OUR PARISH OUTREACH CULTURE: A Platform for Authentic Christianity

I have said many times that we can be very proud of our outreach programs here at Saint John Paul II.

From the very beginning, many of the people in this parish have desired that the culture of charity to the poor be an integral part of who we are as a church community. Perhaps, many of us felt encouraged when we saw the power of our united efforts during the 2016 Year of Mercy observances, when the three parishes then all participated in monthly charitable outreach experiences. Maybe we were encouraged by the existing programs that we already had then, and we wanted to continue doing them at all cost. Maybe we have heard the feedback of our visitors who always tell us what an incredible job we do in our outreach program. But allow me to give you, my dear parishioners, three important reasons why we have to continue to be an outreach-driven parish.

1. Outreach unifies the community. There are areas where we can be divided in our opinions and preferences about a lot of things, but outreach is a universal call to action, and in this platform, we focus not on ourselves and our opinions, but on doing something good for others. This is a very objective, selfless enterprise, thus bearing within it a unitive dimension. This is also the area that we can start a true collaborative effort with others who are not Catholics. For us here at St. John Paul II, if we are to continue to become a united parish, and we are unsure where to begin or what to do, I would easily suggest that we begin with being united in helping the poor, the needy, the hopeless, the voiceless and the powerless.

2. Outreach is the practical application of our Catholic Social Teachings. The Seven Tents of Catholic Social Teachings are: (a) Life and Dignity of the Human Person, (b) Call to Family, Community, and Participation, (c) Rights and Responsibilities, (d) Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, (e) The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers, (f) Solidarity, and (g) Care for God's Creation. All of these are relevant to our Outreach ministries. It is then important to build a strong outreach culture in our parish because it is essential to our Catholicism.

3. Outreach is an opportunity to encounter God. I cannot begin to tell you some of the amazing God-moments that parishioners have experienced over the years. The late Helen Chigaros used to tell me stories of God's providence to the free clinic that she started that paved the way to our present Azzarelli Outreach Clinic. The late Deacon Ron Whitman used to tell me about amazing things that happened in the food pantry, and how it was a true revelation of God's guidance to the work of feeding the hungry. I believe that God's presence is available every day in our outreach programs. I myself have some stories to tell, and I am not even directly involved in these ministries as some of our parishioners.

Church, it's the Lenten Season. What a great time to take seriously the meaning of our Christianity and embrace it through charity and our dedication to our outreach ministries. I encourage you to continue your support to our parish, and to pray for the success of our efforts to help the poor. God bless our parish!

NUESTRA CULTURA PARROQUIAL SE ALARGA Una Plataforma de Cristiandad Auténtica

Muchas veces he dicho que aquí en San Juan Pablo II podemos estar orgullosos por nuestros programas de Tender la Mano.

Desde sus principios, mucha gente en esta parroquia ha deseado que la cultura de caridad hacia los pobres sea una parte integral que identifique nuestra comunidad parroquial.

Quizá sentimos ánimo cuando vimos el poder de nuestros esfuerzos unidos durante el Año de la Misericordia 2016, cuando las tres parroquias participaron mensualmente en experiencias caritativas de alcance. Quizá nos sentíamos animados por los programas que ya existían, y queríamos que continuaran a toda costa. Quizá oímos lo que decían los visitantes que nuestro programa de extensión era increíble. Pero permítanme darles, mis queridos feligreses, tres razones importantes del porqué debemos continuar siendo una parroquia impulsada hacia la caridad.

1. El Tender la Mano unifica la comunidad. Hay áreas donde puede haber división de opiniones y preferencias sobre muchas cosas, pero el alcance es un llamado universal a la acción, y en esta plataforma, no nos enfocamos nosotros mismos y nuestras opiniones, pero en hacer algo bueno por otros. Esto es una iniciativa objetiva, generosa, llevando consigo una dimensión unificadora. Esta también es un área donde podemos empezar un verdadero esfuerzo colaborativo con los no Católicos. Para nosotros aquí en San Juan Pablo II, si continuamos unificando nuestra parroquia, y no estamos seguros donde comenzar o qué hacer, fácilmente sugiero que comencemos uniéndonos en ayudar a los pobres, los necesitados, los desamparados, los que no tienen voz y los débiles.

2. El Tender la Mano es una aplicación de las Enseñanzas Católicas Sociales. Los Siete Dogmas de las Enseñanzas Católicas Sociales son: (a) Vida y Dignidad de la Persona Humana, (b) Llamado a la Familia, Comunidad y Participación, (c) Derechos y Responsabilidades, (d) Opción por los Pobres y Vulnerables, (e) La Dignidad del Trabajo y los Derechos de los Obreros, (f) Solidaridad y (g) Cuidado por la Creación de Dios. Todos estos son aplicables a nuestros ministerios de Alcance. Por lo tanto es importante construir una cultura fuerte de alcance en nuestra parroquia, porque es esencial a nuestro Catolicismo.

3. El Tender la Mano es una oportunidad para encontrar a Dios. No puedo esperar a contarte algunas cosas asombrosas, momentos –de-Dios, que nuestros feligreses han experimentado a través de los años. La fallecida Helen Chigaros (que en Dios descansó) me contaba historias de la providencia de Dios para la clínica que ella comenzó, que preparó el camino, la actual clínica Azzarelli. El fallecido Diácono Ron Whitman (que en Dios descansó) me contaba cosas asombrosas que sucedían en la despensa de alimentos, y como era una revelación verdadera de la guía de Dios el trabajo de alimentar a los hambrientos. Creo que la presencia de Dios está disponible todos los programas de alcance. Yo mismo tengo historias que contar, y no estoy directamente involucrado en estos ministerios como algunos de nuestros feligreses.

Iglesia, es la Temporada de Cuaresma. Que tiempo tan oportuno para tomar seriamente el sentido de nuestra Cristiandad y abrásarlo por medio de la caridad y nuestra dedicación a los ministerios de alcance. Los animo a que continúen apoyar a nuestra parroquia y a orar por el éxito de nuestros esfuerzos para ayudar a los pobres. ¡Dios bendiga nuestra parroquia!


