A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, when Andrew and John heard John the Baptist point to Christ and cry out, "Behold the Lamb of God," they went and followed Jesus immediately. Jesus turned around and asked them, "What are you looking for?" They replied, "Rabbi, where do you dwell?" It's an odd answer to Christ's question. They responded to the question with a question, but it is a question on the heart every of person. Deep down, every person wants peace; every person wants a rest and joy that is only possible by being with God. So Jesus simply responds, "Come, and you will see." He invites them, and He invites you. This encounter between Andrew, John, and Jesus happened at four in the afternoon, and it happens for us at every Mass. At every Mass, we receive that which we most truly desire, the one for whom our souls long and thirst: the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ Himself. At every Mass, after we cry out for the Lamb of God three times, asking for mercy and peace, we hear the words of John the Baptist echoed through the priest of the Church, "Behold the Lamb of God!" Christ is here! He invites you to receive Him so He can make His dwelling with you, so He can give you peace, joy, and mercy, one day bringing you to the Lamb's High Feast in Heaven (cf. Rev. 19). How sacred, essential, and beautiful is the moment of Holy Communion at Mass!

I also ask you to please note that this Thursday begins the novena for life. I encourage you to pray it at home or with us after Mass during the week. This Friday is set aside by the Church as a day of prayer and penance as we pray for the restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. I remember you in my prayers at Mass every day. Please continue to pray for me and one another, and may the Lord always keep you and your loved ones in good health, grace, and peace.

Él nos invita a recibirlo para que él pueda acompañarnos y estar con nosotros, darnos paz, gozo, misericordia y llevarnos al banquete de bodas del Cordero en el cielo (cf. Apocalipsis 19:9). ¡Qué sagrado, esencial y hermoso es el momento de la Sagrada Comunión en la Misa!

También les pido que recuerden que este jueves comienza la novena por la vida. Les animo a rezar la novena en casa o con nosotros después de la misa durante la semana. 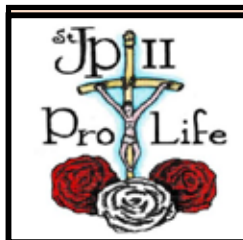

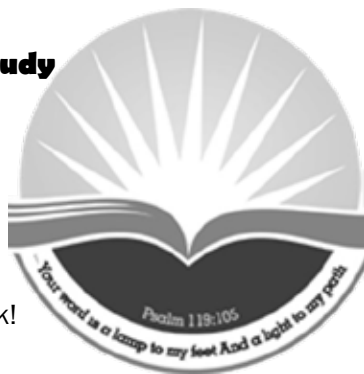

January 17, 2021 Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

1 Sam 3:3b-10, 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20, John 1:35-42

Listening, Discerning and Watching, Coming seeing, Finding. These words ending in -ing in the first and gospel readings indicate some continuing action. They point out good Christian behaviors as we start this winter time between the seasons of Christmas and Lent. Like Samuel, we want to be always listening for God's voice, even while needing the help of another for discerning it. Like the Baptist, we want to be watching for Jesus moving among us, looking for his activity in surprising ways in our midst and, perhaps, the surprising people around us.

- How am I coming closer to Jesus day by day, week by week?
- How am I seeing Jesus active in our world?
- How am I finding myself following Jesus without question?

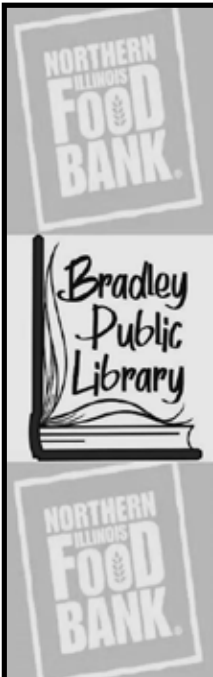
