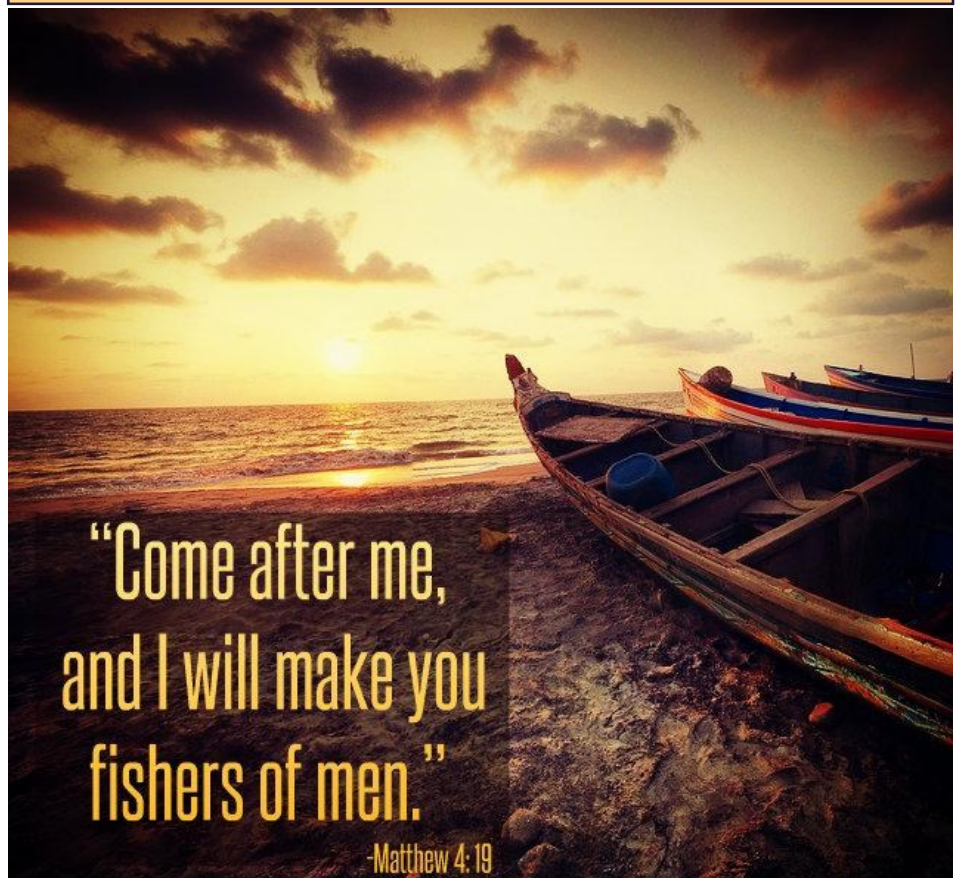

A CALL TO UNITY AND COMMON VISION

Last week, the catechists and volunteers of the Faith Formation program gathered together for a fellowship night, sort of a late Christmas party, and an opportunity to thank them and celebrate what has been accomplished halfway through the program year.

In a gathering like this, it is normal for people to sit with the others whom they already know, or who already are part of their work environment. That's alright, it's part of human nature. But after the attendees have introduced themselves, Donna Worth, who is part of the administration team for Faith Formation, asked all present to draw a number, so that everyone was regrouped differently and gave everyone the opportunity to be with others whom they can get to know better. In the group, we have young mothers and senior volunteers, working professionals and stay-home parents, Hispanics who could speak very little English and non-Hispanics who knew but a word or two of Spanish, male catechists and female catechists, seasoned volunteers and newcomers. There was enough diversity in the room, and yet everyone seemed to have a good time, had a good meal together, and had some fun games and icebreakers. It was truly a good evening for unwinding and simply being present with one another. I stood by Jacob Levy watching the unfolding of the evening, and listening to testimonies of each one, and we were both getting emotional with what we were seeing. Just over a year ago, this program was conceived to emphasize on relationship with God and focus on formation of hearts, instead of emphasizing curriculum concepts and passing of information about the faith. Something about the things that we had a vision about over a year ago are starting to bear fruits. Jacob said, "This is what the rest of the parish can really look like...". And so, when I spoke to the group at the end of the gathering, I encouraged everyone to be ambassadors of the unity and vision that is displayed in the Faith Formation Program, thanks to Sr. Evangeline, Carolyn Levy and the slew of Faith Formation Teams that are working diligently for its success.

I want to share this with the entire parish because I firmly believe that the microcosmic spirit of the faith Formation program can really become the macrocosmic reality of our entire parish. When we break down the barriers of division in our minds and embrace the unity fostered in being the parish of St. John Paul II, we can be a stronger force to realize the visions and dreams for the future. Unity and a common vision are two conversation partners that pave the way to parish success – our unity helps achieve our vision, and our vision unites us together. This is an ongoing reality that we continue to insist in the culture of our parish. And so, for as long as I am able, I will continue to be a cheerleader for these ideals. I will continue to call to mind our parishioners to unite and share a common vision for the future, by building community here and now.

God bless our parish and may we see our spiritual family grow more in the spirit of unity and devotion.

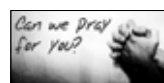



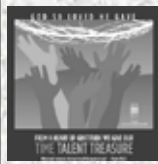
