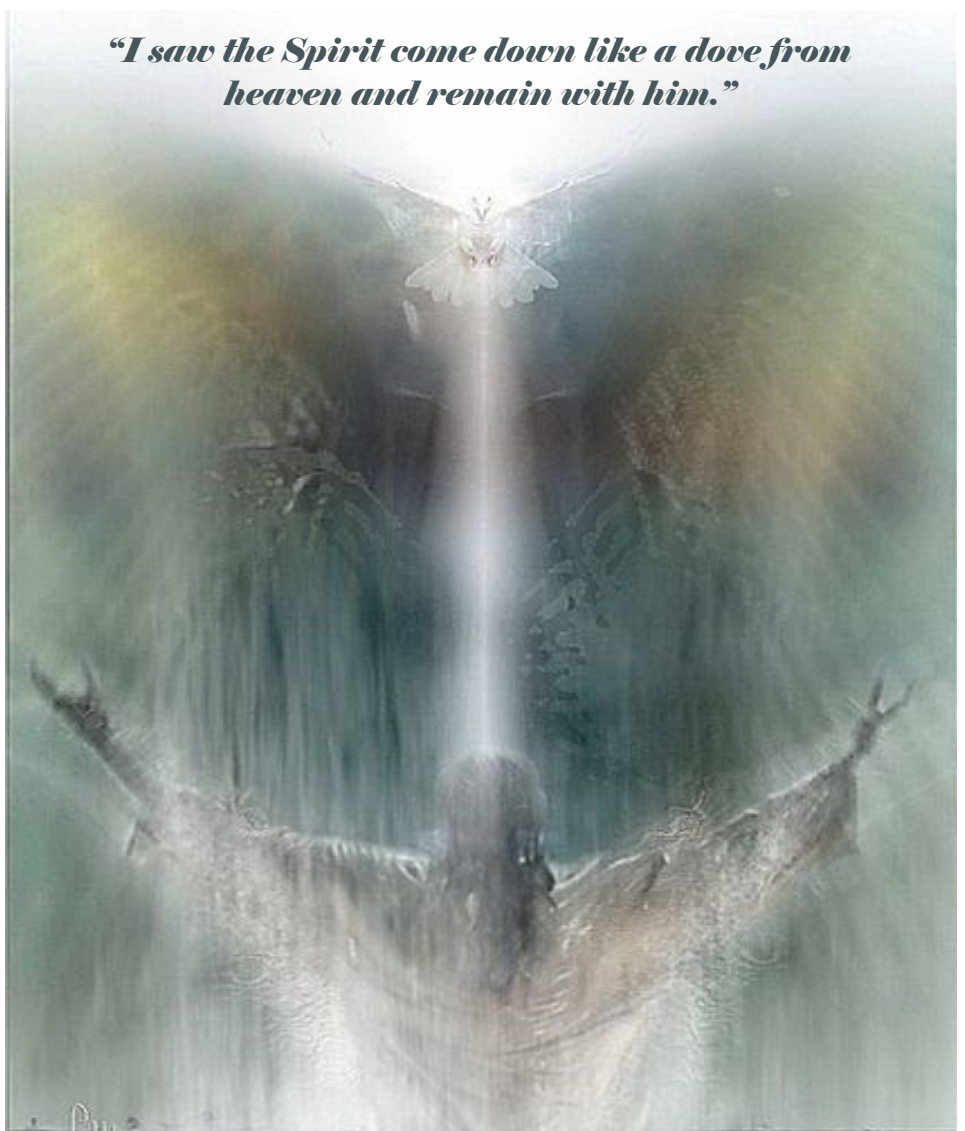

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last weekend, the proclamation of the date of Easter and the other moveable feasts was proclaimed after the Gospel. The practice of the proclamation on Epiphany comes from a time when calendars were not readily available. It was necessary to make known the date of Easter in advance, since many celebrations of the liturgical year depend on its date. The number of Sundays that follow Epiphany, the date of Ash Wednesday, and the number of Sundays that follow Pentecost are all computed in relation to Easter. Although calendars now give the date of Easter and the other feasts in the liturgical year for many years in advance, the Epiphany proclamation still has value. It is a reminder of the centrality of the resurrection of the Lord in the liturgical year and the importance of the great mysteries of faith which are celebrated each year. Christ has entered into time so we can enter into eternity. He has come to sanctify us, including our daily lives. Let us stay close to Him who is our light and our salvation.

Announcement of Easter and the Moveable Feasts:

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the twenty-second day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the ninth day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the twenty-first day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the twenty-eighth day of May, the feast of Pentecost. On the eleventh day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the third day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.



Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El fin de semana pasado, la proclamación de la fecha de la Pascua y otras fiestas movibles fue anunciado después del evangelio durante todas las misas. La proclamación en Epifanía data de un tiempo en que los calendarios no estaban fácilmente disponibles. Era necesario dar a conocer la fecha de la Pascua por anticipado, ya que muchas celebraciones del año litúrgico dependían de esta fiesta. El número de domingos que siguen a la Epifanía, la fecha del Miércoles de Ceniza y el número de domingos después de Pentecostés se calculan en relación a la Pascua. Aunque ahora los calendarios dan la fecha de la Pascua y otras fiestas en el año litúrgico con muchos años de anticipación, la proclamación de la Epifanía todavía tiene valor. Es un recuerdo de la centralidad de la resurrección del Señor dentro del año litúrgico y de la importancia de los grandes misterios de la fe que se celebran anualmente. Cristo ha entrado en el tiempo para que podamos entrar en la eternidad. Él ha venido a santificarnos, incluyendo nuestra vida diaria. Permanezcamos cerca de aquel que es nuestra luz y nuestra salvación.

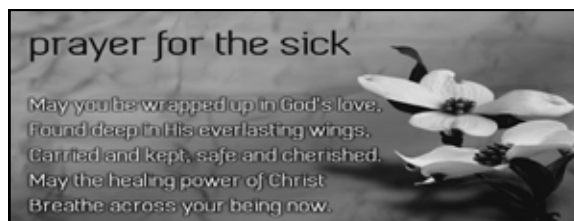

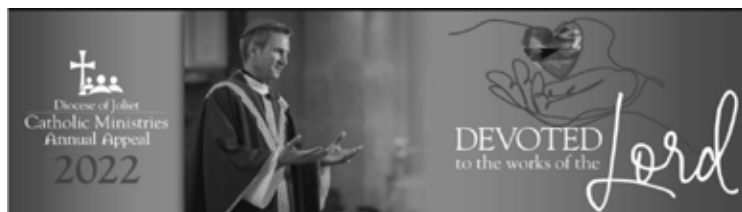

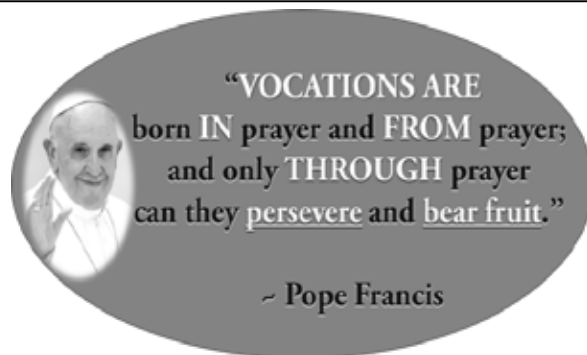

What Baptism Makes of Us.

We begin Ordinary Times this liturgical year full of baptismal reminders. Jesus ranks ahead of John the Baptism and all of us. But though greater, he, in his good Spirit, remains with all of us. In Baptism, we are God's servants, ordained to show God's glory (and not our own), and be about God's saving plan. And like St. Paul and the Corinthians, we are called to be holy.

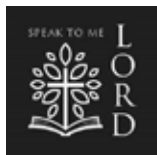

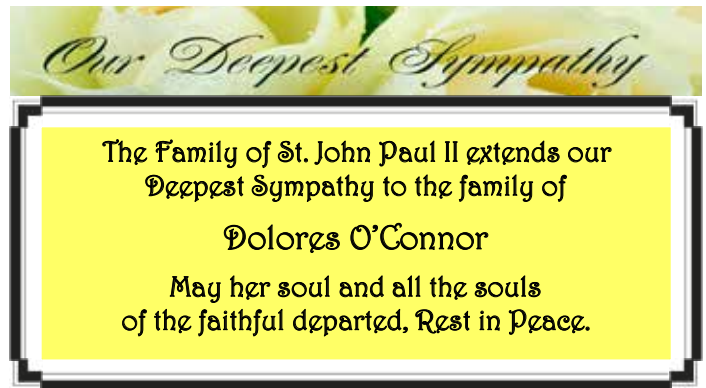

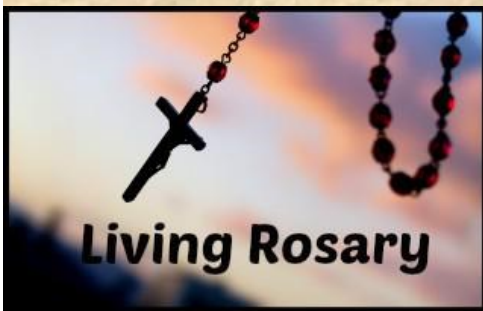
