A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

This Sunday is different from the other Sundays of Advent. Today, the candle on the Advent wreath and the vestments of the priests and deacons take a break from purple, a color which symbolizes penitence and preparation, and are adorned in rose (or pink). None of the other Sundays in Advent have a name, but today is "Gaudete Sunday"—Gaudete is Latin for "Rejoice!" We take a break from the

nighttime purple of Advent to rejoice with the color rose as the light of the Sun of God begins to dawn. The coming of Christ on Christmas is near, and the feast of the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is the cause of our joy, is quickly approaching.

When Pope Benedict XVI led the Angelus on Gaudete Sunday of 2007, he reflected on joy and the meaning of the birth of Jesus, teaching us, "Christian joy thus springs from this certainty: God is close, he is with me, he is with us, in joy and in sorrow, in sickness and in health, as a friend and faithful spouse. And this joy endures, even in trials, in suffering itself. It does not remain only on the surface; it dwells in the depths of the person who entrusts himself to God and trusts in him." We are inundated with many distractions and competing messages about joy and happiness. What truly makes us happy is the light that dispels the darkness: Jesus Christ. He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. His presence is not abstract or merely symbolic. Our savior and Lord is born, and today He is with us. While the world went about its course in an ordinary way, filled with movement, chaos, and conflicts, it received its Creator and Savior in the silence and stillness of that first Christmas night in the little town of Bethlehem. Let us continue to create a serene, quiet, and trusting place in our hearts and in our lives so that we may receive with great joy our Beloved Lord Jesus Christ, who was born in Bethlehem, is seated at the right hand of the Father in Heaven, and gives Himself to us through the holy sacraments. He has entered our world and is our light and our salvation, our rock, our refuge, and our hope: "Reioice in the Lord always: again I say. rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near" (Phil. 4:4-5).




Este domingo es diferente a los otros domingos de Adviento. Hoy, la vela de la corona de adviento y las vestiduras de los sacerdotes y diáconos descansan del morado, color que simboliza la penitencia y la preparación, y se adornan en rosado (o rosa). ¡Ninguno de los otros domingos en Adviento tienen un nombre, pero hoy es el "Domingo Gaudete"—Gaudete significa "¡Alégrense!" en latín. Descansamos del

púrpura nocturno del Adviento para regocijarnos con el color rosa como la luz del Sol de Dios al amanecer. La venida de Cristo en Navidad está cerca y la fiesta de la Natividad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que es la causa de nuestra alegría, se acerca rápidamente.

Cuando el Papa Benedicto XVI dirigió el Ángelus el Domingo Gaudete del 2007, reflexionó sobre la alegría y el significado del nacimiento de Jesús, enseñándonos: "La alegría cristiana brota, pues, de esta certeza: Dios está cerca, está conmigo, está con nosotros, en la alegría y en la pena, en la salud y en la enfermedad, como amigo y esposo fiel. Y esta alegría permanece incluso en las pruebas, en el sufrimiento. No es sólo superficial; habita en lo más profundo de la persona que se encomienda a Dios y confía en Él." Estamos inundados con muchas distracciones y mensajes competitivos sobre la alegría y la felicidad. Lo que verdaderamente nos hace felices es la luz que disipa las tinieblas: Jesucristo. Él es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Su presencia no es abstracta ni meramente simbólica. Ha nacido nuestro Señor v Salvador, y hoy está con nosotros. Mientras el mundo sigue su curso de manera ordinaria, lleno de movimientos, caos y conflictos, recibió a su Creador y Salvador en el silencio y la quietud de aquella primera noche de Navidad en el pueblito de Belén. Sigamos creando un lugar sereno, tranquilo y de confianza en nuestros corazones y en nuestras vidas para que recibamos con gran alegría a nuestro Amado Señor Jesucristo, que nació en Belén, v está sentado a la diestra del Padre en el Cielo v se entrega a nosotros por medio de los santos sacramentos. Ha entrado en nuestro mundo y es nuestra luz y nuestra salvación, nuestra roca, nuestro refugio, y nuestra esperanza: "Alégrense siempre en el Señor; se los repito: ¡alégrense! El Señor está cerca" (Fil. 4: 4-5).
