### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Next Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. It is hard to believe that the following Sunday is the beginning of Advent, which consists of the four weeks leading up to Christmas. During Advent, we reflect on how we can prepare for the coming of Christ. Christ comes to meet us in three ways: in the past



through the Incarnation (the Annunciation and Christmas), in the present through the sacraments, and in the future at the Final Judgment. The First Sunday of Advent is also the beginning of the liturgical calendar of the Church. So next Sunday we will conclude the current liturgical year by crowning the calendar with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe, recalling that Jesus is the king of heaven and earth. He is the king who has humbled Himself and given up His life for us. He hasn't abandoned us to fight our earthly battles and struggles alone, but He has come to us as a child born in Bethlehem, lived for us, died for us, taken up the cross for us, and risen for us. Christ our king has been victorious. He has conquered death and prepared the way to the Kingdom of Heaven, where He sits at the right hand of the Father, reigning in glory. Our Lord Jesus Christ continues to be among us, and He desires that our world be transformed through the Church and her members, giving us a glimpse of His kingdom, which is of justice, love, and peace. May we continue to serve our Lord and King and follow Him together, listening to His voice in our daily prayer, loving Him through works of charity, and devoutly receiving our Lord and King in the sacraments of the Church.

Next weekend, I will have more information about the parish's year of the Eucharist. We will dedicate a year, beginning next Sunday, to a greater understanding and love of our Lord in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Let us stay close to our Lord and pray for one another, and know of my prayers for all of you.




