A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is the commitment weekend for the Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal. Please prayerfully consider pledging to support this appeal, which helps fund the ministries and work of the Diocese.

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the sacred season of Lent. Lent is a penitential time to prepare ourselves to renew our faith and celebrate the feast of our salvation, when Christ freed us from sin and death. On Easter, when Christ conquered the tomb by rising from the dead, we will renew our baptismal promises, remembering that St. Paul said, "Or are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life" (*Rom. 6:3-4; cf. Col. 2:12*). It is easy to fall into old habits or to let our faith be something routine. Lent gives us the opportunity to put aside normal routines and focus on growing in love of God and neighbor, remembering the mystery of Jesus' Passion, death, and Resurrection and renewing our commitment to live in union with our crucified and risen Savior.

As we approach Lent, it is important to start thinking about our Lenten practices. The three Lenten disciplines are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. I encourage you to do one of each: to give something up, to love God in prayer, and to love one's neighbor through charity. Lenten devotional booklets give us helpful reflections, and the Stations of the Cross, Mass during the week, and Parish Mission next Sunday and Monday are helpful ways to enter into the season of Lent. The theme of the mission is "Finding Peace in Prayer". It is of the utmost importance that we go to confession during Lent, and don't forget that Fridays during Lent are days to abstain from meat for anybody over the age of fourteen and that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days to abstain from meat and fast for anyone between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine.

I pray that this Lent be a time to grow closer to our Lord and receive an increase in faith, hope, and love. Know of my continued prayers for you, and please continue praying for one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este es el fin de semana de compromiso para la Apelación Anual de los Ministerios Católicos. Por favor, considere hacer un compromiso apoyando este llamado que ayuda a financiar los ministerios y el trabajo de la Diócesis.

Este miércoles es Miércoles de Ceniza, el comienzo de la temporada sagrada de Cuaresma. Cuaresma es un tiempo penitencial para prepararnos para renovar nuestra fe y celebrar la fiesta de nuestra salvación, cuando Cristo nos liberó del pecado y de la muerte. En la Pascua, cuando Cristo venció la tumba por resucitar de entre los muertos, renovamos nuestras promesas bautismales, recordando que San Pablo dijo: "¿No saben que todos nosotros los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo Jesús, hemos sido sumergidos en Su muerte? Por este bautismo en su muerte fuimos sepultados con Cristo y así como Cristo fue resucitado de entre los muertos por la Gloria del Padre, así también nosotros empezamos una vida nueva." (*Rom. 6:3-4; cf. Col. 2:12*). Es fácil caer en hábitos viejos o dejar nuestra fe como algo rutinario. La Cuaresma nos da la oportunidad de dejar al lado las rutinas normales y enfocarnos al amor a Dios y al prójimo, recordando el misterio de la Pasión, la muerte y la Resurrección de Jesús y renovando nuestros compromisos de vivir en unión con nuestro salvador crucificado y resucitado.

Cuando nos acercamos a la Cuaresma, es importante comenzar a pensar en nuestras prácticas de Cuaresma. Las tres disciplinas de Cuaresma son la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. Les animo a que hagan uno de cada uno: renunciar a algo, amar a Dios en la oración y amar al prójimo por la caridad. Los libritos devocionales de Cuaresma nos dan reflexiones útiles y el Viacrucis, la Misa durante la semana y la Misión Parroquial, el próximo domingo y lunes son formas útiles de entrar en la temporada de Cuaresma. El tema de la misión es "Encontrando Paz en Oración". Es de suma importancia que nos confesemos durante la Cuaresma y no olviden que los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días de abstenerse de comer carne para las personas mayores de catorce años en adelante y que el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de abstenerse de comer carne y de ayunar para las personas entre las edades de dieciocho y cincuenta y nueve años.

Ruego que esta Cuaresma sea un tiempo para acercarnos más a nuestro Señor y recibir un aumento de fe, esperanza y amor. Conozcan mis continuas oraciones por ustedes y por favor sigan rezando los unos por los otros.

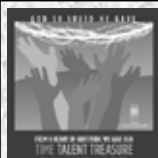

LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
4. To disregard completely the law of fasting and abstinence is seriously sinful.
5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.

REGULACIONAS DE CUARESMA

1. Todos los mayores de 14 años deben de abstenerse de comer carne el miércoles de ceniza y todos los viernes de cuaresma.
2. Todos los mayores 18 años y menores de 59 están obligados al ayuno el miércoles de ceniza y el viernes santo.
3. En estos dos días de ayuno y abstinencia solo una comida sin carne es permitida, otras dos pequeñas comidas sin carne son permitidas, suficiente para mantener fuerzas pero entre las dos debe ser equivalente a una comida completa y no comer entre comidas. Cuando la salud o habilidad para trabajar estarían afectados seriamente la ley no obliga.
4. Pasar completamente por alto del ayuno y abstinencia es un serio pecado.
5. La cuaresma es la época del año de penitencia y abstinencia en la Iglesia. Se pide a todos los fieles a desauollar y seguir un programa de auto negación voluntaria, oración, caridad y misericordia.

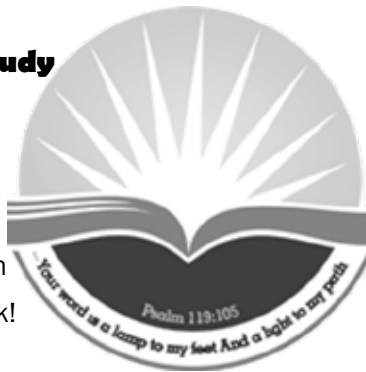

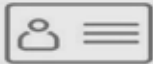

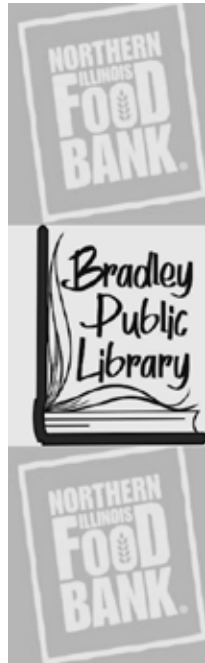
