

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Monday is the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. He is commonly known for his life of poverty and love of creation. Because of his love for creation, this weekend we invoke St. Francis' intercession when we bless the pets. There is much more to the story of this saint. He was born in 1181 in Assisi (in Italy) and died on October 3, 1226. He was the son of a merchant and enjoyed his father's wealth. After many years of pursuing earthly glories and pleasures, he gradually experienced a conversion and felt called to serve our Lord when he had an experience of Christ while praying before the crucifix in the church of San Damiano. St. Francis renounced his possessions and emptied himself so that he could be filled with the charity and mercy of Christ and give himself completely in service to God and neighbor. He had an ardent devotion to the eucharist and is traditionally known for the first nativity scene. In both the eucharist and the nativity, we remember our Lord who loves us so much that He has humbled Himself, descended from the majesty of heaven, and entered our lives, our poverty, so that He could share with us the riches of His mercy and save and sanctify us. St. Francis was in awe of the love and humility of God. He conformed his life to Christ and sought to allow it to transform him. He desired to love what the Lord loves and as the Lord loves. The love of God, experienced in the Holy Mass, transformed his life, as is apparent in this segment of one of his letters to the entire Order of Friars Minor: "Let the whole of mankind tremble, the whole world shake, and the heavens exult when Christ, the Son of the living God, is [present] on the altar in the hands of a priest. O admirable heights and sublime lowness! O sublime humility! O humble sublimity! That the Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under the little form of bread! Look, brothers, at the humility of God and pour out your hearts before Him! Humble yourselves, as well, that you may be exalted by Him. Therefore, hold back nothing of yourselves for yourselves so that He Who gives Himself totally to you may receive you totally." Let us respond to our Lord who gives Himself to us by giving ourselves to Him. May we continue to cultivate a love for our Lord in the Holy Eucharist and allow that to strengthen us and transform our lives.


UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Este lunes es la fiesta de San Francisco de Asís. Es conocido por su vida de pobreza y amor por la creación. Debido a su amor por la creación, este fin de semana invitamos la intercesión de San Francisco cuando bendecimos a las mascotas. Hay mucho más en la historia de este santo. Nació en 1181 en Asís (Italia) y murió el 3 de octubre de 1226. Era hijo de un comerciante y disfrutaba de la riqueza de su padre.

Después de muchos años de perseguir glorias y placeres terrenales, gradualmente experimentó una conversión y se sintió llamado a servir a nuestro Señor cuando tuvo una experiencia de Cristo mientras rezaba ante el crucifijo en la iglesia de San Damián. San Francisco renunció a sus posesiones y se despojó de sí mismo para llenarse de la caridad y la misericordia de Cristo y entregarse completamente al servicio de Dios y del prójimo. Tenía una devoción ardiente por la eucaristía y es tradicionalmente conocido por el primer nacimiento de navidad. La eucaristía y la Natividad expresan que nuestro Señor nos amaba tanto que se ha humillado, descendido de la majestad del cielo y entrado en nuestras vidas, en nuestra pobreza, para compartir con nosotros las riquezas de su misericordia, salvarnos y santificarnos. San Francisco estaba asombrado por el amor y la humildad de Dios. Conformó su vida con Cristo y deseaba amar lo que ama el Señor y como ama el Señor. El amor de Dios, experimentado en la Santa Misa, transformó su vida, como es aparente en este segmento de una de sus cartas a toda la Orden de los Frailes Menores: "Todo hombre tema, todo el mundo se estremezca y exalte el cielo, cuando sobre el altar, en las manos del sacerdote, está Cristo, el hijo de Dios vivo. ¡Oh altura admirable y estupenda dignación! ¡Oh humildad sublime! ¡Oh humilde sublimidad, que el Señor Dios del universo e Hijo de Dios se humille de ese modo, hasta esconderse en un pequeño trozo de pan, por nuestra salvación! Mirad, hermanos, la humildad de Dios y derramad ante él vuestros corazones; humillaos también vosotros, para que Él os ensalce. Nada vuestro, pues, retengáis para vosotros, para que os acoja totalmente quien se ofrece totalmente a vosotros." Respondamos a nuestro Señor quien se entrega a nosotros, entregándonos a Él. Que continuemos cultivando el amor por nuestro Señor en la Sagrada Eucaristía y permitiendo que eso nos fortalezca y transforme nuestras vidas.

Making, Testing, and Deciding

There are at least three take-aways from the readings today. In the **Making** of man and woman in this second creation story, God builds them up from the same stuff. In the first creation story, read during the Easter Vigil, they are made into God's own image and likeness (Genesis 1:27). Made as equals. In the **Testing** of Jesus, the Pharisees try to trip him up with legal loopholes. Jesus does not play that game. In **Deciding** who belongs to the Kingdom of God, it is Jesus and not his handlers who choose. Children are important. So is everyone else.

- ◆ How will I foster the equality of both women and men?
- ◆ How will I avoid loopholes and, instead, tell the truth?
- ◆ Just like Jesus, how will I treat everyone the same as equal members of God's Kingdom?
