

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On behalf of Fr. Roy, Fr. John, our deacons and parish staff, and myself, I would like to wish all of you and your loved ones a very Merry Christmas this week.

This holy day, customarily marked by parties, dinners, presents, songs, and decorations, reminds us of God's presence, love, and fidelity. God has become like us to redeem us. Whenever I reflect on the first Christmas, I am often struck by the fact that the greatest moment in the history of the world, the coming of its own Creator, went relatively unnoticed amid the passing routines of the world. Commenting on that most sublime and silent night, Pope Benedict reflected on St. Luke's observance that there was no room for the Holy Family in the inn and challenged us to be aware of Christ's presence and to make room:

I am also repeatedly struck by the Gospel writer's almost casual remark that there was no room for them at the inn. Inevitably the question arises, what would happen if Mary and Joseph were to knock at my door. Would there be room for them? And then it occurs to us that Saint John takes up this seemingly chance comment about the lack of room at the inn, which drove the Holy Family into the stable; he explores it more deeply and arrives at the heart of the matter when he writes: "he came to his own home, and his own people received him not" (Jn 1:11). The great moral question of our attitude towards the homeless, towards refugees and migrants, takes on a deeper dimension: do we really have room for God when he seeks to enter under our roof? Do we have time and space for him? (Pope Benedict XVI, Homily, December 24, 2012).

This Christmas is an opportunity for us to make room for Him who desires to enter under our roofs, to open the doors of our hearts and receive Christ in the inns of our daily lives: he is present to us through the sacraments, particularly the Eucharist, our prayer, moments and experiences of grace and providence, and those in need. It is good to reflect upon the question: Do I recognize and receive Jesus in the Sunday Eucharist, daily prayer, those in need, the homeless, the poor, and the neglected? In addition to the charitable events and programs in our parish, let us be aware of Christ's presence in those close to us who are in need. Perhaps there is a neighbor who needs someone to listen or a family member who needs a prayer.

Know of my prayers for you, especially during the Christmas Masses. May the Christ child bless you and your loved ones!

UNA NOTA DEL PÁBROCO

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

En nombre de Padre Roy, Padre John, los diáconos, y el personal de la parroquia y yo mismo, me gustaría deseárselos a todos ustedes y sus seres queridos una muy Feliz Navidad esta semana.

Este día sagrado, marcado por fiestas, cenas, regalos, canciones y decoraciones, nos recuerda la presencia, el amor y la fidelidad de Dios. Dios se ha vuelto como nosotros para redimirnos. Cada

vez que reflexiono sobre la primera Navidad, me llega al corazón que el acto más grande en la historia del mundo, la venida de su Creador, pasó relativamente desapercibido en medio de las rutinas pasajeras del mundo. Al comentar sobre la noche más sublime y silenciosa, el Papa Benedicto reflexionó sobre la observancia de San Lucas de que no había lugar para la Sagrada Familia en la posada y nos retó a ser conscientes de la presencia de Cristo y a hacer espacio:

Nuevamente me llega al corazón esa palabra del evangelista, dicha casi de pasada, de que no había lugar para ellos en la posada. Surge inevitablemente la pregunta sobre qué pasaría si María y José llamaran a mi puerta. ¿Habría lugar para ellos? Y después nos percatamos de que esta noticia aparentemente casual de la falta de sitio en la posada, que lleva a la Sagrada Familia al establo, es profundizada en su esencia por el evangelista Juan cuando escribe: "Vino a su casa, y los suyos no la recibieron" (Jn 1,11). Así que la gran cuestión moral de lo que sucede entre nosotros a propósito de los prófugos, los refugiados, los emigrantes, alcanza un sentido más fundamental aún: ¿Tenemos un puesto para Dios cuando él trata de entrar en nosotros? ¿Tenemos tiempo y espacio para él? (Papa Benedicto XVI, Homilia, 24 de diciembre de 2012).

Esta Navidad es una oportunidad para abrir las puertas de nuestros corazones y recibir a Cristo en las posadas de nuestra vida cotidiana: él está presente a través de los sacramentos, particularmente la Eucaristía, nuestra oración y los necesitados. Por eso, preguntamos: ¿Reconozco y recibo a Jesús en la Eucaristía dominical, la oración diaria, los necesitados, las personas sin hogar, los enfermos y los pobres? Que estemos conscientes de la presencia de Cristo en nuestro prójimo. Quizás haya un miembro de la familia o un vecino que necesite una oración o un amigo.

Estoy rezando por ustedes, especialmente durante las misas navideñas. ¡Que el niño Jesús les bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias!

In an effort to help petitioners complete their part of the process, the Office for Family Ministry, in collaboration with the Joliet Diocesan Tribunal, is once again offering an OPTIONAL Day of Support for Annulment Petitioners on Saturday, January 22, 2022 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm In-person at the Blanchette Center for a \$15 fee.

This workshop is designed for divorced persons who have already started the annulment process by petitioning the Diocesan Marriage Tribunal, have submitted their Matrimonial Fact Sheet and have a current case in process but have not yet completed the Marriage Summary Long/Questionnaire. Catholics and non-Catholics are welcome to attend, whether remarried or not.


