Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

The intention of the pope during the month of July is for the pastoral care of the sick: “We pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick confer to those who receive it and their loved ones the power of the Lord and become ever more a visible sign of compassion and hope for all.” In our Gospel this weekend, we read about our Lord sending out the apostles two by two. St. Mark recounts, “They went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them” (Mk. 6:13). They anointed with oil many who were sick. Later in Holy Scripture, St. James instructs us: “Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven” (James 5:14-15). The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is often forgotten, but it is a powerful sacrament that gives peace and grace. It reminds us that we are not alone. When we request the sacrament of the anointing of the sick, we are inviting the Church to accompany us, being anointed by the oil blessed by the bishop. Being anointed on the head and the hands, we recall the wounds of Christ on the cross and so unite our sufferings to Christ, who has suffered with us and for us and conquered suffering, giving us hope. If you or a loved one are seriously ill, please do not hesitate to call a priest. In case of an emergency, there is a particular extension when you call the parish office for such cases. Let us continue to look to the Lord who gives us grace, peace, and hope. Remaining close to our Lord, who constantly shows us His mercy and kindness through the holy sacraments of the Church, we echo the words of today’s psalm in prayer: Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation. Know of my continued prayers for you. Please continue to pray for me and one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El Papa tiene una intención de oración cada mes. Durante el mes de julio, el Papa Francisco nos invita a rezar por “el cuidado pastoral de los enfermos”, para que el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos dé a quienes lo reciben y a sus seres queridos la fuerza del Señor. En nuestro Evangelio del domingo, nuestro Señor envía a los apóstoles de dos en dos. San Marcos cuenta: “Los discípulos se fueron a predicar el arrepentimiento. Expulsaban a los demonios, ungían con aceite a los enfermos y los curaban.” (Mc 6,13) Ungían con aceite a los enfermos. Más adelante en las Escrituras, Santiago nos instruye: “¿Hay alguno enfermo? Que llame a los presbíteros de la Iglesia, que oren por él y lo unjan con aceite en el nombre del Señor. La oración hecha con fe salvará al que no puede levantarse y el Señor hará que se levante; y si ha cometido pecados, se le perdonarán.” (Santiago 5:14-15) El sacramento de la unción de los enfermos a veces es olvidado, pero es un sacramento poderoso que da paz y gracia. Nos recuerda que no estamos solos ni abandonados. Cuando solicitamos el sacramento de la unción de los enfermos, estamos invitando a la Iglesia a acompañarnos, siendo ungidos con el aceite bendecido por el obispo. Ungidos en la cabeza y en las manos, recordamos las llagas de Cristo en la cruz y unimos nuestros sufrimientos a Cristo, quien sufrió con nosotros y por nosotros y venció el sufrimiento dándonos esperanza. Si usted o un ser querido está gravemente enfermo, no dude en llamar a un sacerdote. En caso de emergencia, existe una extensión particular cuando llamen a la oficina parroquial para estos casos. Sigamos mirando al Señor que nos da gracia, paz y esperanza. Permaneciendo cerca de nuestro Señor, que constantemente nos muestra su misericordia y bondad a través de los sacramentos de la Iglesia, recemos la oración de las palabras del salmo de hoy: Muéstranos, Señor, tu misericordia. Conozcan mis continuas oraciones por ustedes. Por favor sigan orando por mí y por los demás.




