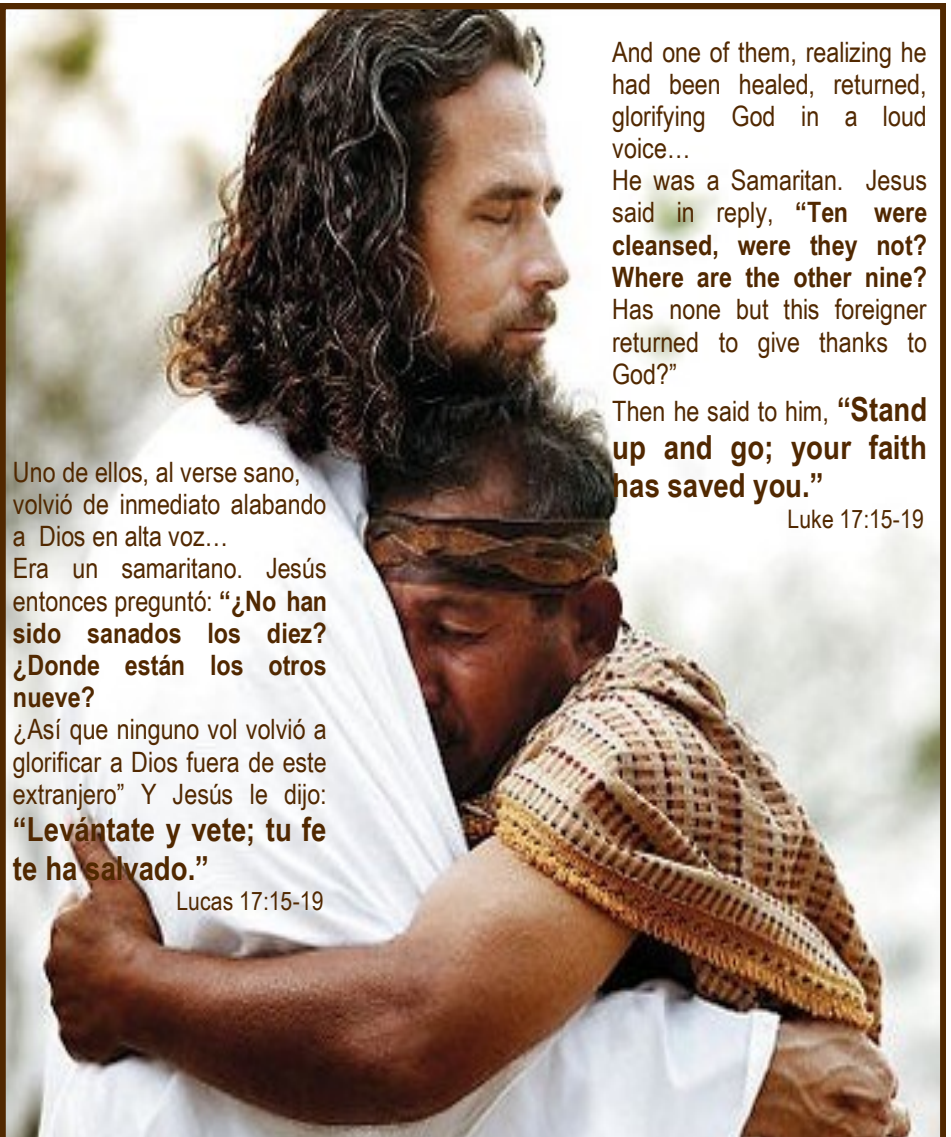

WHY THE FUSS ABOUT MARY?

As I write this article for the bulletin, the Church actually celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, and I am at the airport with my fellow pilgrims, headed to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Our Lady of Ocotlan, in Mexico City and Tlaxcala. What a great timing for all of these in the month of October, the month of Mary. Recently, I have been doing a lot of teaching about the Blessed Virgin Mary and what we really believe as Catholics about her, why we honor, venerate and love her. In fact, I have also just done a presentation with Young Adults at Maternity BVM Church on why we believe what we believe about her. I just realized how ill equipped many Catholics are when it comes to defending our Church's belief about Mary in my own words. So here some basic truths to remember about our Catholic Mariology.

