Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel for the next four weeks will be from Jesus' Bread of Life discourse in the sixth chapter of the Gospel according to St. John. Jesus teaches us that He is the bread that has been sent down from heaven to give life to the world. May we continue to recognize Jesus who is the Bread of Life, who gives Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. St. John Vianney, whose feast day is today, reminded us of the inestimable value of the Holy Eucharist: "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." To reflect on this great gift, I would like to share with you a reflection on this passage from Pope Benedict XVI.

The first element of eucharistic faith is the mystery of God himself, trinitarian love. In Jesus' dialogue with Nicodemus, we find an illuminating expression in this regard: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him" (Jn 3:16-17). These words show the deepest source of God's gift. In the Eucharist Jesus does not give us a "thing," but himself; he offers his own body and pours out his own blood. He thus gives us the totality of his life and reveals the ultimate origin of this love. He is the eternal Son, given to us by the Father. In the Gospel we hear how Jesus, after feeding the crowds by multiplying the loaves and fishes, says to those who had followed him to the synagogue of Capernaum: "My Father gives you the true bread from heaven; for the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven, and gives life to the world" (Jn 6:32-33), and even identifies himself, his own flesh and blood, with that bread: "I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh" (Jn 6:51). Jesus thus shows that he is the bread of life which the eternal Father gives to mankind. (Pope Benedict XVI, *Sacramentum Caritatis*, 7).



Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

El evangelio de las próximas cuatro semanas será del discurso del Pan de Vida de Jesús, tomado del sexto capítulo del evangelio según San Juan. Jesús nos enseña que Él es el pan que ha sido enviado desde el cielo para dar vida al mundo. Sigamos reconociendo a Jesús, quien es el Pan de Vida, que se nos entrega en la Eucaristía. San Juan María Vianney, cuya festividad es hoy, nos recordó el valor de la Sagrada Eucaristía: "No hay nada tan grande como la Eucaristía. Si Dios tuviera algo más precioso, nos lo habría dado". Para reflexionar sobre este gran don, me gustaría compartir con ustedes una reflexión sobre este pasaje del Papa Benedicto XVI.

En Cristo,

El primer elemento de la fe eucarística es el misterio de Dios mismo, el amor trinitario. En el diálogo de Jesús con Nicodemo, encontramos una expresión iluminadora a este respecto: «Tanto amó Dios al mundo, que entregó a su único Hijo, para que todo el que crea en Él no perezca, sino que tenga vida eterna. Porque Dios envió al Hijo al mundo, no para condenar al mundo, sino para que el mundo se salve a través de Él» (Jn 3,16-17). Estas palabras muestran la fuente más profunda del don de Dios. En la Eucaristía, Jesús no da « algo », sino a sí mismo; ofrece su cuerpo y derrama su propia sangre. Entrega así toda su vida, manifestando la fuente original de este amor divino. Él es el Hijo eterno, a quien el Padre ha entregado por nosotros. En el Evangelio también escuchamos como Jesús, después de haber alimentado a la multitud con la multiplicación de los panes y los peces, dice a los que le habían seguido a la sinagoga de Cafarnaún: « Es mi Padre el que les da el verdadero pan del cielo. Porque el pan de Dios es el que baja del cielo y da la vida al mundo » (Jn 6,32-33); e incluso se identifica a sí mismo, su propia carne y sangre, con ese pan: « Yo soy el pan vivo que ha bajado del cielo; el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré para la vida del mundo es mi carne » (Jn 6,51). Jesús muestra así que Él es el pan de vida que el Padre eterno da a los hombres. (Papa Benedicto XVI, *Sacramentum Caritatis*, 7).

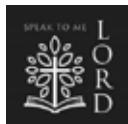
