

FRUITS GROWING FAR AWAY

I have always said in many ways and many forms that when we plant solid foundation of faith on our children, no matter what happens, they will carry that with them wherever they go, and however they may grow. Sometimes, those gifts that are imbedded in the foundation of their lives are there as latent powers that will manifest in their proper time. Sometimes, visible and immediate fruits of the seeds that have been planted might be available for us to see. Whether or not we are privileged to see the fruits of faith that has been sowed in their lives, what is important is to trust that such seeds are there, still bearing the power within itself, still alive.



This past weekend, I was privileged to see the fruits of faith sowed in our community, although it is now growing somewhere else away from here. I remember the Bollwitts from St. Teresa Parish, when Jeri was cantoring on Sundays, and Mike would simply be praying after a week of flying as an airline pilot, and the two kids Alex and Julia would be serving as altar servers. They were young children then, Alex and Julia, and they were also involved in youth group activities. I have seen this family involved and engaged in their faith community, and forged many beautiful friendships and relationships surrounding their faith community. I have had conversations with Mike about St. Thomas, and Bishop Barron's Word on Fire Ministry. I remember Julia dancing on my 10th year anniversary as a priest. I remember encouraging Alex for embracing the ministry of lector as well, after he went to One Bread, One Cup with Ken and Michelle Barries. I saw how Deacon Dave mentored and encouraged Alex as sponsor of his confirmation. I saw how Jeri Bollwitt organized a ministry to help our high school youth to prepare for college. I saw Alex and Julia grow to be young adults' firm in their faith until they went in their own time to college, leaving Jeri and Mike as empty nesters for the first time. The family has been so solidly entrenched in the life of our Catholic community that it came as a surprise to me when they decided to move back home to Iowa City, within the year of our establishment as St. John Paul II Parish. Not long after they left Kankakee, Mike went through a serious medical condition and required full time care. Jeri meanwhile became the Director of Religious Education in their new parish. Julia is now working on her psychology career, and Alex is still in the Air Force.

I got to visit with the Bollwitts last weekend, together with a number of parishioners and Catholic families from the Kankakee area. Alex got married to a beautiful young woman who recently converted to Catholicism. In my conversations with Alex and his new wife Briana, I couldn't have been anything but be amazed by their solid faith. Alex is even now looking into pursuing studies in theology on top of his military duties. They are so on fire in their faith, that it radiated to the people who were present on their wedding day. They spoke tenderly to each other before their vows, offering each other a promise to grow together in their love of God as a family. And what more, Alex and Briana are now growing in their own circle of friends who are able to support their walk of faith for years to come.

As I was driving to the airport to return home, I thanked God for the chance to see the fruits from the seeds of the faith sown here in our community now being shared far away from here. Part of our story is being told somewhere else, but it is still our story, nonetheless. Be inspired, my dear church. Keep sowing the seeds of faith!

LOS FRUTOS CRECEN A LO LEJOS

De muchas maneras siempre he dicho que cuando sembramos una fundación sólida de fe en nuestros niños, pase lo que pase, ellos lo llevarán siempre a donde vayan y como sea que crezcan. Algunas veces, estos dones arraigados en su ser están allí como poderes ocultos que se manifestarán a su propio tiempo. Algunas veces, los frutos visibles e inmediatos de las semillas que han sido sembradas pueden ser vistos. Seamos privilegiados o no de ver los frutos de la fe sembrados en sus vidas, lo importante es confiar que tales semillas están allí, siguen teniendo el poder en sí, siguen vivas.

El fin de semana pasado, tuve el privilegio de ver los frutos de fe sembrados en nuestra comunidad, aunque ya están creciendo en otro lugar lejos de aquí. Recuerdo a los Bollwitts de la parroquia Sta. Teresa, cuando Jeri cantaba en domingo, y Mike rezaba después de volar toda la semana como piloto, y sus dos hijos Alex y Julia servían como acólitos; todavía eran niños pequeños, y también estaban involucrados en las actividades del grupo juvenil. He visto a esta familia involucrarse y entregarse a su comunidad de fe, y forjar muchas amistades y relaciones maravillosas en torno a su comunidad de fe. He tenido conversaciones con Mike acerca de Sto. Tomás y La Palabra del Ministerio Ardiente del Obispo Barron. Recuerdo a Julia bailando en mi 10º aniversario como sacerdote. Recuerdo que animaba a Alex a ser también lector, después de atender a Un Pan, Una Copa con Ken y Michelle Barrie. Vi como el Diácono Dave daba tutoría y animaba a Alex como padrino de su confirmación. Vi cómo Jeri Bollwitt organizó un ministerio para ayudar a los jóvenes de preparatoria en su preparación para el colegio. Vi a Alex y Julia crecer como adultos jóvenes firmes en su fe hasta ingresar al colegio, dejando a Jeri y Mike con el nido vacío por primera vez. La familia estaba sólidamente comprometida en la vida de nuestra comunidad Católica que me sorprendió cuando decidieron regresar a casa en Iowa City, durante el año del establecimiento de nuestra parroquia San Juan Pablo II. Después de poco tiempo de haber salido de Kankakee, Mike estuvo muy enfermo y requirió cuidado de tiempo completo. Entre tanto, Jeri se hizo Directora de Educación Religiosa en su nueva parroquia, Julia está trabajando en su carrera de psicología, y Alex sigue en la Fuerza Aérea.

El fin de semana pasado visité a los Bollwitts, juntamente con algunos feligreses y familias Católicas del área de Kankakee. Alex se casó con una hermosa jovencita quien recién se convirtió a la fe Católica. En mi conversación con Alex y su nueva esposa Briana, estaba pasmado al ver la solides de su fe. Alex incluso ahora está buscando realizar estudios de teología además de sus deberes militares. Ellos tienen una fe ardiente, que la irradiaron a las personas que estaban presentes el día de su boda. Ellos hablaron uno al otro con ternura al pronunciar sus votos, prometiéndose uno al otro crecer unidos en su amor a Dios como familia. Y además, Alex y Briana están ahora creciendo en su propio círculo de amistades quienes pueden apoyarlos en su camino de fe en los años venideros.

Mientras conducía al aeropuerto para regresar a casa, le di gracias a Dios por la oportunidad de ver los frutos de las semillas de la fe que fueron sembradas aquí en nuestra comunidad, ahora compartidas lejos de aquí. Parte de nuestra historia se comparte en otro lugar, sin embargo, sigue siendo nuestra historia. Inspírense, mi querida iglesia. ¡Sigan sembrando las semillas de la fe!

- Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- To disregard completely the law of fasting and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.

REGULACIONES DE CUARESMA

- Todos los mayores de 14 años deben de abstenerse de comer carne el miércoles de ceniza y todos los viernes de cuaresma.
- Todos los mayores 18 años y menores de 59 están obligados al ayuno el miércoles de ceniza y el viernes santo.
- En estos dos Días de ayuno y abstinencia solo una comida sin carne es permitida, otras dos pequeñas comidas sin carne son permitidas, suficiente para mantener fuerzas pero entre las dos debe ser equivalente a una comida completa y no comer entre comidas. Cuando la salud o habilidad para trabajar estarian afectados seriamente la ley no obliga.
- Pasar completamente por alto del ayuno y abstinencia es un serio pecado.
- La cuaresma es la época del año de penitencia y abstinencia en la Iglesia. Se pide a todos los fieles a desauollar y seguir un programa de auto negación voluntaria, oración, caridad y misericordia.