1. **CHOSEN BY THE FATHER.** Mary is fully human, but God chose her to be the mother of Jesus. That counts for a lot. In the Gospel of Luke, Elizabeth said to her, "Blessed are you among women!"
2. **IMMACULATE CONCEPTION.** She was chosen, set apart, for this role. And because her role is to bear Jesus, who is God, she had to be a worthy and pure vessel. So, she was conceived in the womb of St. Anne, without the corruption of sin. God literally created in her a pathway of grace, so that God could insert Himself into the human condition, for the purpose of our redemption through Christ.
3. **MOTHER OF GOD.** Because she was chosen to be the mother of Jesus, who is God Incarnate, she then is the "mother of God." This may sound surprising to some people, but it is truly the surprising consequence of the surprising truth that God became man.
4. **PERPETUAL VIRGINITY.** The Church also holds that by all the things that were revealed to Mary and Joseph about Jesus, their relationship with each other was elevated to a eschatological level, that Mary remained a Virgin even after the birth of Jesus. In the Bible, when a reference is made to Jesus' mother and brothers, the "brothers" here are not really blood siblings, but it can pertain to cousins, friends and familiar neighbors.
5. **ASSUMPTION.** Death is a consequence of sin, as we learn in the Genesis story. Because she was conceived without sin, then it makes sense that Mary, at the end of her earthly life, transitioned into the other side of life in a qualitatively different way. The Church calls it "dormition" followed by her assumption into heaven body and soul. We know of two others that went into heaven body and soul – Enoch and Elijah.
6. **MEDIATRIX.** It is true that Jesus is the only mediator between God and man. But Mary mediates between us and her son Jesus. We know that Mary's intercession is efficacious, based on the story of the wedding Feast of Cana in the Gospel of John. As we ask other people in this world to pray for us, we should be even more comfortable to ask Mary to pray for us, because even now and into eternity, she is given to the Church as a Mother by her own son Jesus, as he hung upon the cross.
7. **FULL OF GRACE.** The Angel Gabriel addressed her this way. In other words, she is full of the favor of God.

People who do not want to have anything to do with their friend's mother, have a very dysfunctional idea of relationships. This is true for human relationship, and even more so with divine relationship. How can a Christian say they love the Lord when they do not want to have anything to do with His mother? As Christians, our relationship with God, is such that when we love others, including Mary and the saints, we also love God. This is the true economy of divine love. May our love and devotion to our Heavenly Mother grow deeper and stronger.

¿PORQUE EL ALBOROTO CON MARIA?

Mientras escribo este artículo para el boletín, la Iglesia celebra la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Santo Rosario, estoy en el aeropuerto con mis compañeros peregrinos, en camino al Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe y Nuestra Señora de Ocotlán en la Ciudad de México y Tlaxcala. Que gran momento para todo esto en el mes de octubre, el mes de María. Recientemente, he estado enseñando mucho acerca de la Bendita Madre María y lo que de verdad creemos como católicos acerca de ella, porque la honramos, veneramos y amamos. De hecho, hice una presentación con Jóvenes Adultos en la Iglesia de Maternity BVM en por qué creemos lo que creemos de ella. Me acabo de dar cuenta de lo mal equipado que están muchos católicos cuando se trata de defender nuestra creencia de la Iglesia acerca de María, en mis propias palabras. Así que aquí están algunas verdades básicas para recordar acerca de nuestra Mariología Católica.

