

## BLESSINGS OF THE SEASON

I am full of the spirit these days, because I think we have received so much blessing as a parish community last weekend, and the positive effects of those days continue to ripple to today.

**BISHOP CONLON OPENS THE WINDOWS.** The Pastoral Visit of Bishop Conlon last weekend was a very positive experience for me as a pastor. This is the second time that I have experienced such visit, the first time being in December 2014 at Saint Teresa Parish. This second visit was equally memorable and positive because I got to witness Bishop Conlon being hands on in pastoring our own people. He spent much time being with the children in school, and also spent enough time visiting the sick and being with people. I actually did tell him in one of those moments that I actually appreciate his effort of visiting all the parishes in the diocese, in order to connect with people. When planning his visit, he insisted that it was a pastoral visit, and so it was not about administration meetings but about being with people. And so that's what we did for him. I am also very proud of our parish leaders who came to visit with him on Saturday for a breakfast conversation with the Bishop. I saw everyone's honesty, open-mindedness, and genuine concern for our parish. I am very proud of it all. On my part as your pastor, I was also happy to have a one-on-one time with the Bishop in order to air some stuffy parts of my priestly ministry. The Bishop showed his concern and fatherly care for me, and he opened a window for me to feel more at peace with myself. I want to say that Bishop opened windows in our parish community during this visit, and helped us to see God's grace even in the midst of the challenges that we have faced and are still facing today.

**FRIENDS, DISCIPLESHIPS, MISSIONARIES OF THE CROSS.** Our Lenten Mission from Sunday to Tuesday was a special one. I was happy to share this moment with Fr. John Horan, where we were both given the chance to engage our parishioners in a longer platform for conversation, teaching and dreaming together. The theme "I Have Called You Friends" made all the sense in the world, because I do believe that Jesus made the initiative to call his disciples friends, in order that His friendship may be extended to His Church throughout the ages. As friends of Jesus in our time, we are given the task to invite others to become his friends too. We are disciples of the cross too, i.e., we are here to spread the good news of God's love in the willingness of Jesus to die on the cross for us. That is the apex of our salvation history and that is the essence of the Church. Jesus is present to us in the Holy Spirit, to guide us in accomplishing this task today. And so, we are invited as a parish community to think of ways to build Christ-centered relationships in our own time. This task, we will intentionally and diligently do as a parish this year. I am excited!

I send you my blessings as we continue to pray for the future of our church. I am writing a special open letter this weekend also for Deacon Michael Groth. Let us congratulate him as his home parish and keep him in our prayers for his deaconate ministry.
