A CULTURE OF LIFE

As we all know, the month of January is a time where we as a church are called to reflect more deeply on the Gospel of Life, that it is a sacred gift, a divine masterpiece.

When I was very young, I remember watching my mother work her magic in her garden. I was always amused by the amount of attention and labor that she affords every little seedling. I watched her talk to each plant and encourage them to flower and bear fruit. At certain times, I would hear her giving the plant a little lecture on how to grow, or how her patience is being really, really tested, but she would still nurture them the same way and water them lovingly, even sometimes doing it after sunset, when it was already dark. What's more, my mother always had great results. It is not an exaggeration to say that she could create a forest out of a little seedling or plant that she would pick up from a friend's house or a seemingly misplaced shoot on the road. Her garden was always beautiful and promising. Neighbors would always take a peek at which flower was blooming this time, or treat her to a conversation about what new plants are being showcased in her garden, and what new ideas she has for arranging them. Many times in the year, her plants would even make it to our mission chapel, if our parish priest had not yet sent a jeepney to "borrow" some of her plants for a big parish mass.

Something about my mother's love of plants and anything that has life for that matter, got me on a very solid foundation about my own attitude towards life itself. I have come to understand through the years of watching her do her magic in the garden that life indeed is precious, special and in every life, there is always a potential for something beautiful and precious to grow. Her simple witness of patient nurturing also taught me that life doesn't happen necessarily by applying one formula. Instead, every life has to be treated uniquely, and every life has its own pace and season for growth and fruit-bearing.

We are in a society where we often hear the lie that life is a choice, that we can do whatever we want with it. But the truth is, all this time throughout all of history, God has a plan for each life, and has built in a personal story for each one to be, to grow, to life and to die in each unique way. Every story is unique, personal, and holy. And it is not for anyone of us to trample with, or to claim it like it is ours. Life calls us to be stewards, to be magnanimous in bringing out the best in each lifeform. It is a vocation to participate in the sacred work of creation.

This month of January, let us together as a family of faith rebuild again a culture of life among us. Let us make a commitment to nurture and cherish every life that the Lord has entrusted to our care, beginning from our family and friends, especially our children, to every pet, every creature that breathes, every masterpiece of God's creation. Let us participate in a universe that continues to unfold before us. Let us allow God to continue His creative work through us, as His Church. May God bless the life that is in us, and all others that surround us. Amen.

UNA CULTURA DE VIDA

Como todos sabemos, el mes de enero es un tiempo cuando nosotros como iglesia somos llamados a reflexionar más profundamente sobre el Evangelio de la Vida, que es un don sagrado, una obra maestra.

Cuando yo era muy joven, recuerdo observar a mi madre trabajando maravillas en su jardín. Siempre me admiraba por la cantidad de atención y trabajo que dedicaba a cada plantita. La observaba hablando y animando a cada planta a florecer y dar fruto. En veces, la oía dándoles un pequeño sermón sobre cómo crecer, o como su paciencia estaba realmente a prueba, pero ella seguía alimentándolas y regándolas cariñosamente como siempre, a veces hasta la puesta del sol, cuando ya estaba oscuro. Además, mi madre siempre tenía resultados grandiosos. No es una exageración decir que ella podía crear una selva con una semillita o plantita que encontraba en casa de una amiga o en el camino. Su jardín era siempre hermoso y prometedor. Los vecinos siempre veían qué planta estaba floreciendo o conversaban con ella sobre qué nuevas plantas estaban en exhibición en su jardín y qué nuevas ideas tenía para arreglarlas. Muchas veces en el año, sus plantas llegaban hasta la capilla de nuestra misión, si es que nuestro pastor aún no enviaba un camioncillo para pedir "prestadas" algunas de sus plantas para una celebración de misa parroquial grande.

Algo acerca del amor de mi madre por sus plantas y cualquier cosa que tenga vida, ha fomentado en mí una fundación sólida acerca de mi actitud hacia la vida misma. Llegué a comprender, a través de los años, observándola haciendo su magia en el jardín, que la vida es realmente preciosa, especial, que en cada vida siempre hay un potencial para que crezca algo bello y precioso. Su testimonio simple de cuidado paciente también me enseñó que la vida no sucede necesariamente aplicando una fórmula. En cambio, cada vida debe tratarse en manera única, y cada vida tiene su propio paso y temporada para crecer y dar fruto.

Estamos en una sociedad donde frecuentemente oímos la mentira que la vida es una opción, que podemos hacer lo que queramos con ella. Pero la verdad es, todo este tiempo a través de toda la historia, Dios tiene un plan para cada vida, y ha formulado lo que será nuestra historia personal, para crecer, vivir y morir en una manera única. Cada historia es única, personal y santa. Y no es para que cualquiera de nosotros la pisotee, o reclamarla como si fuera nuestra. La vida nos llama a ser administradores, a ser magnánimos al sacar lo mejor de cada forma de vida. Es una vocación participar en el trabajo sagrado de la creación.

Este mes de enero, unámonos como una familia de fe para reconstruir nuevamente una debemos formar nuevamente una cultura de vida entre nosotros. Hagamos un compromiso para nutrir y valorar cada vida que el Señor ha confiado a nuestro cuidado, comenzando con nuestra familia y amigos, especialmente nuestros hijos, con cada mascota, cada criatura que respira, cada pieza maestra de la creación de Dios. Participemos en un universo que continúe desplegándose ante nosotros. Permitámosle a Dios continuar Su trabajo creativo a través de nosotros, como Su Iglesia. Que Dios bendiga la vida en nosotros y en todos los que nos rodean. Amén.

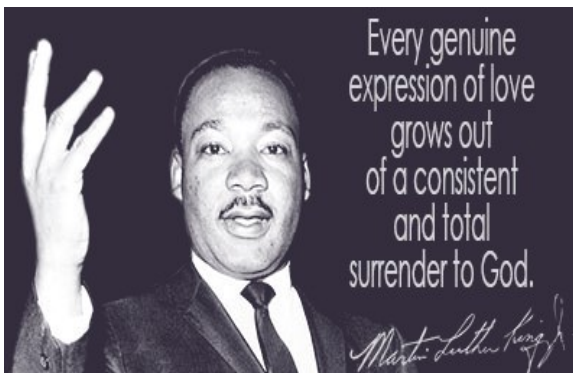
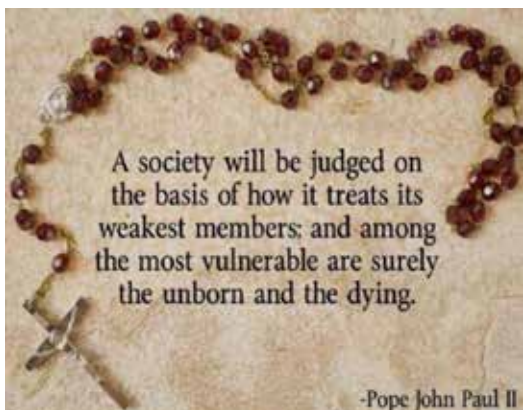
DAY OF PRAYER for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

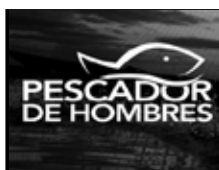
