A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of November is set aside for remembering and praying for the faithful departed. We begin the month with All Saints Day, celebrating the Church triumphant in heaven and asking for their intercession. The following day, November 2nd, we remember the faithful departed at Mass. During the evening Mass we will light candles in memory of those who have died this past year. People will bring pictures of their deceased loved ones, which will remain in the church until the weekend before Thanksgiving, and we remember in our prayers throughout this month those who have died whose names are being written in our Book of Remembrance.

When we speak about what happens after death, I find that there is often confusion around purgatory. For the most part, we understand heaven and hell, but purgatory seems less clear to many. When speaking about purgatory in sections 1030 through 1032, the Catechism says: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." It references St. Gregory the Great, who died in 604 and taught that, "As for certain lesser faults, we must believe that, before the Final Judgment, there is a purifying fire." St. John Chrysostom, who died in 407, said, "Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them." This practice of praying for the dead is mentioned in the Bible: "In doing this [Judas Maccabeus] acted in a very excellent and noble way, inasmuch as he had the resurrection of the dead in view...If he did this with a view to the splendid reward that awaits those who had gone to rest in godliness, it was a holy and pious thought. Thus he made atonement for the dead that they might be freed from this sin" (cf. 2 Macc. 12:43-46). Confident in God's mercy and love after we depart from this world, let us continue to invoke our Lord and ask for His grace, mercy, and pardon upon our loved ones. Let us offer Masses, rosaries, and prayers at the cemetery. What a loving and holy act it is to pray for those who have gone before us. May they rest in the peace of Christ.

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El mes de noviembre está dedicado para recordar y rezar por los fieles difuntos. Comenzamos el mes con el Día de Todos los Santos, celebrando a la Iglesia triunfante en el cielo y pidiendo su intercesión. Al día siguiente, el 2 de noviembre, recordamos a los fieles difuntos en la misa. En la misa de la tarde vamos a encender velas en memoria de quienes murieron el año pasado. Las personas traen fotos de sus seres queridos que quedarán en la iglesia

hasta el fin de semana antes del Día de Acción de Gracias y recordamos en nuestras oraciones a aquellos que murieron cuyos nombres están escritos en nuestro Libro de Recuerdo.

Cuando hablamos de lo que sucede después de la muerte, encuentro que a menudo hay confusión sobre purgatorio. En su mayor parte, entendemos el cielo y el infierno, pero a muchos el purgatorio parece menos claro. Al hablar sobre el purgatorio en las secciones 1030 a 1032, el Catecismo dice: "Los que mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios, pero imperfectamente purificados, aunque están seguros de su eterna salvación, sufren después de su muerte una purificación, a fin de obtener la santidad necesaria para entrar en la alegría del cielo." Se refiere a San Gregorio Magno, quien murió en 604 y enseñó que: "Respecto a ciertas faltas ligeras, es necesario creer que, antes del juicio, existe un fuego purificador..." San Juan Crisóstomo, quien murió en 407, dijo: "Llevémosles socorros y hagamos su conmemoración. Si los hijos de Job fueron purificados por el sacrificio de su padre, ¿por qué habrían de dudar de que nuestras ofrendas por los muertos les lleven un cierto consuelo? No dudemos, pues, en socorrer a los que han partido y en ofrecer nuestras plegarias por ellos." Esta práctica de orar por los difuntos está mencionada en la Biblia: "Las mandó [Judas] a Jerusalén para ofrecer un sacrificio por el pecado, obrando muy hermosa y noblemente, pensando en la resurrección... Si consideraba que una magnífica recompensa está reservada a los que duermen piadosamente, era un pensamiento santo y piadoso. Por eso mandó hacer este sacrificio expiatorio en favor de los muertos, para que quedaran liberados del pecado" (cf. 2 Macc. 12: 43-46). Confiados en la misericordia y el amor de Dios que duran para siempre, sigamos invocando a nuestro Señor y pidiendo su gracia, misericordia y perdón a nuestros seres queridos. Ofrezcamos misas, rosarios y oraciones en el cementerio. Orar por los que nos han precedido es una acción de amor y santidad. Que descansen en la paz de Cristo.







We prepare for eternal life by choosing to love and follow God. Our journey with Christ includes equipping our consciences to make morally good judgments at the end of life. While no summary can substitute for thorough catechesis, one thing is clear: we are entrusted by God with the gift of life. This obliges us to make use of appropriate, effective medical care. The Church affirms the inviolable dignity of every person, regardless of the duration or extent of the person's incapacity. Nothing diminishes the sanctity of a person's life, or the obligation to protect and care for it. Those who are sick should not be alone, and, even after death, accompaniment continues by praying for those who have passed.

We are entrusted by God with the gift of life.


