WHAT IS MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP?

When our Parish Council formulated our parish mission statement, I really appreciated the wisdom underneath it, and was very much enthused by the phrase “Bringing Jesus to everyone, and everyone to Jesus...”. It felt like an excellent summary of the things that we do as a parish family.



Today, November 5, 2019, I had a meeting with a group of individuals from the diocesan curia and the deaneries, to talk about how to bring to light the Bishop's Pastoral Letter “Go, He Said...” which was distributed throughout the diocese one year ago. There was a lot of energy among the people present, to talk about being pro-active in responding to the call to missionary discipleship. (PAUSE). Alright, I know the words “Missionary Discipleship” might sound foreign or strange to many of you, my dear parishioners. But if you read my bulletin article last weekend, and if you have read the Bishop’s Pastoral Letter, you might already have some basic idea of what we are talking about.

Missionary Discipleship doesn't mean that we have to go to another country or to leave our home and community to convert people to Christ. It means that we are being called to share our faith to others in whatever way we can.

Missionary Discipleship is not about being an all-knowing teacher of the truths of God, but simply being a joyful witness of God's love and grace, at work in the world today, therefore inviting people to discover the same in their own lives. It is about looking into your own faith and discovering how God has worked in your life, and being a witness to that gift.

Missionary Discipleship is not about being perfect and faultless. Rather, it is finding a way for people to fall in love with God, whatever goes on in their life.

Missionary Discipleship is not having to do things on your own. Rather, it is about working with others to bring one another to Christ. It is about sharing your mission with the community, with the parish, with your friends and support groups, with the people that you meet in your ministry, with your own family, with those around you who need to find God in their lives.

Missionary discipleship is about our parishioners generously mentoring our children to the faith. It is about praying with the young people of our parish so that they can be connected with God, and find in Him a loving and compassionate companion in their life's journey. Jacob Levy and Cindy Nichols stood at the Lisieux Center one Friday morning and invited those who went to the clothing closet to pray with them. More than a hundred people later, they are now telling me stories of others who are thanking them and joyfully reporting that their prayers have been answered. That's missionary discipleship.

I got out of that meeting today feeling proud that we have a culture of missionary discipleship in our parish, but there is so much more to be done. If you want to know more, and how, and what else, you are welcome to have a cup of tea or coffee with me, and we can talk about it. I am looking for missionary disciples who want to share this dream with the Bishop, and with those who were there today in that meeting.

The Church needs you and me. Now more than ever, our Church needs people who are willing to be bold in proclaiming the Kingdom, because so many people need to hear it, including those who come to us at mass on Sundays, and those whom we never ever see walk through our doors. May God bless our efforts to BRING JESUS TO EVERYONE and EVERYONE TO JESUS. Amen.




