Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus multiplied five loaves and two fish to feed five thousand men. The event began with our Lord in a humble position: He looked up from His place on the mountain and saw vast crowds coming. Even though the disciples doubted that they would be able to feed the crowd, our Lord used the humble offering of a young boy who had five loaves and two fish. Jesus instructed the thousands to recline on the grass, like sheep being fed by their shepherd. He took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them, like he would later do at the Last Supper when He instituted the Eucharist (Eucharist is the Greek word for "to give thanks") and as our Lord does at every Mass.

After they had their fill, there were twelve wicker baskets full of fragments; our Lord's grace is abundant. Sometimes it is hard for us to be patient or to trust in God's care for us. We can look at a situation and doubt, and yet God is our humble and loving Shepherd who feeds His flock. As we come before the Lord and make our humble offering of bread and wine at Mass, let us recognize Christ who is present, offering Himself, giving refreshment and life to our souls.

After this event, Jesus continued to teach them that He is the true bread that has come down from heaven and that we will not have life within us unless we eat His flesh and drink His blood. This teaching, which is often referred to as the Bread of Life Discourse, was fulfilled at the Last Supper when Jesus instituted the Eucharist, the sacrament of His body and blood. The Gospel for the next four Sundays will be taken from the Bread of Life Discourse in the sixth chapter of John. I encourage you to take some time reading this chapter and spending time with our Lord, who has the words of everlasting life and is really and truly present in the Holy Eucharist. Know of my prayers for you at the altar of the Lord, and let us continue to keep one another in prayer.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús multiplicó cinco panes de cebada y dos pescados para alimentar a cinco mil hombres. El evento comenzó con nuestro Señor en una posición humilde: levantó Su vista desde Su lugar en la montaña y vio una gran multitud. Aunque los discípulos dudaron que pudieran alimentar a la multitud, nuestro Señor usó la humilde ofrenda de un muchacho que tenía cinco panes y dos pescados. Jesús instruyó a las miles de personas a sentarse en la hierba, como ovejas siendo alimentadas por su pastor. Tomó los panes, dio gracias y los repartió, como lo haría en la Última Cena cuando instituyó la Eucaristía (Eucaristía es la palabra griega para "dar gracias") y como lo hace nuestro Señor en cada misa.

Después de que todos se saciaron, llenaron doce canastos con los fragmentos del pan; la gracia de nuestro Señor es abundante. A veces es difícil para nosotros ser pacientes o confiar en Dios. A veces vemos una situación y dudamos. Sin embargo, Dios es nuestro pastor quien humilde y cariñosamente alimenta a su rebaño. Cuando venimos ante el Señor y ofrecemos nuestra humilde ofrenda de pan y vino en la misa, reconozcamos a Cristo que está presente, ofreciéndose a Sí mismo, dando descanso y vida a nuestras almas.

Después de este evento, Jesús continuó enseñándoles que Él es el verdadero pan que descendió del cielo y que no tendremos vida dentro de nosotros a menos que comamos su carne y bebamos su sangre. Esta enseñanza, que se conoce como el Discurso del Pan de Vida, se cumplió en la Última Cena cuando Jesús instituyó la Eucaristía, el sacramento del cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo. El Evangelio de los cuatro domingos siguientes será del Discurso del Pan de Vida en el sexto capítulo del evangelio según San Juan. Los animo a que lean este capítulo y pasen tiempo con nuestro Señor, que tiene las palabras de la vida eterna y está presente verdaderamente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Conozcan mis oraciones por ustedes en el altar del Señor, y sigamos recordándonos unos a otros en oración.

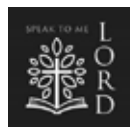
