

OUR PARISH DISCERNS ITSELF

This weekend is a very important weekend!

Since we started as a new unified parish on July 1, 2017, we have been operating as a community based on the hopes, vision and presumptions of what we would be as a church after the work of consolidation was over. For the first time since then, we are coming together as a family to honestly look at how far we have come, and to match the realities of our parish now vis-à-vis the vision that was created when we started.

As your pastor, I take this as an opportunity to define who we are today, by looking at the many facets of our parish and determining the next steps where we should be headed. I know there are a lot of things to talk about, and I know when we ask 100 people about their opinions on something, we may get 100 different things altogether. But if there is any wisdom to what we are doing today, it is simply that we are being given an opportunity to speak and share our thoughts, ideas, opinions, points of views, and even concerns, suggestions and disappointments. There is also an equal weight to celebrating now some of the victories and accomplishments over the past one year and nine months into being the parish of St. John Paul II. While there are many concerns, I can say that there are many reasons to be grateful and celebrate, and there are many reasons why we can be proud of our parish even now.

In this process of collective introspection, I ask you, my dear parishioners, to please offer a prayer for all of us. A number of you might not be able to attend the forum physically; please attend in spirit by offering a prayer; that the gift of Divine Wisdom may descend. Yes, we need wisdom to be able to see clearly what is happening in our parish, and we also need wisdom to be able to discern and respond to our present reality. This is one of those times when we really need to be in synergy with the Holy Spirit, or as close to it as possible. Although I feel like through the process of integration, the Holy Spirit has manifested to me and to all of us collectively the guiding light of Wisdom, to walk the steps we have taken that has led us to where we are today. And yet, the clarity of mind on areas of discernment is never a mathematical certainty like $1+1=2$, but a peacefulness of heart and the courage to act accordingly that determines where that Wisdom lies. I am confident that God will continue to help us, as He has done in the past.

Yes, my dear St. John Paul II parishioners, I have said here that today is a very important day. By the end of this fiscal year, I would have been in Kankakee for eight years – four years as pastor of Saint Teresa, two years as pastor of three parishes (St. Teresa, St. Rose and St. Martin), and two years as pastor of the newly established parish of Saint John Paul II. Through all the transitions that have taken place, I want to say thank you to the many people that have remained, that walked with me through the happy, sad, convenient and challenging times. Wherever we may go from this important day, please know that I love you all with the love of the Lord. God bless our Church!

Rosa y San Martín), y dos años como pastor del nuevo establecimiento de la parroquia de San Juan Pablo II. A través de todas las transiciones que han tomado lugar, doy las gracias a toda la gente que han continuado aquí, que han caminado conmigo en tiempos alegres, tristes, convenientes y desafiantes. Por dónde quiera que vayamos desde este día importante, quiero que sepan que los amo a todos con el amor de nuestro Señor. Que Dios bendiga nuestra Iglesia!
