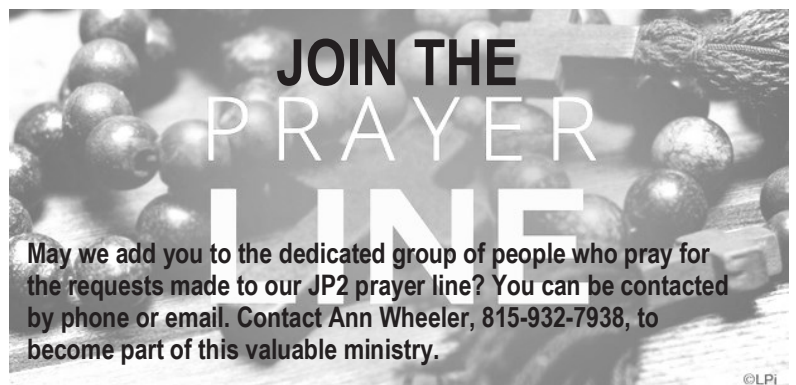

With the summer temperatures climbing it is important to take precautions, especially if you are working outside or without air conditioning. Stay hydrated, take breaks, and check on the elderly and pets.

HEAT EXHAUSTION	OR	HEAT STROKE
Faint or dizzy		Throbbing headache
Excessive sweating		No sweating
Cool, pale, clammy skin		Body temperature above 103° Red, hot, dry skin
Nausea or vomiting		Nausea or vomiting
Rapid, weak pulse		Rapid, strong pulse
Muscle cramps		May lose consciousness

- Get to a cooler, air conditioned place
- Drink water if fully conscious
- Take a cool shower or use cold compresses

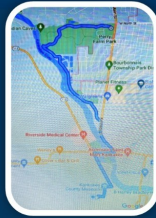
