

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity - May 26, 2024



Prayer to the Most Holy Trinity

Omnipotence of the Father, help my weakness, and deliver me from the depth of misery.... Wisdom of the Son, direct all my thoughts, words and actions. Love of the Holy Ghost, be thou the source and beginning of all the operations of my soul, whereby they may be always conformable to the divine will.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Next Sunday, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. It is an opportunity to give honor to our Lord Jesus Christ, really and truly present in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is the heart of the Christian community. At the Mass, the faithful come together to receive Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life. In the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John, many disciples walked away from Jesus out of disbelief when Jesus told them that He Himself is the bread of life that has come down from heaven and that His flesh is true food, and His blood is true drink. Christ fulfilled that teaching at the Last Supper when, the night before He offered His Body and Blood on the altar of the cross, He instituted the sacrament of His Body and Blood in the holy Eucharist. His sacrifice on the cross, the most perfect act of mercy and love done for our salvation, is extended to us in every Mass. Every time we approach the altar at Mass, we approach Christ; we receive Jesus Himself and are renewed in our union with Him. Our food for the journey of life, which can be a long journey, is not ordinary bread, but it is Jesus Himself.

A powerful way to honor and celebrate the most holy and precious gift that is the Holy Eucharist is to conduct a eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi. So next Sunday, June 2nd, we are blessed to have Bishop Hicks join us for the celebration of the holy Mass and then lead us in procession. The Mass will be at a special time: 12:00 p.m. There will be no 11:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. Mass that day. Instead, everyone is encouraged to come together to a bilingual Mass celebrated by our bishop. We will then process from our parish church to the Chapel of St. Rose of Lima. There will then be a reception there, and we will also have a shuttle bus available to bring people back to St. John Paul II. The instructions for processions say, "It is fitting that the procession should go from one church to another." The procession is a way to honor Jesus publicly as we walk through the streets of Kankakee. The act of procession reminds us that we bring Christ out of our churches and into our world. Like the Israelites who wandered in the desert to the Promised Land, fed only by manna, which was like bread that had fallen from Heaven, the procession leading to another destination reminds us that we are on a journey to the Promised Land of Heaven, fed by the true bread that has come down from Heaven to give us life: Jesus Christ.

In every Mass, Christ calls us together and unites through Holy Communion. I pray that we can come together to express that beautiful reality of the Eucharist and Holy Communion as well as publicly give God thanks for the gift of the Holy Eucharist, the sacrament of the love of Christ. Know of my prayers for all of you at Mass, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El próximo domingo vamos a celebrar la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, Corpus Christi. Es una oportunidad para dar honor a nuestro Señor Jesucristo, verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. La Eucaristía es el corazón de la comunidad cristiana. En la misa, los fieles se reúnen para recibir a Jesucristo, el Pan de Vida. En el capítulo sexto del Evangelio según San Juan,

muchos discípulos se alejaron de Jesús por incredulidad cuando Jesús les dijo que Él mismo es el pan de vida que ha bajado del cielo y que su carne es verdadera comida y su sangre es verdadera bebida. Cristo cumplió esa enseñanza en la Última Cena cuando, la noche antes de ofrecer su Cuerpo y Sangre en el altar de la cruz, instituyó el sacramento de su Cuerpo y Sangre en la sagrada Eucaristía. Su sacrificio en la cruz, el acto más perfecto de misericordia y amor hecho por nuestra salvación se nos extiende en cada misa. Cada vez que nos acercamos al altar en la misa, nos acercamos a Cristo; recibimos a Jesús mismo y somos renovados en nuestra unión con él. Nuestro alimento para el camino de la vida, que a veces es duro, no es pan ordinario, sino que es Jesús mismo.

Una manera poderosa de honrar y celebrar el don más santo y precioso que es la Sagrada Eucaristía es realizar una procesión eucarística en Corpus Christi. El próximo domingo 2 de junio, el Obispo Hicks celebrará la santa misa aquí y luego nos guiará en procesión. La misa será en un horario especial: 12:00 p.m. En ese día no habrá misa a las 11:30 am ni a la 1:00 pm. En su lugar, los animo a que asistan a la misa bilingüe celebrada por nuestro obispo. Enseguida procesionaremos desde nuestra iglesia parroquial a la Capilla de Santa Rosa de Lima. Después habrá un convivio allí, y también tendremos disponible un autobús para llevar a las personas de regreso a San Juan Pablo II. Las instrucciones para las procesiones dicen: "Conviene que la procesión vaya de una iglesia a otra". La procesión es una forma de honrar públicamente a Jesús mientras caminamos por las calles de Kankakee. El acto de la procesión nos recuerda que llevamos a Cristo de nuestras iglesias a nuestro mundo. Como los israelitas viajaban por el desierto hacia la Tierra Prometida, alimentados con maná, que era como pan caído del cielo, la procesión que conduce a otro destino nos recuerda que estamos en un viaje hacia la Tierra Prometida del Cielo, alimentados por el verdadero pan que ha bajado del cielo para darnos vida: Jesucristo.

En cada Misa, Cristo nos llama y nos une a través de la Sagrada Comunión. Ruego que nos reunamos para expresar esa hermosa realidad de la Eucaristía y la Sagrada Comunión y para dar gracias públicamente a Dios por el don de la Sagrada Eucaristía, el sacramento del amor de Cristo. Sepan de mis oraciones por todos ustedes en la misa y por favor continúen orando por mí y por los demás.






