

Third Sunday of Lent - March 12, 2023



"Bringing Jesus to Everyone and Everyone to Jesus"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Thirst. It is a powerful craving often used to describe what drives or motivates someone. As we spend time in the desert of Lent, we ask ourselves today: For what do we thirst? What drives us? What quenches our thirst? In our first reading,

the Israelites grumbled and thirsted for water, which was satisfied when Moses miraculously drew water from the rock. In our Gospel, Jesus meets the Samaritan woman at Jacob's well under the midday sun, telling her, "Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." The water that Jesus has to give is not simply important for surviving or momentarily satisfying one's thirst. Rather, this water is living; it will bubble up within us eternally. It perfectly satisfies and gives eternal life. This water, which comes from the rock of Jesus Christ, is given to us in Baptism. Born again by water and the Holy Spirit in Baptism, "the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us," as St. Paul says in our second reading. There are many things for which we thirst, but do we ultimately guench our thirst, our deepest desires, in the rock of Jesus Christ, drinking from the fount of mercy and life given to us through the Church? Let us continue to invoke His mercy, love, and grace. The love of God has been poured into our hearts. Let us live in His love.

In Christ, Fr. Matt Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

La sed es un anhelo poderoso que se usa para describir lo que impulsa o motiva a alguien. Mientras pasamos tiempo en el desierto de la Cuaresma, hoy nos preguntamos: ¿De qué tenemos sed? ¿Qué nos impulsa? ¿Qué apaga nuestra sed? En

nuestra primera lectura, los israelitas tuvieron sed, la cual fue satisfecha cuando Moisés sacó agua milagrosamente de la roca. En nuestro Evangelio. Jesús se encuentra con la samaritana en el pozo de Jacob bajo el sol del mediodía y le dice: "El que beba del agua que yo le daré, nunca más tendrá sed; el agua que yo le daré se convertirá dentro de él en un manantial capaz de dar la vida eterna." El agua que Jesús nos da no es simplemente importante para sobrevivir o para saciar momentáneamente la sed. Más bien, esta agua es viva; burbujeará dentro de nosotros eternamente. Satisface perfectamente y da vida eterna. Esta agua, que brota de la roca de Jesucristo, nos es dada por el Bautismo. Nacidos de nuevo por el agua y el Espíritu Santo en el Bautismo, "Dios ha infundido su amor en nuestros corazones por medio del Espíritu Santo, que él mismo nos ha dado," como dice San Pablo en nuestra segunda lectura. Hay muchas cosas de las que tenemos sed. pero ¿apagamos finalmente nuestra sed, nuestros anhelos más profundos, en la roca de Jesucristo, bebiendo de la fuente de la misericordia y de la vida que nos da la Iglesia? Sigamos invocando su misericordia, amor v gracia. El amor de Dios ha sido derramado en nuestros corazones. Vivamos en su amor.







#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

- Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- To disregard completely the law of fasting and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.
