

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our second reading this Sunday (1 Cor. 7:32-35) begins by speaking of anxiety: "I should like you to be free of anxieties." St. Paul then points out that some are anxious about the things of the Lord and others are anxious about the things of the world. Both can be anxious. This leads us to wonder what exactly is anxiety. After all, isn't it normal to worry or to be concerned? However, anxiety is more than being concerned or worried. The Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines anxiety as: "1 a: painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usually over an impending or anticipated ill; b: fearful concern or interest." To be worried is one thing, but to experience inner turmoil about a future or potential outcome is another. Anxiety can consume us. It is when we can't think or look at anything but a failed or painful outcome. We can lose a sense of hope or feel afraid and lost. However, we remember that Christ is Emmanuel ("God-with-us"); we have hope. Hope is "the theological virtue by which we desire and expect from God both eternal life and the grace we need to attain it" (cf. Catechism). The Lord will lead us through the tough times. Certainly, in this brief letter, I cannot address the many ways to find hope. After all, each of us is different, with particular backgrounds, concerns, histories, and personalities. To complicate things, some experience clinical anxiety. However, there is one thing I find worth accentuating: stay close to Christ. He is our strength, our hope, and our salvation. We can discover His presence and receive His grace through the sacraments, praying with Scripture, and meditating on the life, passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Spending time with family and friends, being a part of the community, is also a source of consolation and support.

This week is Catholic Schools Week. We are blessed to have Bishop McNamara Catholic School (3-Year Old Preschool-Grade 12), and I am grateful for your support. Please continue to promote our school to others. Also, the Illinois Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program is still taking donations. Individuals who donate can specify that they would like their donation to fund the Catholic education of a student to attend Bishop McNamara Catholic School. Donors to the Scholarship Program through Empower Illinois can receive a credit on their state income taxes in the amount of 75 percent of the donation. Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Nuestra segunda lectura de este domingo (1 Cor. 7: 32-35) comienza hablando de las preocupaciones: "Yo quisiera que ustedes vivieran sin preocupaciones." San Pablo luego dice que algunos están preocupados por las cosas del Señor y otros por las cosas de la vida. Ambos pueden ser preocupantes. Entonces nos preguntamos, ¿Es normal preocuparse o estar preocupado, no? A veces experimentamos ansiedad y nos falta la esperanza cuando estamos preocupados. La definición de ansiedad es "1. Estado mental que se caracteriza por una gran inquietud, una intensa excitación y una extrema inseguridad. 2. Angustia que acompaña a algunas enfermedades." Estar preocupado es una cosa, pero experimentar una confusión interna sobre un futuro o un resultado potencial es otra. La ansiedad puede consumirnos y mantener nuestros pensamientos en un resultado fallido o doloroso, perdiendo el sentido de la esperanza o sintiéndose asustados y perdidos. Más, sin embargo, recordamos que Cristo es Emmanuel ("Dios con nosotros"); tenemos esperanza. La esperanza es "virtud infusa que capacita al hombre para tener confianza y plena certeza de conseguir la vida eterna y los medios, tanto sobrenaturales como naturales, necesarios para alcanzarla, apoyado en el auxilio omnipotente de Dios" (cf. Santo Tomás de Aquino). El Señor nos guiará a través de los tiempos difíciles. Ciertamente, en esta breve carta, no puedo abordar las muchas formas de encontrar esperanza. Después de todo, cada uno de nosotros es diferente, con antecedentes, preocupaciones, historias y personalidades particulares. Complicando esto, algunos experimentan ansiedad clínica. Sin embargo, hay una cosa que encuentro que vale la pena acentuar: manténganse cerca de Cristo. Él es nuestra fuerza, esperanza y salvación. Podemos descubrir su presencia y recibir su gracia a través de los sacramentos, rezando con las Escrituras y meditando en la vida, pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús. Pasar tiempo con la familia y los amigos, ser parte de la comunidad, también es una fuente de consuelo y apoyo.

Esta semana es la Semana de las Escuelas Católicas. Tenemos la bendición de tener la Escuela Católica de Bishop McNamara (de preescolar de 3 años a grado 12), y estoy agradecido por su apoyo. Continuemos promoviendo nuestra escuela a otros. Además, el Programa de Becas de Crédito Tributario Invest in Kids de Illinois todavía está aceptando donaciones. Las personas que donan pueden especificar que les gustaría que su donación financiara la educación católica de un estudiante para asistir a la Escuela Católica de Bishop McNamara.
