AN OCTOBER TO REMEMBER

This month looks like a very promising month, one that offers many memorable moments for our community. I am excited, and I hope everyone is feeling the same.

BLESSING OF ANIMALS. St. Francis' feast day has been observed this year with the blessing of animals. This is always a joyful feast, especially because we are all very fond of our pets, and we treat them as part of our families. Blessing of our pets is a sign of our continued desire to be good stewards of the earth, and the many creatures that God has entrusted to us in creation.

LIVING ROSARY. Our Living Rosary devotion on Wednesday, October 9, is in observance of the feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, which falls on October 7. In the Church, the month of October is observed as a Marian Month, because other than the Rosary feast, other major Marian celebrations include the feast of Our Lady of the Pillar (October 12), Our Lady Mother Most Admirable (October 20), Our Lady of Victory (October 26). The traditional feast of the Divine Maternity of our Lady and Queenship of Mary is also on October 11. The rosary is a very special tool for meditation on the life of Jesus using the mantra of the Hail Mary to center us in our meditation. It is one of our most solemn observances as a parish throughout the year, and we need to continue this very special tradition that we have started.

JP2 OKTOBERFEST. I have said it in most masses last weekend that this is our most important fundraising and community spirit event of the year. That is why we need to support it all together, as long as we consider this parish as our spiritual home. We are being invited to celebrate as a family what the Lord has done to bring us together. As a fundraising event, we need the help and participation of all our parishioners, in whatever way they can. If your family is unable to join in our festivities and fundraising dinner, we ask that we still consider making some type of donation to say "thank you" to our parish, and to support our worthwhile ministries. As a community event, we invite you to engage yourselves in the work of unity and fostering the spirit of our parish. I ask you, my dear parishioners, to invite others outside our parish to experience the spirit that is present here. Our parish has so much to offer, and this needs to be made known for others to see and support.

THE FALLING LEAVES. This month is the silent witness to the annual spectacle of fall colors. I always look forward to this month, because the Fall Season is my favorite season; it gives me a sense of nostalgia and warms my spirit with the melancholia of the passing of time. During this season I always see to it that I keep my eyes open to the ways that nature reminds us of the temporality of existence.

ALL HALLOW'S EVE. The last day of the month of October is the observance of All Hollow's Eve, the evening before All Hollow's day, or All Saints' Day. The name derives from the Old English 'hallowed' meaning holy or sanctified and is now usually contracted to the more familiar word "Hallowe'en." I am sure it will be of greater significance for our children if they are taught what this evening really is all about. That it is not just a costume party, but a time to reflect about becoming like the saints. That it is an occasion to be inspired, not to be scared.

Enjoy this month, dear Church, and make it an October to remember!

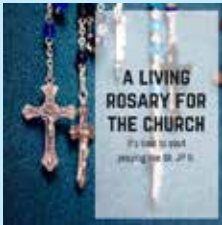

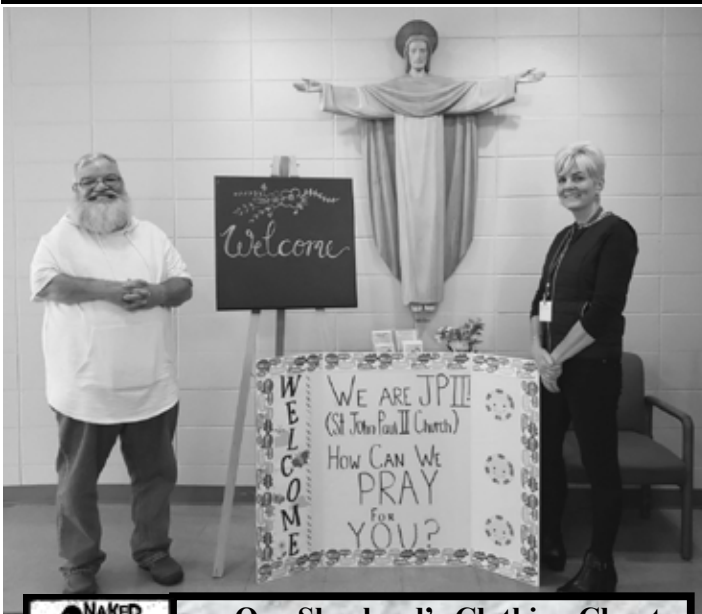

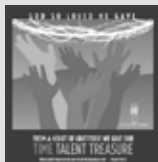
