A Message from FFP Catechist Elida Razo

This year, I received the opportunity to be a catechist for our parish. At first, the idea of being a catechist seemed unrealistic for me since I am a mother of three children and work a full time job. Between managing

our household, afterschool activities, and sports practices, I did not think I could take on another responsibility. What convinced me was the need I saw in our parish for younger parishioners.

Every Sunday, I would take my children to mass and would see very few children. I thought to myself, if we don't get involved, who will teach and prepare our children to be active members of our parish and have a friendship with God? As baptized Christians, we are called to proclaim the Gospel to others and being a catechist is an excellent opportunity to fulfill God's call.

There have been many benefits to being a catechist for me. First off, I feel my faith and understanding of the word has grown. Each week, I am able to reflect on my own faith and knowledge as I prepare for the week's lesson. I have met some great people through volunteering in our faith formation program; my students, my students' parents, and fellow catechists. It feels good to see my students excited and happy when they see me in public or in mass. It is also very rewarding to see how my students' faith is growing and know that I had a hand in it.

Lastly, being a catechist enables me as a parent to be involved in the way our children are brought up in the faith.

I encourage you to consider taking the same opportunity to be a part of the process of encouraging and teaching our young people to have a relationship with God at an early age.







Julia Greeley, Denver's Angel of Charity, was born into slavery in Hannibal, Missouri, sometime between 1833 and 1844. While the cruel slave master was beating her mother, his whip caught her right eye and destroyed it forever. Even with the loss of one eye ,she still had a beautiful smile that could not be forgotten. Julia was freed through the 1865 Emancipation Act; then she earned her keep working for white wealthy families in Missouri, Wyoming, Colorado and New Mexico. In the 1870's, Julia

came to Denver and worked as the housekeeper for the wealthy Gilpin family, who were Catholic. It was at this time she became a devout Catholic. Julia Greeley did her charitable works as an "undercover agent" for the poor and needy of Denver. In the middle of the night wearing a floppy black hat and pulling her red wagon she would distribute food, fuel, and clothing to poor white families. Julia knew they would be embarrassed taking charity from a black woman, so she knocked on doors late at night while the other neighbors were asleep. She was constantly giving to the poor; when she didn't have enough from her own small resources, she begged for food and clothing for the needy. Once, she was seen carrying a mattress on her back through the dark Denver alleys. Only God knows the extent of Julia Greeley's charity.

"When you give to the poor, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. Mathew 6:3-4.

Julia had a devout devotion to the Scared Heart of Jesus and the Holy Sacrament. Every month she would walk and visit every fire station in Denver and give out literature on the Sacred Heart of Jesus to all the firemen. Julia was always happy and active in her charitable works until her death in June 1918.

Many dedicated Catholic men and women are actively working to have these Black American Servants of God: Pierre Toussaint, Father Tolton, Mary E. Lange, Henriette Delille, and Julia Greeley, canonized as saintsin the Catholic Church. The Catholic Church canonization process can be lengthy, however, all of these servants are already Saints in God eyes. They have obeyed His laws and given Him the glory, praise and honor by faithfully serving their sisters and brothers on earth in union with His love for all of us. By following their example of love for the Lord and love one another, we too can be called saints.
