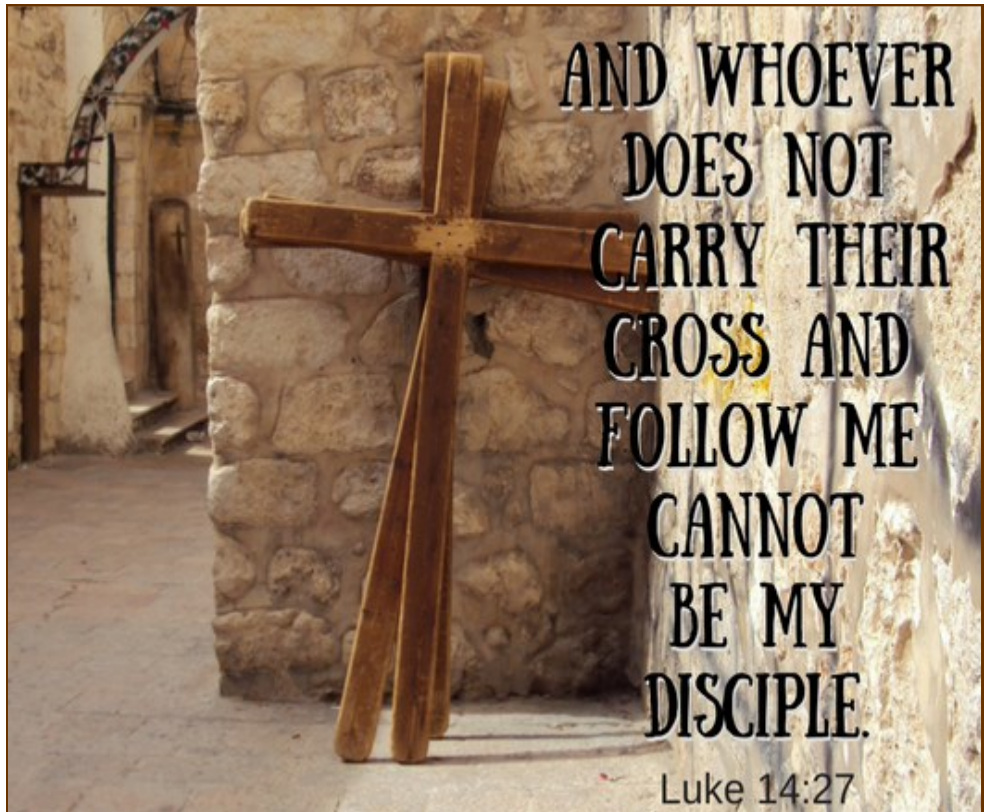

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In our psalm this weekend, we pray, "In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge. Fill us at daybreak with your kindness, that we may shout for joy and gladness all our days. And may the gracious care of the Lord our God be ours..." We remember our Lord's goodness and faithfulness, the salvation He has won for us through His cross and resurrection, and the grace He continues to shower down upon us through the sacraments. We turn to our Lord, who is our hope, our refuge, and our strength, who lightens our days.

When writing about the parish in *Evangelii Gaudium*, Pope Francis said that the parish "is a community of communities, a sanctuary where the thirsty come to drink in the midst of their journey, and a center of constant missionary outreach" (28). In my own experience, the parish has always helped me to find refuge in the Lord, particularly through the sacraments and the friendships and community formed by the faith. I pray that we may continue to find rest and refreshment in the life of our parish and form a community where people can find rest and nourishment in the love of Christ and the joy of the Gospel.

I hope that you will be able to join us next Saturday the tenth for the annual Mexican Independence Day Celebration. It is a fun event for the entire community. After the 9:30 am Mass on Sunday the eleventh, there will be donuts and hospitality. I know that we often have our routines and weekly breakfast plans, but I encourage you to spend a few extra minutes in fellowship with one another.

Many programs are beginning anew. Among them are the book club and GIFT (Growing in Faith Together). Encuentros Juveniles has a couple of Spanish speaking retreats coming up within the next month, and the CCW Champagne Brunch will be on Sunday the 18th. Also, as our Faith Formation Program begins, let us continue to pray for our students and catechists. May our youth come to better know our Lord Jesus Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life, as well as discover His love and grace. If you have not yet registered your child for faith formation, please do so soon.

Know of my continued prayers for you. Let us continue to pray for one another.

An excerpt from a message from His Holiness Pope Francis

"The sweet song of creation invites us to practice an "ecological spirituality" (Laudato Si', 216) attentive to God's presence in the natural world. It is a summons to base our spirituality on the "loving awareness that we are not disconnected from the rest of creatures, but joined in a splendid universal communion" (ibid., 220). For the followers of Christ in particular, this luminous experience reinforces our awareness that "all things came into being through him, and without him, not one thing came into being" (Jn 1:3). In this Season of Creation, we pray once more in the great cathedral of creation, and revel in the "grandiose cosmic choir" (2) made up of countless creatures, all singing the praises of God.

Let us join Saint Francis of Assisi in singing: "Praise be to you, my Lord, for all your creatures" (cf. *Canticle of Brother Sun*). Let us join the psalmist in singing, "Let everything that breathes praise the Lord!" (Ps 150:6)
