A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In this Sunday's gospel, Christ criticizes the scribes for their long robes and even longer prayers, and then he criticizes some of the wealthy, even though they give large sums of money to the treasury. Why? Doesn't Christ want scribes leading people in prayer as well as people taking care of the temple? When Christ holds up the widow as an example, he teaches us that the practice of faith is not just about external actions and accolades. He affirms the widow who remains faithful to the Lord even when it does not appear easy, beneficial, or grand by worldly standards. She sacrificed because of her faith in God, hope in His providence, and love of Him and His people. Faith, hope, and love: these are what we call the theological virtues, given to us in baptism. Let us ask God to increase these gifts in us so that we might lift up our hearts with our offerings to the Lord. May we give of ourselves to God and His people through our daily prayers, attention at the Holy Mass, works of charity toward loved ones, neighbors, and the poor, and our offerings to the church. Generosity is not measured by the amount but by the heart. May we persevere, remaining faithful in making our lives a pleasing offering to God who has offered Himself to us.

I bring you to our Lord every day in prayer. I ask you to continue to pray for me and one another, especially our veterans as we celebrate Veterans Day this week. May the love of the Lord unite us together in His friendship and be our consolation and our joy.

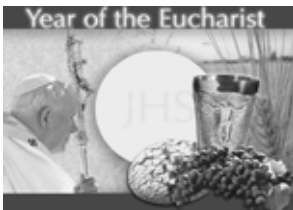


Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,
