A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Wednesday, February 2nd, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It is the fortieth day after Christmas, which is when St. Joseph and the Blessed Mother brought the child Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem. There Simeon and the prophetess Anna recognized that the forty-day old infant was the Messiah, the light for all nations. Remembering that Christ is our light, we begin Mass that day with the blessing of the candles and a brief procession. That is why this day is popularly known as Candlemas. Because it is forty days after Christmas, many cultures wait to take down their Christmas decorations until that day. Since Jesus was presented in the temple that day, there is a popular custom in Latin America to bring their statues of the Baby Jesus to church to be blessed before putting them away. There will be a blessing of the statues of the Baby Jesus at the Spanish Mass at 7:00pm on Wednesday, February 2nd.

It is great to reflect on the Child Jesus. I am happy that we have a statue of the Infant of Prague in our church. The Child Jesus reminds us of His humility and love for us. We see our Savior living as one of us, and He does so in order that He may love us perfectly on the cross, conquer death on Easter Sunday, and send His Holy Spirit upon us so that we might be children of God and live in union with Him here on earth and forever in heaven. In 2007, I received my godmother's prayer book from when she was a little girl, and I quickly found one of the chapters simple and profound. It refers to the Child Jesus and is on the meaning of life, what a good child should live for: "A Catholic child should have...one great desire: to love Jesus; one great joy: to possess Jesus; one great fear: to lose Jesus; one great model: the Child Jesus; one great business: to work for Jesus; one great delight: to speak to Jesus; one great wish: to be like Jesus; one great care: to do the will of Jesus; one great sorrow: the sufferings of Jesus; one great hope: to live forever with Jesus; one great refuge: the Heart of Jesus; one great glory: to be crowned with Jesus." May we live in union forever with Christ; may the light of His love shine upon us and bring us joy and eternal happiness.

Know of my prayers for you, and let us continue to pray for one another.

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este miércoles, 2 de febrero, es la Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor. Es el cuadragésimo día después de Navidad, cuando San José y la Santísima Madre llevaron al niño Jesús al Templo de Jerusalén. Allí Simeón y la profetisa Ana reconocieron que el niño de cuarenta días era el Mesías, la luz que alumbría a las naciones. Recordando que Cristo es nuestra luz, comenzamos la misa de ese día con la bendición de las velas y una breve procesión. Por eso, este día es conocido popularmente como Candelaria. Debido a que son cuarenta días después de Navidad, muchas culturas esperan hasta ese día para quitar sus adornos navideños. Porque el Niño Jesús fue presentado en el templo ese día, hay una costumbre popular de traer sus imágenes del Niño Jesús a la iglesia ese día para la bendición y levantada del Niño Dios. Les invito a traer sus imágenes y velas para ser bendecidas en la misa en español a las 7:00 pm, el miércoles 2 de febrero.

Estoy feliz que tenemos una estatua del Niño de Praga en nuestra iglesia. El Niño Jesús nos recuerda su humildad y amor por nosotros. Vemos a nuestro Salvador viviendo como uno de nosotros y lo hacía para amarnos perfectamente en la cruz, vencer la muerte el domingo de Pascua y enviar su Espíritu Santo sobre nosotros para que seamos hijos de Dios y vivamos en unión con él en este mundo y para siempre en el cielo. En el 2007, yo recibí el librito de oraciones de mi madrina cuando ella era niña y encontré un capítulo muy sencillo y profundo sobre el Niño Jesús y el significado de la vida, para qué debe vivir un buen niño: "Un niño católico debe tener... un gran deseo: amar a Jesús; una gran alegría: poseer a Jesús; un gran temor: perder a Jesús; un gran modelo: el niño Jesús. un gran negocio: trabajar para Jesús; un gran deleite: hablarle a Jesús; un gran deseo: vivir como Jesús; un gran cuidado: hacer la voluntad de Jesús; un gran dolor: los sufrimientos de Jesús; una gran esperanza: vivir para siempre con Jesús; un gran refugio: el Corazón de Jesús; una gran gloria: estar coronado con Jesús." Que siempre vivamos en unión con Cristo, la fuente de nuestro gozo y felicidad eterna.

Yo rezo por ustedes; sigamos rezando los unos por los otros.
