Setting Our Hearts and Minds To A Parish Strategic Planning



My dear parishioners, have you ever thought of what your own personal life goals are, for the next few years? Have you asked yourself in the beginning of this new decade, what things you would like to see happen in your life by 2030? Perhaps some of these dreams and visions pertain not only to your own person, but also, your own family, your community, and even your parish?

As we have begun this new decade, I am excited to think about the new visions that we might have regarding the future of this parish family. These moments of new beginnings are a real opportunity to think about what we are called to do together, to focus our efforts, in building the Kingdom of God in our parish. Bishop Conlon, has invited us through his pastoral letter to think together of ways by which we can continue to proclaim the Good News of Christ in our own time, to be missionary disciples to one another and to those who seek the Lord with a sincere heart. How timely it is that such invitation is happening within the transition months from one decade to another. 2. Work with the Parish Leadership on the process of visioning.
3. Preparing questionnaires and methods of gathering input from the entire parish family.
4. Executing the survey and holding conversation sessions for visioning.
5. Writing up of input systematically, for presentation.
6. Formalizing the vision in our liturgy and setting calendar dates for evaluation and updates.
7. Disseminating the fruits of the vision and planning sessions.
8. Implementation of plans based on calendar of development.

As we anticipate the beginning of this process, I ask you to spend some time praying to the Holy Spirit for guidance. After all, the impetus of this planning is to unfold the will of God for our community. God bless our parish family, and our efforts to be missionary disciples today.