1. **ELEGIDA POR EL PADRE.** María es completamente humana, pero Dios la eligió para ser la madre de Jesús. Eso cuenta mucho. En el Evangelio de Lucas, Elizabeth le dijo, "Bendita eres entre las mujeres!"
2. **INMACULADA CONSEPCION.** Ella fue elegida, apartada para este papel. Y porque su papel es llevar a Jesús, que es Dios, tenía que ser un vaso puro y digno. Así que fue concebida en el vientre de Santa Anna, sin la corrupción del pecado. Dios literalmente la creo en el camino de gracia, para que Dios pudiera insertarse a si Mismo a la condición humana, para el propósito de nuestra redención a través de Cristo.
3. **MADRE DE DIOS.** Porque fue elegida para ser la madre de Jesús, quien es Dios Encarnado, ella es entonces la "madre de Dios." Esto puede sonar sorprendente para algunos, pero es de verdad la sorprendente consecuencia que Dios se hizo hombre.
4. **VIRGINIDAD PERPETUA.** La Iglesia también sostiene que por todas las cosas que fueron reveladas a María y José acerca de Jesús, su relación entre ellos fue elevada a un nivel escatológico, que María permaneció Virgen después del nacimiento de Jesús. En la Biblia, cuando se hace referencia a Jesús madre y hermanos, los "hermanos" en verdad no son hermanos de sangre, pero puede referirse a primos, amigos, vecinos conocidos.
5. **ASUNCION.** Muerte es consecuencia del pecado, como aprendemos en la historia de Genesis. Porque fue concebida sin pecado, entonces tiene sentido que María al final de su vida terrenal, paso a la otra vida de una manera cualitativamente diferente. La Iglesia le llama "dormition" seguida por su acención al cielo cuerpo y alma. Sabemos de otros dos que se fueron al cielo cuerpo y alma- Enoch and Elijah.
6. **MEDIADOR.** Es verdad que Jesús es el único mediador entre Dios y hombre. Pero María es mediadora entre nosotros y su hijo Jesús. Sabemos que la intercesión de María es eficaz, basado en la historia de la Fiesta de la Boda de Cana en el evangelio de Juan. Así como le pedimos a otras personas en este mundo que oren por nosotros, deberíamos estar mas cómodos en pedirle a María orar por nosotros, porque aun ahora y en la eternidad, ella es entregada a la Iglesia como Madre por su propio hijo Jesús, mientras El colgaba de la cruz.
7. **LLENA DE GRACIA.** El ángel Gabriel se le dirigió de esta manera. En otras palabras, ella esta llena del favor de Dios.

Las personas que no quieren tener nada que ver con la madre de sus amigos tienen una idea muy disfuncional de las relaciones. Esto es verdad para relaciones humanas y aún más con relaciones divinas. Como puede un Cristiano decir que aman al Señor y no quiere tener nada que ver con Su Madre? Como cristianos, nuestra relación con Dios, es tal que cuando amamos a otros, incluyendo a María y los santos, también amamos a Dios. Esto es la verdadera economía del divino amor. Que nuestro amor y devoción a nuestra Madre Celestial crezcan mas profundas y fuertes.

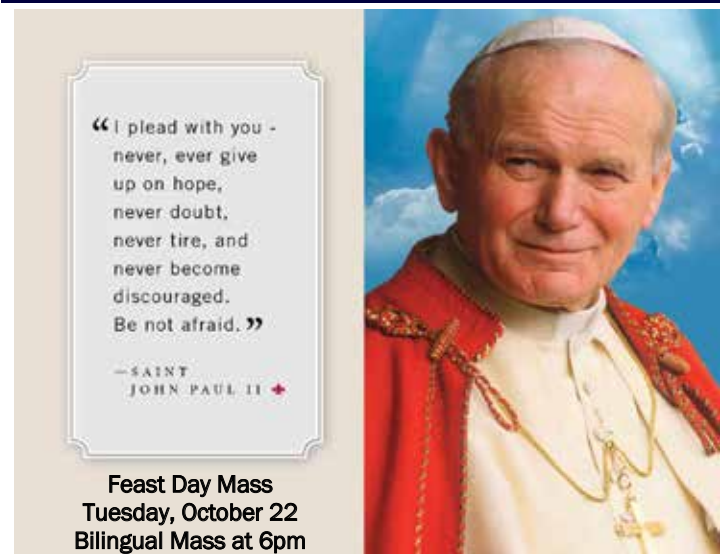



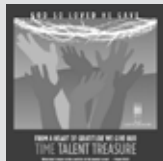
