Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus says in today's Gospel reading: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world... Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." Jesus went to the cross, offering Himself as the perfect and unblemished sacrifice so that this perfect act of love may defeat the division and separation that are the results of sin and death and thus bring us into union, or friendship, with God now and for eternity. The night before Jesus offered His body and blood on the cross, He took bread and wine and said, "This is my body... This is the chalice of my blood..." He instituted the sacrament of His most holy Body and Blood, the Holy Eucharist, so as to extend to us his perfect and eternal love, which has moved Him to offer His body and blood for our salvation, remaining with us, strengthening us, and sustaining us now and forever.

How good it is that Jesus remains in us and we in Him! We are a community, a parish family, because of Christ. Jesus has united us to Him and in Him through Baptism and brings us together and strengthens our union through the holy Mass. As we live out that union with our Lord, I would like you to join the community for our Marian Procession and Parish Picnic today, Sunday, following the 11:30 Mass. Also, please pray for our students and teachers as school begins. Know of my prayers for you, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Here is what your 5 month spiritually adopted baby is doing right now. Please keep praying!

Your spiritually adopted baby weighs over one pound now. His mother can feel him moving now. Before he was too small for her to feel. Although he swam with ease in his watery world, he needed to be big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it—the inside wall of the uterus has no feeling. We are mid-way through the pregnancy now. Your prayers have helped your baby's mother continue with her pregnancy and seek the help she needs.

Ya es lo suficientemente grande y fuerte como para dar fuertes patadas a la pared externa del útero y dejar su huella. Han sobrevivido bebés que han nacido a esta etapa de desarrollo prenatal.

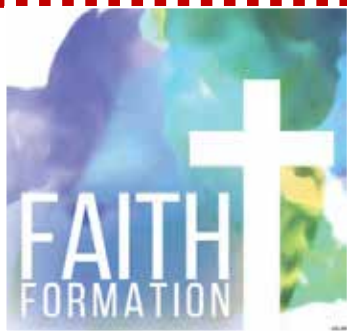
