Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Pope Francis has dedicated 2024 to prayer. During this Year of Prayer, I would like us to reflect on adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration is when the consecrated host is placed on the altar for prayer. This time is usually marked by silence, inviting us to spend time with our Lord, really and truly present in the most Blessed Sacrament of the altar. It is a great gift to spend time with our Lord present in the holy Eucharist, to have an audience with the King of kings. He humbly comes to us under the appearances of bread and wine to nourish us and strengthen us on the journey. He actually comes to us in every Mass. He is true to His word and does what He says. He gives Himself to us. In a restless and noisy world, our Lord invites you to spend some quiet time with Him: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" (Mt. 11:28). In every Mass, we have the opportunity to receive the Lord. In adoration, we are invited to rest in the Lord and grow in friendship with Christ. Before and after Mass and throughout the week, it is good to revere the Lord present in the tabernacle, remembering that our Lord has made His dwelling among us. During holy communion, receive the Lord with great reverence, for in every communion, you become a living tabernacle, a dwelling place for the Lord. There is no holier moment than holy communion during Mass. In adoration, the consecrated host (in which Jesus is truly and really present) is placed in a monstrance upon the altar for us to then spend time with him in prayer.

We have adoration every Monday from noon to 5pm as well as from 8am to 6pm on the first Friday of the month and from 9pm to 3am on the first Saturday of the month (Nocturnal Adoration). The church is quiet during that time, inviting you to pray. It is a gift to quiet the soul and spend time in prayer. Prayer is powerful. Our patron saint, Pope John Paul II wrote of the importance of prayer in the parish: "Yes, dear brothers and sisters, our Christian communities must become genuine 'schools' of prayer, where the meeting with Christ is expressed not just in imploring help but also in thanksgiving, praise, adoration, contemplation, listening and ardent devotion, until the heart truly 'falls in love'. Intense prayer, yes, but it does not distract us from our commitment to history: by opening our heart to the love of God it also opens it to the love of our brothers and sisters, and makes us capable of shaping history according to God's plan" (Novo Millennio Ineunte, 33). Let us continue to open our hearts to the love of the Lord and remember one another in prayer.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El Papa Francisco ha dedicado el año 2024 a la oración. En este Año de Oración, me gustaría que reflexionáramos sobre la adoración al Santísimo Sacramento. La adoración es cuando la hostia consagrada se coloca en el altar para orar. Este tiempo está marcado por el silencio, que nos invita a pasar tiempo con nuestro Señor, real y verdaderamente presente en el Santísimo Sacramento del altar. Es un gran regalo pasar tiempo con nuestro Señor presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía, tener una audiencia, un encuentro, con el Rey de reyes. Él viene humildemente a nosotros bajo las apariencias del pan y del vino para alimentarnos y fortalecernos en el camino. De hecho, viene a nosotros en cada misa. Es fiel a su palabra y hace lo que dice. Se nos entrega. En un mundo inquieto, nuestro Señor nos invita a pasar un tiempo tranquilo con Él: "Vengan a mí todos los que están fatigados y agobiados, y yo les daré alivio" (Mt. 11,28). En cada Misa, tenemos la oportunidad de recibir al Señor. En la adoración, se nos invita a descansar en Él y crecer en la amistad con Cristo. Antes y después de la misa y durante la semana, es bueno reverenciar al Señor presente en el sagrario, recordando que nuestro Él ha hecho su morada entre nosotros. Durante la sagrada comunión, recibamos al Señor con gran reverencia, porque en cada comunión, nos convertimos en un sagrario viviente, una morada para el Señor. No hay momento más sagrado que la comunión durante la misa. En la adoración, la hostia consagrada (en la que Jesús está verdaderamente presente) se coloca en una custodia sobre el altar para que pasemos un tiempo con Él en oración.

Tenemos adoración todos los lunes desde el mediodía hasta las 5:00pm, así como desde las 8:00am-6:00pm el primer viernes del mes y desde las 9:00pm hasta las 3:00am el primer sábado del mes (Adoración Nocturna). La iglesia está en silencio durante ese tiempo, invitándonos al príncipe de paz. Es un regalo aquietar el alma y pasar tiempo en oración. La oración es poderosa. Nuestro santo patrono, el Papa Juan Pablo II, escribió sobre la importancia de la oración en la parroquia: "Sí, queridos hermanos y hermanas, nuestras comunidades cristianas tienen que llegar a ser auténticas 'escuelas de oración', donde el encuentro con Cristo no se exprese solamente en petición de ayuda, sino también en acción de gracias, alabanza, adoración, contemplación, escucha y viveza de afecto hasta el 'arrebato del corazón'. Una oración intensa, sí, pero no nos aparta del compromiso en la historia: abriendo el corazón al amor de Dios, lo abre también al amor de los hermanos, y nos hace capaces de construir la historia según el designio de Dios" (Novo Millennio Ineunte, 33). Continuemos abriendo nuestros corazones al amor de Dios y recordándonos unos a otros en oración.

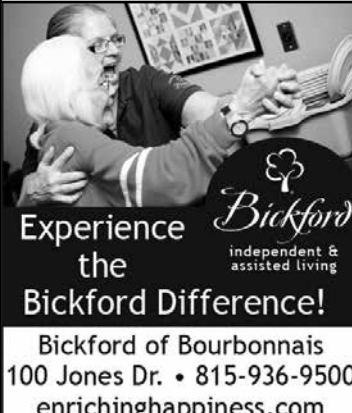
