A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Mother's Day! This weekend, we give thanks for the gift of motherhood and honor and pray for all mothers and godmothers. We also celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. We profess it every Sunday when we recite the Creed. On the fortieth day after Easter, Jesus ascended into Heaven. Then, the nine days that followed were spent in preparation to receive the Holy Spirit. This was the first novena (traditional nine days of prayer). On the fiftieth day after Easter, after seven weeks had passed (a week of weeks), in order to make us a new creation, unite us to Christ, and give us the grace and power to proclaim the Good News to all the world so that all may be one in Christ, the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles who were with the Blessed Mother in prayer. Today, let us keep our eyes fixed on the Heavenly Lord as He sends us out to live out and proclaim the faith. We are reminded in one of the prefaces of the Ascension that Jesus "ascended, not to distance himself from our lowly state but that we, his members, might be confident of flowing where he, our Head and Founder has gone before." We are called to follow our Lord to heaven, and this calling impacts the way we approach our daily lives. Let us strive to live in friendship with our Lord, and as we prepare to celebrate Pentecost, I'd like to encourage all of us to pray "Come, Holy Spirit" throughout this week, inviting the Holy Spirit into our lives, friendships, families, workplaces, and parish.

I ask you to please pray for our students who are preparing to receive the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation on June 8th. Also, there are still some tickets available for "Damien" this Friday at 7pm. It is an inspiring play about the saintly priest who responded to the Lord's call and followed Him by ministering to and among the lepers on the Hawaiian island of Molokai. Wayne Messmer stars as Father Damien, whose feast day was celebrated this past Friday. It will be a faith-filled and inspiring evening.

Also, please don't forget to mark your calendars to join the bishop and the community for Mass here on Sunday, June 2nd, at 12:00 p.m. and the eucharistic procession through the streets to St. Rose Chapel, which will begin following the Mass. It is a great opportunity to join our bishop in prayer and give public witness and honor to our Lord present in the Holy Eucharist. It is also a great reminder to us that we walk together in Christ on our journey to heaven. Let us continue to stay close to Christ and to pray with and for one another.
