A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, on the Feast of the Epiphany, we recall the Magi following the star to a house in Bethlehem where they found the child Jesus with the Blessed Mother. Like the Wise Men, we are on a journey, and our destination, the purpose of our lives, is found in the one who rested in the manger: Jesus Christ. He is the one who brings joy and peace to our souls. In Bethlehem, the Magi found Him. They found the King of kings in a humble home, the Creator of the universe being cared for by His mother. In Bethlehem, they found God who made His dwelling among us. God has entered our world and our history so that we may enter into an eternal friendship with Him. Christ has revealed the love of the Father not because He simply wants to teach us or show us His love but because He actually loves us.

Led by the star of the Church, we find Christ in the Mass. Jesus is just as present in the Mass as He was in the manger in Bethlehem. In the flesh, Jesus lied in the manger so that one day He would offer Himself on the cross, for no greater love does one have than this but to lay down one's life for one's friends (see Jn 15:13). The wood of the manger leads to the wood of the cross. He never stops loving us. He is the perfect offering, and He gives Himself to us in the sacrament of His body and blood, in the Holy Eucharist, calling us constantly into friendship with Him. It is in our friendship with Christ where we find strength, hope, love, and joy.

Even though the Wise Men saw a baby, they were looking upon God. As we look upon bread and wine at Mass, we see God. Like the Wise Men who prostrated themselves before the baby Jesus and did Him homage, opening their treasures and giving Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, let us adore Christ in the Holy Eucharist and open the treasures of our hearts and our lives to the Lord. It is a temptation to treat the Eucharist as something ordinary. It is anything but ordinary. At every Mass, heaven pours out Love Himself upon the altar. May the words on our lips and in our hearts during Mass express love for God and implore His mercy. May we spend time after receiving Jesus enjoying this most sacred gift. May we sit before the tabernacle or before the monstrance, spending time with our humble and loving Savior. The Wise Men show us that adoration is the response to the gift of God's presence. Let us recognize His presence among us, and let us adore Him! Merry Christmas to you and your families.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hoy es la fiesta de la Epifanía, cuando recordamos a los Reyes Magos que seguían la estrella hacia una casa en Belén, donde encontraron al niño Jesús con la Santísima Madre. Como los Reyes Magos, estamos de viaje y nuestro destino, el propósito de nuestras vidas, es encontrado en él que descansó en el pesebre: Jesucristo. Él es el que trae alegría y paz a nuestras almas. En Belén, los magos encontraron el Rey de los reyes en un hogar humilde, el Creador del universo cuidado por su madre. En Belén, encontraron a Dios que puso su morada entre nosotros. Dios ha entrado en nuestro mundo y nuestra historia para que podamos vivir en una amistad eterna con él. Cristo ha revelado el amor del Padre no porque simplemente quiera enseñarnos su amor, sino porque en realidad nos ama.

Guiados por la estrella de la Iglesia, encontramos a Cristo en la misa. Jesús está tan presente en la misa como lo estuvo en el pesebre de Belén. En la carne, Jesús descansó en el pesebre para que un día se ofreciera a sí mismo en la cruz, porque nadie tiene mayor amor que este, que uno ponga su vida por sus amigos (vea Jn 15, 13). La madera del pesebre conduce a la madera de la cruz. Él nunca deja de amarnos. Él es la ofrenda perfecta y se entrega a nosotros en el sacramento de su cuerpo y sangre, en la Sagrada Eucaristía, llamándonos constantemente a tener amistad con él. Amistad con Cristo nos da fuerza, esperanza, amor y alegría.

A pesar de que los Reyes Magos vieron a un bebé, estaban mirando a Dios. Cuando miramos el pan y el vino en la misa, vemos a Dios. Como los Reyes Magos que se postraron ante el niño Jesús y lo adoraron, abriendo sus cofres y ofreciéndole regalos de oro, incienso y mirra, adoremos a Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía y abramos los cofres de nuestros corazones y nuestras vidas al Señor. Es una tentación tratar la Eucaristía como algo ordinario. Pero no lo es. En cada misa, el cielo derrama Amor mismo sobre el altar. Para que las palabras en nuestros labios y en nuestros corazones durante la misa expresen amor por Dios e imploren su misericordia. Pasemos un ratito después de recibir a Jesús disfrutando este regalo tan sagrado. Que nos sentemos ante el sagrario o la custodia, pasando un tiempo con nuestro Salvador. Los Reyes Magos nos enseñan que la adoración es la respuesta al don de la presencia de Dios. ¡Reconozcamos su presencia entre nosotros y adorémoslo ! Feliz Navidad a ustedes y sus familias.

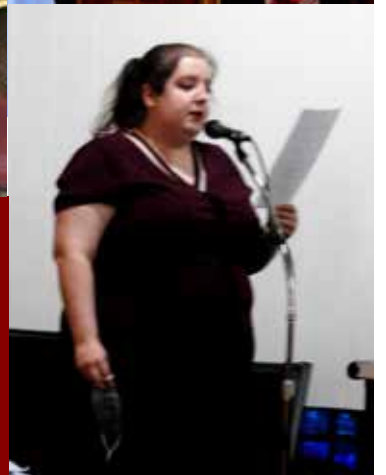

POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS

THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH



Until December 2021, there are many new ways that Catholics can receive an indulgence, including entrusting their daily work to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker or reciting the rosary with their families.

These acts must be accompanied by sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the pope's intentions, the usual conditions to obtain any plenary indulgence.

Plenary indulgences remit all temporal punishment due to sin and must be accompanied by full detachment from sin.

According to the decree issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary on Dec. 8, there are 15 ways to receive an indulgence in the Year of St. Joseph:

- 1) Participate in a spiritual retreat for at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph.
- 2) Pray for St. Joseph's intercession for the unemployed that they might find dignifying work.
- 3) Recite the [Litany of St. Joseph](#) for persecuted Christians. Byzantine Catholics have the option of an Akathist to St. Joseph.
- 4) Entrust one's daily work and activity to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker.
- 5) Follow St. Joseph's example in performing a corporal work of mercy. These include feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, visiting the imprisoned, visiting the sick, and burying the dead.
- 6) Perform one of the spiritual works of mercy, such as comforting the sorrowful, counseling the doubtful, instructing the ignorant, admonishing the sinner, bearing wrongs patiently, forgiving injuries, and praying for the living and the dead.
- 7) Pray the rosary together with one's family in order that "all Christian families may be stimulated to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was in the Holy Family."
- 8) Engaged couples can also receive an indulgence from praying the rosary together.
- 9) Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, because St. Joseph "invites us to rediscover our filial relationship with the Father, to renew fidelity to prayer, to listen and correspond with profound discernment to God's will."
- 10) Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on St. Joseph Sunday, the Sunday after Christmas in the Byzantine Catholic tradition.
- 11) Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph on March 19 with an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph.
- 12) Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on the 19th of any month.
- 13) Honor Joseph with an act of piety or approved prayer on a Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to St. Joseph.
- 14) Pray to St. Joseph on the Feast of the Holy Family on Dec. 29.
- 15) Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1 with an act of piety or prayer.

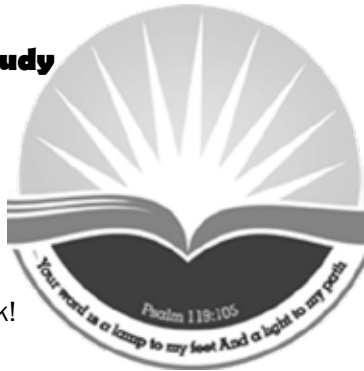
