Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Gospel from Mark 6:30-34 concludes, "When he (Jesus) disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things." Jesus is the Good Shepherd who loves us. At times we can go astray; sometimes we can drift through life or become distracted. Christ, the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep, never abandons us. He cares for us and wants us to be gathered together with Him. He has done so in our lives first by uniting us to Himself in baptism and bringing us together as a Church, feeding us in the Holy Eucharist, restoring our relationship in Confession, and calling us to be united in Him in heaven for all eternity. Pope Benedict XVI said it well at his first Mass as Pope when he preached about Jesus as the Good Shepherd: "He leaps to his feet and abandons the glory of heaven, in order to go in search of the sheep and pursue it, all the way to the Cross. He takes it upon his shoulders and carries our humanity; he carries us all – he is the good shepherd who lays down his life for the sheep." Christ is the one who carries us still. Let us stay close to our Lord. Let us listen to the voice of the Shepherd in prayer, Scripture, and the teachings of the Church; let us be cared for by our Shepherd through the sacraments; and let us follow our Shepherd in the way of virtue and charity.

Know of my prayers for you, and please continue to pray for me, for all priests and bishops who shepherd us, and for one another.

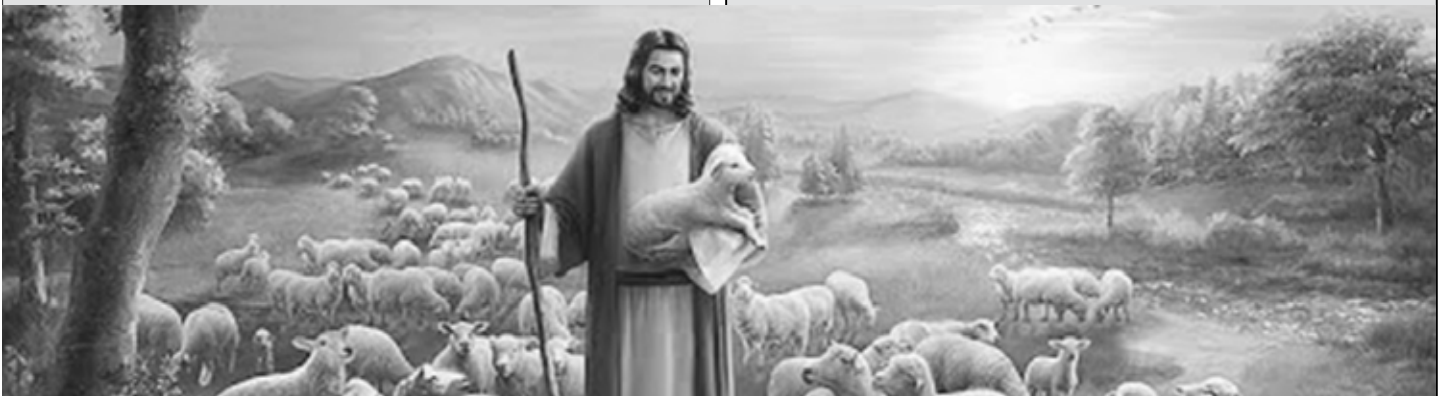


Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

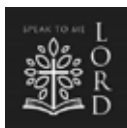

Here is what your 3 month spiritually adopted baby is doing right now. Please keep praying! Well, your little baby now weighs 6 ounces. He has fingernails and eyelashes. He has his own unique fingerprints which will remain unchanged throughout his life. His taste buds are working. His sense of hearing is present at 14 weeks. There are no major bodily developments anymore. Your spiritually adopted baby is already well-formed, internally and externally. All he needs now is time to gain weight and grow strong !



Programa de Adopción Espiritual

Tamaño: cerca de 9 pulgadas; peso: cerca de 6 onzas. El cerebro del bebé ha comenzado a madurar – un proceso que continuará hasta los 14 años. Los párpados están ahora cerrados y se abrirán durante el séptimo mes de embarazo. Ya tiene su paladar. Los alimentos que ingiere su madre, los recibe en una o dos horas. El bebé recibe diariamente trescientos litros de líquido a través del cordón umbilical. Comienzan a crecerle el cabello, las cejas y las pestañas. Se pueden apreciar ahora expresiones faciales parecidas a las de sus padres. Durante esta etapa de su desarrollo los doctores han grabado el movimiento rápido de sus ojos (REM- Rapid eye movement), una señal de que duerme y sueña.
