ONE HUNDRED DAYS

I would like to begin by saying thank you to many of you who said wonderful and amazing things of affirmation after the announcement about my transfer last weekend. I have also received Facebook messages from many of you, telling me about the fruits of my ministry in Kankakee over the nine years of my time here. For those who might not have been here to hear the news, I would like to offer it here for your purposes. Hopefully this will avoid unnecessary speculations and doubts about where I stand as of this writing. Here is the gist of the message about my transfer:

I have received a call from Fr. John Balluff, Joliet Diocese Vicar for Clergy, on Friday afternoon with the instruction to announce this weekend that St. John Paul II Parish will have a new pastor in the next fiscal year, which begins on July 1, 2020.

1. REASSIGNMENT. *This means that my time to serve you as your pastor is coming to its end. By the 27th of June a new pastor will be with you, as my last weekend in the parish will be June 20/21. I will be moving to my new parish assignment on June 24.*
2. REMAINING DAYS. *It also means that starting this weekend, I have exactly 20 weeks left here in Kankakee before I move to a new parish. Out of those 140 days, I have about two weeks of vacation left to celebrate my mother's 75th birthday, and about 20 days of days off. Doing the math, I have about 100 days left to minister to the parish.*
3. STILL WORKING. *It doesn't mean that I am not working anymore. Please know that I am not slowing down as I come to the final days of my time with you. I still hope that we can accomplish a strategic planning during the Lenten season, in order to facilitate a smoother transition with your future pastor. I promise to continue to work hard in serving you and doing the ministry for our parish.*
4. DISCERNMENT. *With all these in mind, please know that my discernment to move to a new assignment is not because I do not love our parish. In fact, I am proud of what has been accomplished over the nine years of my time here. I have never lived in one city for that long in my life, and so Kankakee will always be a special part of my personal story. The decision to leave did not come easy, but it started two Christmases ago, and as I continued to discern, the whole idea of closing this chapter of my priestly narrative became clearer and clearer.*
5. PRAYER. *Please pray for me during this time of transition. Pray also for the priest that will be assigned here. I promise to continue to hold you all in my prayers as I move from here. Meanwhile, let us make the most of the time that is left for us to be together. Thank you.*
6. NEXT ASSIGNMENT. *This past Monday, I spent my day off visiting the churches that are open for pastorate: St. Peter (Itasca), St. Anthony (Frankfort), St. Irene (Warrenville) and St. Luke (Carol Stream). I spent some time praying in these churches, (although in one of them, I could only pray outside of the church), asking for divine inspiration. I believe that God was truly present with me during this time and gave me great clarity for the future. I am very optimistic and positive about where I am headed, and I hope that everything will fully come to light soon.*

The question that I have left for us to answer, my dear church, is this: what are we doing in these my final 100 days with you? I hope to answer this more with you soon. Meanwhile, may God bless our time, and may we continue to grow in holiness and grace until we reach the end of the line.

CIEN DÍAS

Me gustaría empezar dando las gracias a muchos de ustedes que el fin de semana pasado dijeron algunas cosas positivas, maravillosas y sorprendentes, después de los anuncios sobre mi traslado. También he recibido mensajes en Facebook de muchos de ustedes, contándome los frutos de mi ministerio en Kankakee durante los nueve años de mi estancia aquí. Para aquellos que no hayan estado aquí para escuchar las noticias, me gustaría dárselas. Espero que, a partir de este escrito, se eviten especulaciones innecesarias y dudas sobre mi postura. Aquí está lo esencial del mensaje sobre mi traslado:

El viernes por la tarde recibí una llamada del Padre John Balluff, Vicario del Clero de la Diócesis de Joliet, con la instrucción de anunciar este fin de semana que la Parroquia de San Juan Pablo II tendrá un nuevo párroco en el próximo año fiscal, que comienza el 1º de julio, 2020.

