## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

## UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Come, Lord Jesus!" The last three sentences of the Book of Revelation are, "Amen! Come, Lord Jesus! The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all." The Bible doesn't begin with, "Come, Lord Jesus!" It doesn't end with, "The Lord Jesus has come," "We have found the Lord Jesus," or simply, "The end." Rather, it ends with the People of God crying out, "Come, Lord Jesus!" Our hearts desire Christ. We have a longing for more than simply knowing about Him. We long to receive God, to be united with Him, to enter into communion with Him, to be in an eternal friendship with Him. This Sunday's collect begins, "Grant your faithful, we pray, almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ." The collect for the morning Mass on December 24 says, "Come quickly, we pray, Lord Jesus, and do not delay, that those who trust in your compassion may find solace and relief in your coming." Let us spend these next four weeks in an excited preparation to receive God, who has become one with us to redeem us, shower down His grace upon us, give us hope, and bring us to the eternal and blessed Kingdom of heaven.

As we move forward to welcome our Lord on Christmas, we remember that the name of this season is Advent, which means "coming." It is a time of anticipation and preparation for the coming of Christ our King. I hope that we are able to take some time during these four weeks of Advent to prepare our hearts and our households to receive Jesus in a new way on Christmas Day. During this next month, take some time each day for personal prayer as well as for family devotions and works of charity such as the Advent wreath, an Advent calendar that counts down to Christmas, placing Jesus in the manger on Christmas Eve, the rosary, and serving the poor and needy.

Know of my continued prayers for you, and let us continue to pray for one another. May the Lord bless you and your loved ones always as we prepare for the birth of our savior.

La colecta para la misa de la mañana del 24 de diciembre dice: "Apresúrate, Señor Jesús, no tardes más, para que, a quienes confiamos en tu bondad, nos reanime el consuelo de tu venida." Pasemos estas cuatro semanas siguientes preparando para recibir a Dios, quien se ha hecho uno con nosotros para redimirnos, derrama su gracia sobre nosotros, danos la esperanza y llévanos al reino de los cielos.

Quando avanzamos para dar la bienvenida a nuestro Señor en Navidad, recordamos que el nombre de esta temporada es Adviento, que significa "a la venida". Es un tiempo de anticipación y preparación para la venida de Cristo. Espero que podamos tomar un tiempo durante estas cuatro semanas de Adviento para preparar nuestros corazones y nuestros hogares para recibir a Jesús de una manera nueva el día de Navidad. Durante el próximo mes, tómense tiempo cada día para oración personal y devociones con la familia y obras de misericordia como la corona de Adviento, un calendario de Adviento que cuenta los días hasta Navidad, colocando a Jesús en el pesebre en la víspera de Navidad, el rosario y sirviendo a los pobres y necesitados.

Rezo cada día por ustedes; sigamos rezando unos por otros. Que el Señor siempre les bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias mientras preparamos para la celebración del nacimiento de nuestro salvador.

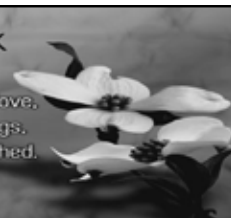

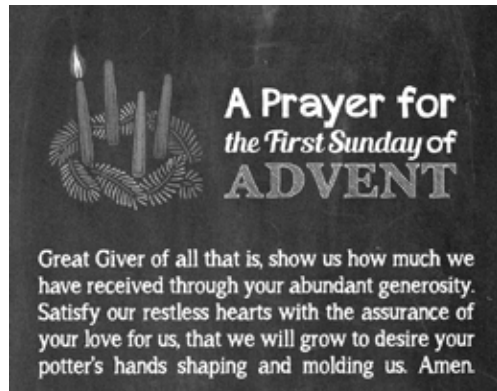

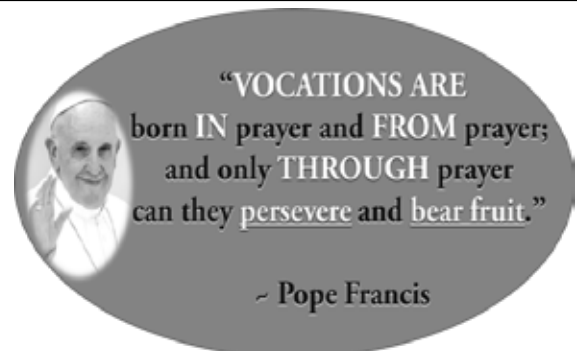

## The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary


SOLEMNITY: DECEMBER 8

**What it is**

- It is the **conception of Mary**. Through a special grace from God, she was kept free from Original Sin and lived her whole life free from sin in order to carry out her mission as the Mother of Jesus.
- It is an **ancient Church teaching**. While it was defined as dogma by Pope Pius IX in 1854, the Church has held it as point of faith for centuries before.

**What it is not**

- It is **not a virgin birth**. Mary was conceived like any other person.
- It is **not the conception of Jesus**. We remember the conception of Jesus on the Feast of the Annunciation, which is celebrated on March 25.



The Miraculous Medal also known as the Medal of the Immaculate Conception has this prayer inscribed:  
*"O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee."*

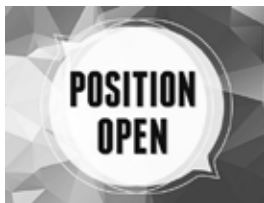

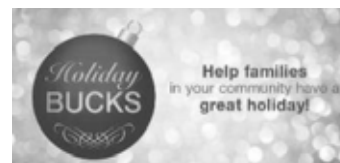

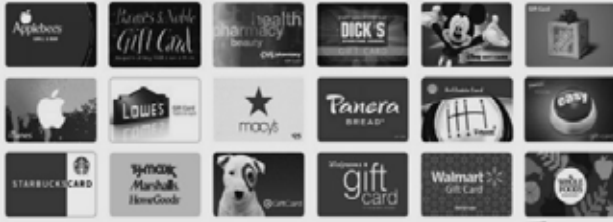
