A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Merry Christmas! Today we celebrate New Year's Day, World Day of Prayer for Peace, and the Octave (Eighth) Day of Christmas: the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. As we begin this new year, we look at the beginning of the Gospel, and our attention is drawn to the Holy Family and the birth of our Savior. On the eighth day of Christmas, after a week had passed since the birth of the Christ, Mary and Joseph brought our Lord Jesus Christ to be circumcised and gave Him His name, as was customary according to the Law. When we reflect upon the Holy Family and the baby Jesus, we see the rather humble and ordinary beginnings of our salvation. The Lord has entered into the ordinariness of our world. God became a member of a human family and the whole human family so that we may form a new family, united in the love of the Holy Trinity and made one as the Church.

In a special way today, we honor Mary, who shows us what it means to love and follow Jesus. She understood Jesus' mission. After all, because of her "yes" to the will of God, it was in her womb that God united humanity to Himself. She loved Jesus as only a mother could. She accompanied Him throughout His life and ministry. She stood at the foot of the cross and rejoiced at the news of the Resurrection. She was with the Apostles when the Holy Spirit descended upon them on Pentecost, the beginning of the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ. She was filled with joy to receive her Son in the Holy Eucharist. As the mother of Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary was there, loving Jesus at every moment and reflecting on all that took place in her heart. As the mother of all Christians, Mary loves us who are united to Her Son with a mother's love and helps us to be one with her Son and Savior. Like Mary, may we reflect in our hearts all that Jesus has done and is doing. May we receive Him with great love and love Him greatly at all times. As we begin a new year, may our reflections imitate the reflections of Mary. May we respond to the presence and work of God in our daily lives, and may we be brought closer to Christ. Know of my prayers for all of you, and I ask the Lord to bless you abundantly as we begin this new year with the blessing found in our first reading: "The Lord bless you and keep you! The Lord let his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you! The Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!"