1. REASIGNACIÓN. *Esto significa que mi tiempo para servirles como su pastor está llegando a su fin. El 27 de junio un nuevo pastor estará con ustedes, ya que mi último fin de semana en la parroquia será el 20/21 de junio. Me mudaré a mi nueva asignación parroquial el 24 de junio.*
2. LOS DÍAS QUE QUEDAN. *También significa que, a partir de este fin de semana, me quedan exactamente 20 semanas aquí en Kankakee antes de mudarme a una nueva parroquia. De esos 140 días, me quedan unas dos semanas de vacaciones para celebrar el cumpleaños 75 de mi mamá, y unos 20 días libres. Haciendo cuentas, me quedan unos 100 días siendo pastor de la parroquia.*
3. SIGO TRABAJANDO. *No significa que ya no esté trabajando. Por favor, sepán que no estoy disminuyendo el ritmo mientras llego a los últimos días de mi tiempo con ustedes. Todavía espero que podamos lograr una planificación estratégica durante la temporada de cuaresma, para facilitar una transición más leve con su futuro pastor. Prometo seguir trabajando duro sirviéndoles y haciendo el ministerio para nuestra parroquia.*
4. DISCERNIMIENTO. *Con todo esto en mente, por favor quieren que sepán que mi discernimiento para mudarme a una nueva asignación no es porque no amo nuestra parroquia. De hecho, estoy orgulloso de lo que se ha logrado en los nueve años que llevo aquí. En mi vida había vivido tanto tiempo en una ciudad, así que Kankakee siempre será una parte especial de mi historia personal. La decisión de irme no fue fácil, pero comenzó hace dos Navidades, y a medida que continuaba discerniendo, la idea de cerrar este capítulo de mi narrativa sacerdotal se hizo más y más clara.*
5. ORACIÓN. *Por favor, recen por mí durante este tiempo de transición. Recen también por el sacerdote que será asignado aquí. Prometo continuar rezando por todos ustedes mientras me muevo de aquí. Mientras tanto, aprovecharemos el tiempo que nos queda para estar juntos. Gracias.*
6. SIGUIENTE TAREA. *Al día siguiente, pasé mi día libre visitando las iglesias que están abiertas para el pastoreo: San Pedro (Itasca), San Antonio (Frankfort), Santa Irene (Warrenville) y San Lucas (Carol Stream). Pasé algún tiempo rezando en estas iglesias, (aunque en una de ellas, sólo pude rezar afuera de la iglesia), pidiendo inspiración divina. Creo que Dios estuvo realmente presente conmigo durante este tiempo y me dio una gran claridad para el futuro. Estoy muy optimista y positivo acerca de hacia dónde me dirijo, y espero que todo salga pronto a la luz.*

Las preguntas que dejé para que contestáramos, mi querida iglesia, son estas: ¿Qué estamos haciendo en estos mis últimos 100 días con ustedes? Espero responderlas pronto con ustedes. Mientras tanto, que Dios bendiga el tiempo, y que sigamos creciendo en santidad y gracia hasta que lleguemos al final de la línea.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- To disregard completely the law of fasting and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.

REGULACIONES DE CUARESMA

- Todos los mayores de 14 años deben de abstenerse de comer carne el miércoles de ceniza y todos los viernes de cuaresma.
- Todos los mayores 18 años y menores de 59 están obligados al ayuno el miércoles de ceniza y el viernes santo.
- En estos dos Días de ayuno y abstinencia solo una comida sin carne es permitida, otras dos pequeñas comidas sin carne son permitidas, suficiente para mantener fuerzas pero entre las dos debe ser equivalente a una comida completa y no comer entre comidas. Cuando la salud oabilidad para trabajar estarian afectados seriamente la ley no obliga.
- Pasar completamente por alto del ayuno y abstinencia es un serio pecado.
- La cuaresma es la época del año de penitencia y abstinencia en la Iglesia. Se pide a todos los fieles a desauollar y seguir un programa de auto negación voluntaria, oración, caridad y misericordia.


