

A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With a word, God created the universe. With a word, Christ calmed the winds and the sea and commanded the lame to walk and the dead to rise. With a word, Christ gave thanks and multiplied five loaves and two fish to feed the multitudes. At the last Supper, Christ spoke the words of consecration over the bread and the wine, "This is my body... This is the chalice of my blood," instructing the Apostles to do this in memory of Him (see Lk.22:19-20). The same Christ who made the blind see, the deaf hear, and the mute speak, who with a word cried out for the forgiveness of sins from the cross and conquered death on Easter Sunday, has entrusted the words of consecration to the Church, and Christ does what His words say: this is His body and blood. He has given us the sacrament of His body and blood in the holy Eucharist. His humble and perfect sacrifice of love and mercy on the cross, which has conquered sin and death, is extended to us in every Mass, as He humbly and perfectly gives Himself to us in holy communion. There is no greater gift of love and mercy: Jesus humbly and lovingly gives Himself to us to nourish our souls and unite us to Himself, for His flesh is true food, and His blood is true drink (cf. Jn. 6:55).

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. We are joined by our bishop at the noon Mass for the annual Corpus Christi procession, when we publicly honor and adore Christ's presence in the Holy Eucharist by processing outside of the church with the Blessed Sacrament. As we walk through the streets of Kankakee with the holy Eucharist, we are reminded that we bring Christ out of our churches and into our world. Like the Israelites who wandered in the desert to the Promised Land, fed by manna, which was like bread that had fallen from Heaven, the procession leading to another destination reminds us that we are on a journey to the Promised Land of Heaven, fed by the true bread that has come down from Heaven to give us life: Jesus Christ.

In every Mass, Christ calls us together and unites us through Holy Communion. I pray that we can come together to express that beautiful reality of the Eucharist and Holy Communion as well as publicly give God thanks for the gift of the Holy Eucharist, the sacrament of the love of Christ. Know of my prayers for all of you at Mass, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Con una palabra, Dios creó el universo. Con una palabra, Cristo calmó los vientos y el mar y ordenó a los cojos caminar y a los muertos vivir. Con una palabra, Cristo dio gracias y multiplicó cinco panes y dos peces para alimentar a la multitud. En la última Cena, Cristo pronunció las palabras de consagración sobre el pan y el vino: "Esto es mi cuerpo... Éste es el cáliz de mi sangre", instruyendo a los Apóstoles a hacer esto en conmemoración suya (ver Lc.22). :19-20). Cristo que hizo ver a los ciegos, oír a los sordos y hablar a los mudos, que con una palabra perdonó los pecados desde la cruz y venció la muerte en el Domingo de Pascua, ha confiado a la Iglesia sus palabras de consagración, y Cristo hace lo que dicen sus palabras: este es Su cuerpo y Su sangre. Él nos ha dado el sacramento de su cuerpo y sangre en la Eucaristía. Su humilde y perfecto sacrificio de amor y misericordia en la cruz, que ha vencido el pecado y la muerte, se nos extiende en cada misa, mientras él se entrega humilde y perfectamente a nosotros en la sagrada comunión. No hay mayor don de amor y de misericordia: Jesús se nos entrega humilde y amoroso, nutre nuestras almas y nos une a Él, porque su carne es verdadero alimento y su sangre es verdadera bebida (cf. Jn. 6,55).

Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, conocido como Corpus Christi. Nuestro obispo nos acompaña en la misa del mediodía para la procesión anual de Corpus Christi, cuando honramos y adoramos públicamente la presencia de Cristo en la Eucaristía mediante una procesión fuera de la iglesia con el Santísimo Sacramento. Mientras caminamos por las calles de Kankakee con la hostia consagrada, recordamos que llevamos a Cristo de nuestra iglesia a nuestro mundo. Como los israelitas que viajaban por el desierto hacia la Tierra Prometida, alimentados con maná, que era como pan caído del cielo, la procesión que conduce a otro destino nos recuerda que estamos en un viaje hacia la Tierra Prometida del Cielo, alimentados por el verdadero pan que ha bajado del cielo para darnos vida: Jesucristo.

En cada misa, Cristo nos llama y nos une a través de la sagrada comunión. Ruego que nos unamos para expresar esa hermosa realidad de la Eucaristía y la Sagrada Comunión al igual que dar gracias públicamente a Dios por el don de la Sagrada Eucaristía, el sacramento del amor de Cristo. Sepan de mis oraciones por todos ustedes en la misa y, por favor, continúen orando por mí y unos por otros.




