

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend's Gospel is about the wedding feast at Cana. This is the first miracle that Jesus performed: turning water into wine. Miracles are particularly important in the Gospel according to St. John, because they are little epiphanies that reveal to us Jesus' divinity, reminding us that God has visited His people. A wedding was a fitting occasion for Jesus to begin to reveal who He is and what He is about. After all, salvation is a love



story between God and His people. Even though we sin and can drift away from God, God has pursued us and entered into a covenant, a union, with us. Time and again in the Old Testament. God spoke of us His love for us by referring to His people as His beloved bride. This is fulfilled in Jesus, who wed humanity to Himself when He became man, loved us so perfectly when He died for us, and sent His Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Church, inviting us into a union with Him that is loving and eternal. St. Paul reminds us in the fifth chapter of his letter to the Ephesians that Christ loved the Church as a groom loves his bride. Jesus' parables that liken heaven to a wedding feast are echoed in the nineteenth chapter of the Book of Revelation: "Blessed are those who have been called to the wedding feast of the Lamb." Heaven is a wedding feast, when we are in perfect union with God. when the Lamb, Jesus Christ, is received by His bride, the Church, and we the Church are received by the bridegroom, Jesus Christ. That heavenly wedding feast is not only our destination, but our Lord has given us an experience of it in this life every time we receive the sacraments. In the sacraments, particularly the holy Eucharist, holy Matrimony, and confession, we are given a taste of that loving relationship between God and His Church. Through the sacraments, our Lord loves us and sanctifies us. Let us stay close to our Lord in the frequent and devout reception of the sacraments. Know of my continued prayers for you, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Esto es cumplido en Jesús, quien desposó consigo a la humanidad cuando se hizo hombre, nos amó tan perfectamente cuando murió por nosotros v envió su Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles v la Iglesia. invitándonos a una unión con él que es amorosa y eterna. San Pablo nos recuerda en el quinto capítulo de su carta a los Efesios que Cristo amó a la Iglesia como un marido ama a su esposa. Las parábolas de Jesús que comparan el cielo con una fiesta de bodas están expresadas en el capítulo diecinueve del Libro del Apocalipsis: "Felices los que han sido invitados al banquete de bodas del Cordero." El cielo es una fiesta de bodas, cuando estamos en perfecta unión con Dios, cuando el Cordero, Jesucristo, es recibido por su esposa, la Iglesia, y nosotros, la Iglesia, somos recibidos por el marido, Jesucristo. La fiesta de bodas celestial es nuestro destino y más sin embargo nuestro Señor nos ha dado unas experiencias de su amor celestial en esta vida cada vez que recibimos los sacramentos. En los sacramentos, particularmente la santa Eucaristía, el Matrimonio y la confesión, se nos da a probar esa relación amorosa entre Dios y su Iglesia. A través de los sacramentos, nuestro Señor nos ama y nos santifica. Permanezcamos cerca de nuestro Señor en la frecuente y devota recepción de los sacramentos. Frecuentemente yo rezo por ustedes y por favor sigan orando los unos por los otros.





Second Sunday in Ordinary Time January 16, 2022

Isaiah 62:1-5 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 John 2:1-11 Believing Signs

At first glance, these readings lead us to bride and groom, gifts, and marriage. But there are important things underneath, important truths at the heart of these proclamations. God has not and will not abandon us (Isaiah). Charisms, that is, gifts of the Spirit, are given to everyone to use for the common good, not just one's own good (Corinthians). The miracle of water to wine is the first of many signs of the Messiah, the Christ (John). God's signs and good activity are everywhere.

- What evidence do I have that God is with us still?
- What gifts that I have, given by the Spirit, will I put to use for the good of another?
- Christ is active all the time. What little and big signs of this goodness can I be part of? What signs will I rejoice in?





On Monday, January 17, the Parish Office will be closed in honor of the Martin Luther King Holiday.



On 12 September 1987, Pope John Paul II recalled the dream of the African-American leader. He was in New Orleans when he met the black Catholic Community of the city. Karol Wojtyla recalled the long and difficult journey of the African-American community to overcome injustice and to liberate itself from the weight of oppression. "In the most difficult hours of your struggle for civil rights amidst discrimination and oppression", he emphasized, "God himself guided your steps along the way of peace. Before the witness of history, the response of non-violence stands, in the memory of this nation, as a monument of honor to the black community of the United States."

St. John Paul II spoke of the "providential role" played by Martin Luther King Jr "in contributing to the rightful human betterment of black Americans and therefore to the improvement of American society itself." Like Paul VI, he found a particular affinity with the Christian vision of human brotherhood incarnated by the Pastor from Atlanta who believed, up to point of the ultimate sacrifice, in the liberating action of faith in Christ.






