A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Thursday is the fortieth day after Christmas, and so each year on February Second, we celebrate the event that occurred on the fortieth day after the birth of Jesus: the Presentation of the Lord. This feast day is also traditionally known as Candlemas. It does not often fall on a Sunday, and so it often goes unnoticed by many people. However, this is a beautiful feast that connects Christmas and the Epiphany with Easter, reminding us that Jesus is the light of all nations.

I hope that these words of Pope St. John Paul II help us to understand and celebrate this feast:

"Come, Lord, to your holy temple." With this invocation, which we sang in the Responsorial Psalm, the Church, on the day when she recalls the Presentation of Jesus at the temple in Jerusalem, expresses the desire to be able to welcome him again at this present moment in her history. The Presentation is an evocative liturgical feast, fixed since ancient times on the 40th day after Christmas, following what Jewish law had prescribed for the birth of all first-born males (cf. Ex 13: 2). Mary and Joseph observed it faithfully, as the Gospel account tells us. Christian traditions of the East and West have been interwoven, enriching the liturgy of this feast with a special procession in which the light of candles both large and small is a symbol of Christ, the true Light who came to illumine his people and all peoples. Today's feast is thus connected with the Nativity and Epiphany of the Lord. However, it also serves as a bridge to Easter by recalling the prophecy of the elderly Simeon, who on that occasion foretold the dramatic destiny of the Messiah and his Mother. The Evangelist has even recorded the details of this event: Simeon and Anna, two elderly persons filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, received Jesus at the temple in Jerusalem. They personify the "remnant of Israel", watchful in expectation and ready to meet the Lord, as the shepherds did on the night of his birth in Bethlehem.

May we, like Simeon and Anna, keep watch for Christ, the light of the world. May the light of Christ, the light of faith, hope, and love that we received in baptism, shine through us and guide our paths.

Speaking of asking God to guide us on the journey, I would like to take this moment to thank Silvia Barajas and Kathy Dummer for their service in our parish office. Between the two of them, they have worked in St. John Paul II Parish and St. Teresa Parish for twenty-five years. I am grateful for their kindness and support in the office and offer them my prayers as they move on from the office. May the Lord watch over them, their loved ones, and our parish community and guide us in all that we do. May the light of God's love and grace shine upon us always.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este jueves es el cuadragésimo día después de Navidad. Entonces cada Dos de Febrero celebramos el evento que ocurrió el cuadragésimo día después del nacimiento de Jesús: la Presentación del Señor. Este día de fiesta también se conoce tradicionalmente como Candelaria. Esta fiesta hermosa conecta la Navidad y la Epifanía con la Pascua, recordándonos que Jesús es la luz de todas las naciones.

Espero que estas palabras del Papa San Juan Pablo II nos ayuden a comprender y celebrar esta fiesta:

"Ven, Señor, a tu templo santo." Con esta invocación, que hemos cantado en el Salmo responsorial, la Iglesia, el día en que recuerda la Presentación de Jesús en el templo de Jerusalén, expresa el deseo de poder acogerlo también en el presente de su historia. La Presentación es una fiesta litúrgica evocativa, fijada desde la antigüedad cuarenta días después de la Navidad, según la prescripción de la Ley judía acerca del nacimiento de todo primogénito (cf. Ex 13, 2). María y José, como muestra la narración evangélica, la cumplieron fielmente. Las tradiciones cristianas de Oriente y Occidente se han entrelazado, enriqueciendo la liturgia de esta fiesta con una procesión especial, en la que la luz de los cirios y de las candelas es símbolo de Cristo, Luz verdadera que vino para iluminar a su pueblo y a toda la gente. De este modo, la fiesta de hoy se relaciona con la Navidad y con la Epifanía del Señor. Pero, al mismo tiempo, se sitúa como un puente hacia la Pascua, evocando la profecía del anciano Simeón, que, en aquella ocasión, anunció el dramático destino del Mesías y de su Madre. El evangelista ha recordado el hecho con detalles: dos personas ancianas, llenas de fe y de Espíritu Santo, Simeón y Ana, acogen a Jesús en el santuario de Jerusalén. Personifican al "resto de Israel", vigilante en la espera y dispuesto a ir al encuentro del Señor, como ya lo habían hecho los pastores en la noche de su nacimiento en Belén.

Que nosotros, como Simeón y Anna, vigilemos a Cristo, la luz del mundo. Que la luz de Cristo, la luz de la fe, la esperanza y el amor que recibimos en el bautismo, brille a través de nosotros y guíe nuestros caminos.

Hablando de pedirle a Dios que nos guíe en el viaje, me gustaría aprovechar este momento para agradecer a Silvia Barajas y Kathy Dummer por su servicio en nuestra oficina parroquial. Entre las dos, han trabajado en las parroquias de San Juan Pablo II y Santa Teresa por veinticinco años. Estoy agradecido por su amabilidad y apoyo en la oficina y ofrezco mis oraciones durante la transición. Que el Señor las cuide a ellas, a sus seres queridos y a nuestra comunidad parroquial y nos guíe en todo lo que hacemos. Que la luz del amor y la gracia de Dios brille siempre sobre nosotros.
