

THE CHRISTMAS MESSAGE: GOD'S LOVE FOR US ALL

We have arrived at the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and in a few days, we will celebrate the holy day of Christmas, and the season of divine love, expressed in the birth of the Son of God.

As we light the fourth candle of advent, the candle of love, I want to offer a reminder that love is a holy action, not just some feel-good feeling or ego massaging sentiment. Love is our commitment to do something good in the name of God whose very essence is Love Itself. All the advent observances that we do during this season have to be consecrated lovingly to the Lord, as an offering, for His love for us.

This festival of the birth of Jesus is arguably one of the greatest expressions of God's holy love. Because of the mystery of the Incarnation, every human being now bears within their humanity the image of the divine God, as He assumed for Himself the human form. This is when God took our humanity in order that we may share in His divinity. And from the mystery of the nativity, our language of God has changed forever. For indeed, from the God born in the manger, comes the God who grew up in Nazareth, the God who lived to be a carpenter's son, the God who went missing in Jerusalem and was found with the elders in the temple, the God who was baptized by John at the beginning of His public ministry, the God who was tempted by the devil, the God who called his friends to a mission of love, to the God who would die on the cross and would rise again from the death, we came to see the face of God. This solemn feast of the Incarnation was humanity's doorway to discovering even more profoundly who God really is in Jesus Christ. How powerful it is to be aware of the amazing love of God manifest in the story of Christmas!

Dear parishioners, this is my ninth Christmas in Kankakee. Every Christmas that I have had with you has been very memorable, joyful and emotionally charged. This is for me one of the reasons why I know I have made a real home here in Kankakee over the years, that my Christmases with you have been beautifully blessed. I know that this year is not going to be different. Even now, I have already received plenty of gifts and greetings from our parishioners, and I want to take this time to say thank you to all of you. I have a few big boxes of greeting cards from over the past eight years of being in Kankakee, and I know someday, when I open these boxes again, some beautiful memories and sentiments will surface back in my soul. I am very grateful and I thank God for these beautiful moments of my priestly life. They will never be forgotten.

Allow me to take this opportunity to also remind all of us that the season of Christmas is just about to begin. Christmas does not end the day after Christmas day, but actually continues for a few weeks all the way to the feast of Epiphany, and even more extendable to the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Please make sure to teach the families around you to not put away your Christmas decorations just when the Christmas Season has finally arrived. Even more importantly, I invite to make sure to keep the Christmas spirit alive throughout the season. Be with friends and family, whisper a pray of gratitude by the manger scene. Sing your Christmas carols. And when you can, come to pray at Church during the entire octave of Christmas.

On behalf of our entire parish family, I greet you a Merry Christmas. May you always have the love of God in your hearts, and may you never fail to recognize that love displayed in many areas of your life. That you may grow in your gratitude and respond to His love with utter generosity of spirit and passion for your faith.

- I will stop complaining this week about _____?




THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD

The Papal Crucifix is based on the design of the Papal "Pastoral" staff that Pope John Paul II made so recognizable during his time as our shepherd in Rome.

The Papal Crucifix is a sign of service in the footsteps of Jesus - the savior who guides and leads, who serves, and gives his life as a ransom for many.


