A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

We begin the month of November with All Saints Day, celebrating the Church triumphant in heaven and asking for the prayers of the saints. They have run the race and won the crown. They persevered in living a holy life united with Christ here on earth, and so they are now eternally united with Him in heaven. Their lives encourage and inspire us, and their prayers strengthen us.



Tomorrow, November 2nd, is All Souls' Day, when we remember the faithful departed. During the evening Mass we will light candles in memory of those who have died this past year. People have begun to bring pictures of their deceased loved ones, which will remain in the church until the weekend before Thanksgiving, and we remember in our prayers those who have died whose names are being written in our Book of Remembrance, which is by the entrance to the church.

The month of November is set aside for remembering and praying for the faithful departed. When we speak about what happens after death, I find that there is often confusion around purgatory. For the most part, we understand what heaven and hell are, but purgatory seems less clear to many. When speaking about purgatory in sections 1030 through 1032, the Catechism says: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." It references St. Gregory the Great, who died in 604 and taught that purgatory stems from God's mercy and justice, "As for certain lesser faults, we must believe that, before the Final Judgment, there is a purifying fire." St. John Chrysostom, who died in 407, spoke about praying for the deceased, "Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them." This practice of praying for the dead is mentioned in the Bible: "In doing this [Judas Maccabeus] acted in a very excellent and noble way, inasmuch as he had the resurrection of the dead in view... If he did this with a view to the splendid reward that awaits those who had gone to rest in godliness, it was a holy and pious thought. Thus he made atonement for the dead that they might be freed from this sin" (cf. 2 Macc. 12:43-46). Confident in God's mercy and love after we depart from this world, let us continue to invoke our Lord and ask for His grace and pardon upon our loved ones. Let us offer Masses, rosaries, prayers at the cemetery, and even our sufferings for them. What a loving and holy act it is to pray for those who have gone before us. May they rest in the peace of Christ.

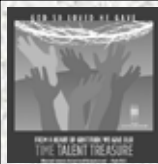
Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Comenzamos el mes de noviembre con el Día de Todos los Santos, celebrando la Iglesia triunfante en el cielo y pidiendo las oraciones de los santos. Han corrido la carrera y han ganado la corona. Ellos perseveraron viviendo una vida santa unidos con Cristo aquí en la tierra, y por eso ahora están eternamente unidos con Él en el cielo. Sus vidas nos animan e inspiran y sus oraciones nos fortalecen.

Mañana, 2 de noviembre, es el Día de Todos los Fieles Difuntos. Durante la misa de la tarde, encenderemos velas en memoria de nuestros parroquianos que han fallecido durante el año pasado. Unas personas han comenzado a traer fotografías de sus seres queridos fallecidos, que permanecerán en la iglesia hasta el fin de semana anterior al Día de Acción de Gracias, y durante este mes vamos a recordar en nuestras oraciones a los fallecidos cuyos nombres están escritos en nuestro Libro del Recuerdo, que está a la entrada de la Iglesia.

El mes de noviembre está dedicado para rezar por los difuntos. Cuando hablamos de lo que sucede después de la muerte, muchas veces encuentro confusión sobre purgatorio. Generalmente entendemos el cielo y el infierno, pero a muchos el purgatorio parece menos claro. Hablando sobre el purgatorio en las secciones 1030 a 1032, el Catecismo dice: "Los que mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios, pero imperfectamente purificados, aunque están seguros de su eterna salvación, sufren después de su muerte una purificación, a fin de obtener la santidad necesaria para entrar en la alegría del cielo." Se refiere a San Gregorio Magno, quien murió en 604 y enseñó que purgatorio es de la misericordia y justicia de Dios: "Respecto a ciertas ligeras faltas, es necesario creer que, antes del juicio, existe un fuego purificador..." San Juan Crisóstomo, quien murió en 407, dijo: "Llevémosles socorros y hagamos su conmemoración. Si los hijos de Job fueron purificados por el sacrificio de su padre, ¿por qué habríamos de dudar de que nuestras ofrendas por los muertos les llevan un cierto consuelo? No dudemos, pues, en socorrer a los que han partido y en ofrecer nuestras plegarias por ellos." Esta práctica de rezar por los difuntos está mencionada en la Biblia: "Les mandó [Judas] a Jerusalén para ofrecer un sacrificio por el pecado, obrando muy hermosa y noblemente, pensando en la resurrección... Si consideraba que una magnífica recompensa está reservada a los que duermen piadosamente, era un pensamiento santo y piadoso. Por eso mandó hacer este sacrificio expiatorio en favor de los muertos, para que quedaran liberados del pecado" (cf. 2 Macc. 12: 43-46). Confiados en la misericordia y el amor de Dios que duran para siempre, sigamos invocando a nuestro Señor y pidiendo su gracia y perdón a nuestros seres queridos. Ofrezcamos misas, rosarios, oraciones en el cementerio y nuestros sufrimientos por ellos. Rezar por los que nos han precedido es una acción de amor y santidad. Que descansen en la paz de Cristo.

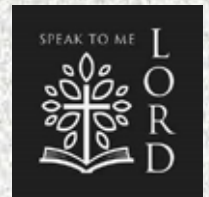

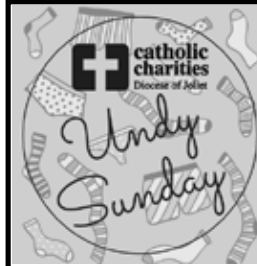
